Ek, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Pryskontroleur, handelende kragtens regulasie 3 van Oorlogsmaatreel No. 49 van 1946, bepaal hierby vir die hele Unie, met uitsondering van die gebied Suidwes-Afrika en die hawe en nedersetting Walvisbaai, as volg:—

1. Die maksimum prys waarteen die goedere in die Bylae hiervan vermeld, deur 'n handelaar verkoop mag word—

- (a) aan 'n ander handelaar, is die prys wat in kolom 1 van genoemde Bylae aangegee word;
- (b) aan enigeen behalwe 'n handelaar, is die prys wat in kolom 2 van genoemde Bylae aangegee word.

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS, MACHINERY AND SPARE PARTS FOR SAME.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, hereby amend Government Notice No. 1079 of 22nd May, 1953 (Maximum Prices of Agricultural Implements and Machinery and Spare Parts for Same) by—

- (i) the deletion of paragraph 5 thereof; and
- (ii) the addition of the following new item 10 to the First Schedule thereto:—

Column 1. Description.	Column 2. Percentage.
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- 10 Spare parts (manufactured in the Union) for agricultural implements and machinery, excluding discs and ploughshares..... 80

NOTE.—The effect of this notice is that the maximum prices of all spare parts (manufactured in the Union) for agricultural implements and machinery, are now determinable in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of the Government Notice under amendment and that a total percentage profit margin of 80 per cent is prescribed in respect of such spare parts, with the exception of discs and ploughshares on which the percentage remains 55 per cent.

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF BICYCLE TYRES AND TUBES.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby, throughout the Union, excluding the Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay—

1. Fix the maximum prices at which the goods specified in the Schedule hereto may be sold by a dealer—

- (a) to any other dealer, the prices specified in column 1 of the said Schedule; and
- (b) to any person other than a dealer, the prices specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

2. Die maksimum pryse wat in genoemde Bylae vir 'n buite- of binneband aangegee word, kan verhoog word met die koste wat die verkoper of vorige verkoper (uitsluitende die fabrikant) noodwendig moes aangaan in verband met die vervoer daarvan per spoor en/of per pad van die perseel van die fabrikant daarvan na dié van die verkoper.

3. Die maksimum bedrag wat iemand mag vorder—
 (a) vir die aansit van 'n buiteband of 'n binneband of albei aan die voorwiel van 'n fiets is *een sjeling en drie pennies*; en
 (b) vir die aansit van 'n buiteband of 'n binneband of albei aan die agterwiel van 'n fiets is *twee sjellings*.

4. Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1388 van 26 Junie 1953, betreffende die maksimum prys van fietsbuitebande en -binnebande, word hierby herroep.

OPMERKING.—Die uitwerking van hierdie kennisgewing is dat die maksimum prys van fietsbuite- en -binnebande wat in die Unie vervaardig word, verhoog word vanweë die verhoogde aksjonsbelasting.

2. Direct that the maximum prices specified in this Schedule for any tyre (cover) or tube may be increased by the addition thereto of the cost necessarily incurred by the seller and any previous seller (excluding the manufacturer) in the transportation such tyre (cover) or tube by rail and/or road from the premises of the manufacturer thereof to that of the seller.

3. Fix the maximum charge that may be made by any person—

- (a) for the service of fitting a tyre (cover) or tube or both to the front wheel of a bicycle at *one shilling and threepence*; and
 (b) for the service of fitting a tyre (cover) or tube or both to the back wheel of a bicycle at *two shillings*;

4. Withdraw Government Notice No. 1388 of 26 June, 1953, relating to maximum prices of bicycle tyres and tubes.

DIE MERK VAN PRYSE OP GOEDERE.

Ek, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Pryskontroleur, handelende kragtens regulasie 9 van Oorlogsmaatreel No. 49 van 1946, bepaal hierby vir die hele Unie, met uitsondering van die gebied Suidwes-Afrika en die hawe en nedersetting Walvisbaai, as volg:

(1) Elke kleinhandelaar, of hy gelisensieer is om goedere te verkoop al dan nie, moet op die manier voorgeskryf in subparagraph (2) hiervan, alle goedere wat hy vir verkoop vertoon, met sy kleinhandelkontantverkoopprys van die goedere merk, en in gevalle waar sodanige goedere vertoon word vir verkoop op paaiementerme, met die periodieke paaiment wat betaalbaar is en met die termyn wat op elke paaiment van toepassing is.

(2) Genoemde prys en paaemente moet in duidelik leesbare letters en syfers wat minstens een-agtste duim hoog is, gemerk word, hetso—

- (a) op die goedere; of
- (b) op diehouer (as daar een is) waarin die goedere vir verkoop vertoon word; of
- (c) op 'n prisetiket of pryskaartjie wat aan sodanige goedere of houer geheg is; of

PRICE CONTROL.

MARKING OF PRICES ON GOODS.

In terms of regulation 9 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, hereby, throughout the Union, excluding the Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay:

1. Direct that—

- (1) every retail dealer, whether or not he is licensed to sell goods, shall, in the manner prescribed in subparagraph (2) hereof, mark all goods exposed for sale by him with his retail cash selling price for such goods, and in cases in which any such goods are exposed for sale on instalment terms, with the periodical instalment payable indicating the period applicable to each instalment;
- (2) the aforesaid price and instalments shall be marked in clearly legible letters and figures of not less than one-eighth inch in height either—
 - (a) on the goods; or
 - (b) on the container (if any) in which the goods are exposed for sale; or
 - (c) on a price ticket or tag fixed to such goods or such container; or

(d) op 'n prysplakkaat wat op of in die onmiddellike nabyheid van sodanige goedere of houer vertoon moet word;
met dien verstande dat in gevalle waar die goedere op paalementterme aangebied word, die kontantprys gemerk moet word in syfers en letters wat minstens drie maal so groot is as dié wat gebruik word vir die merk van die periodieke paalement.

(3) Vir die toepassing van hierdie kennisgewing— sluit „kleinhandelaar” elke handelaar in behalwe (a) 'n handelaar wat goedere slegs aan ander handelaars verkoop, of (b) 'n handelaar wie se gewone besigheid bestaan uit die verkoop van goedere aan ander handelaars maar wat ook aan persone wat nie handelaars is nie, goedere verkoop of bereid is om hulle te verkoop teen dieselfde prys as dié waarteen hy die goedere aan ander handelaars verkoop; beteken „kleinhandelkontantverkoopprys” die kontantprys waarteen goedere aan persone wat nie handelaars is nie, verkoop word of vir verkoop aan sulke persone vertoon word.

(4) Goedere wat in 'n winkelvenster of buitevertoonkas uitgestal word, word beskou as vir verkoop vertoon ten spyte daarvan dat die publiek gewoonlik nie tot dié gedeelte van die handelaar se perseel wat onmiddellik aan die venster of vertoonkas grens of daaragter is, toegelaat word nie.

2. Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1233 van 12 Junie 1953 (Merk van Pryse op Goedere) word hierby ingetrek.

OPMERKINGS.

1. Die uitwerking van hierdie kennisgewing is dat daar van kleinhandelaars wat goedere vir verkoop op paalementterme vertoon, vereis word om sowel die kontantprys as die paalement te merk en om aan te toon of dit 'n weeklikse of maandelikse paalement is, ens. Die kontantprys moet gemerk word met letters en syfers wat drie maal so groot is as dié wat gebruik word om die paaemente aan te du. As die paalement bv. in letters en syfers van $\frac{1}{2}$ duim aangetoon word, moet die kontantprys in letters van $1\frac{1}{2}$ duim aangetoon word.

2. Kleinhandelverkoopprys moet nie slegs deur kleinhandelaars op goedere gemerk word nie, maar ook deur groothandelaars wat ook kleinhandelaars is.

3. Die bepalings van hierdie kennisgewing is van toepassing op goedere waarvan die pryse van beheer onthef is.

4. Die aandag word gevëstig op die bepalings van paragraaf (L) (ii) van regulasie 17 van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 49 van 1946 ingevolge waarvan dit 'n oortreding is om goedere met 'n hoër prys as die maksimum prys (as daar een is) te merk.

MAKSIMUM PRYSE VAN SEMENT.

Ek, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Pryskontroleur, handelende kragtens regulasie 3 van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 49 van 1946, wysig Goewermentskennisgewing No. 932 van 1 Mei 1953 (Maksimum Pryse van Sement) hierby deur die maksimum prys wat daarin aangegee word, met twee en 'n halfpennie per sak te verhoog.

OPMERKING.—Die uitwerking van hierdie kennisgewing is om die bestaande maksimum prys van cement met $2\frac{1}{2}$ d. per sak te verhoog vanweë die verhoogde spoorwegtariewe.

(d) on a price placard which shall be kept displayed on or in immediate proximity to such goods or such container; provided that in cases in which the goods are offered on instalment terms the cash price shall be marked in figures and lettering at least three times as great as those used for marking the periodical instalment.

(3) for the purpose of this notice—

“retail dealer” includes every dealer other than (a) a dealer who sells goods to other dealers only, or (b) a dealer whose ordinary business it is to sell goods to other dealers, but who also sells or is prepared to sell goods to persons, who are not dealers, at the same price at which he sells such goods to other dealers;

“retail cash selling price” means the cash price at which goods are sold or exposed for sale to persons who are not dealers;

(4) goods exhibited in a shop window or external show case shall be regarded as exposed for sale notwithstanding that the public may not normally be admitted to that portion of the dealer's premises immediately adjacent to or behind such window or show case.

Grant exemption from the provisions of the regulations contained in the Annexure to War Measure No. 49 of 1946 to any person in the sale by him to any other person of any article in respect of which a maximum price was fixed by any notice quoted in paragraph 8 of Government Notice No. 2758 of 23rd December, 1949 (Maximum Prices of Groceries), or by Government Notice No. 2029 of 23rd September, 1949 (Freezing of Prices), and for which a maximum price is not fixed in the Second, Third or Fourth Schedule hereto.

1. A place specifically named means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authority at such place and, except in the case of Cape Town, includes all places within five miles of the boundary of such area.

2. "Cape Town" means the area under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Cape Town and includes all places within ten miles of the boundary of such area.

3. "Witwatersrand" means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authorities at Alberton, Alexandra Township, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Edenvale, Elsburg, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempston Park, Krugersdorp, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg and Springs and includes all places within five miles of the boundary of the area falling under the jurisdiction of any of the places just mentioned.

4. (a) Distances must be calculated by taking the mileage of the shortest railway route from the named railway station from which the goods in question are usually obtained to the railway station or siding to which they are generally consigned plus the mileage of the shortest distance by road from the last-mentioned railway station or siding to the place of sale; provided that where goods are normally transported by pont and are subject to a charge for such service, the road distance thus determinable may be increased by fifty miles.

(b) The mileage of the shortest railway route shall be determined in accordance with the Supplement No. 1 to the Official Railway Tariff Book No. 24.

5. The expression "nearest railway station or siding" means the station or siding to which the goods are consigned, but excludes Road Motor Service stations or halts, also stations and sidings (other than Port Nolloth station) on the Port Nolloth-Okiep railway line.

6. The expression "Retail Price" refers to a price determinable in accordance with the Fourth Schedule and the expression "Wholesale Price" means a price determinable in accordance with the Third Schedule.

7. Any fraction of a penny in the maximum price in terms of the Fourth Schedule, for a sale at any one time of any goods specified in the said Schedules, whether it be the price of a single unit in the case of a sale of such single unit or the price resulting from the computation of the price applicable to any number of such units in the case of a sale of more than one unit, shall, if less than a halfpenny, be regarded as a halfpenny, and if more than a halfpenny, be regarded as a penny.

8. The prices specified in or determinable in accordance with this notice are the maximum prices at which the goods in question may be sold either for cash or for credit not exceeding sixty days calculated from the date of the monthly statement in which the purchase of the goods is reflected. In the case of a credit sale for a term exceeding that just mentioned, interest at six per cent per annum may be added.

9. The maximum wholesale prices specified in or determinable in accordance with the provisions of the Third Schedule relate to unbroken packages as supplied by the manufacturer. For "open-stock" sales an amount not exceeding $3\frac{3}{4}$ per cent may be added to such prices.

10. In cases where the maximum prices that may be charged by a dealer who sells at wholesale prices are determined by the addition of a stated percentage to the manufacturer's price such percentage may be added to the manufacturer's price prior to the deduction therefrom of any cash discount not exceeding $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.

11. The provisions in the Fourth Schedule relating to allowances for road transportation shall not apply in Zululand. The allowance for road transport that may be added to the maximum retail prices of commodities sold in Zululand at places that are more than five miles from the nearest railway station or siding shall be calculated at the rate of a halfpenny per lb. in the case of places that are more than five miles but not more than fifty miles and at the rate of a penny per lb. in the case of places that are more than fifty miles from the nearest railway station or siding.

12. In terms of regulation 3 (4) of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, the maximum price of any portion or quantity of any goods to which this notice relates, shall, if the maximum price for such portion or quantity has not been specifically fixed—

- (1) if the portion or quantity sold or purchased is more than the amount or quantity for which the maximum price has been fixed, be proportionate to the maximum price fixed for the largest amount or quantity that is less than the portion or quantity sold or purchased; and
