MAXIMUM PRICES OF DRIED FRUIT.—
AMENDMENT.

In terms of section *twenty-nine* of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), as amended, I, STEPHANUS PETRUS LE ROUX, Minister of Agriculture, hereby make known that the Dried Fruit Board, referred to in section 2 of the Dried Fruit Scheme, published by Proclamation No. 332 of 1949, has, in terms of section 18 of the said scheme, and with my approval, amended the prohibition made known by Government Notice No. 347 of 9th February, 1951, as amended, in the manner indicated in the Annexure hereto.

And I further make known that the said amendment shall become operative on the date of publication of this notice.

- (iv) may be increased by 3½d. per lb. if the fruit is sold packed in "Flav-O-Tainer" bags;
- (v) may be increased by 3½d. per lb. if the fruit is sold packed in wrapped cardboard packs;
- (vi) may be increased by 3½d. per lb. if the fruit is sold packed in ½-lb. transparent bags.

- (b) The foregoing prices [increased, where permissible, in terms of paragraph (a) hereof] apply to sales at Cape Town and at places up to and including 100 miles from the railway station at Cape Town. At places that are more than 100 miles but not more than 450 miles from the railway station at Cape Town these prices may be increased by ½d. per lb. At places that are more than 450 miles from the railway station at Cape Town these prices may be increased by ¼d. per lb.

- (c) The foregoing prices [increased, where permissible, in terms of paragraph (a) and/or paragraph (b)] may be further increased by the addition of ¼d. per lb. for every 20 miles or part thereof beyond the first 10 miles from the nearest railway station or siding.

WITHDRAWAL OF SPECIAL LEVY ON
DRIED FRUIT.

In terms of sub-section (1) of section *twenty-nine* of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), as amended, I, STEPHANUS PETRUS LE ROUX, Minister of Agriculture, hereby make known that the Dried Fruit Board, referred to in section 2 of the Dried Fruit Scheme, published under Proclamation No. 332 of 1949, as amended, has under the powers vested in it by section 20 of the said scheme and with my approval withdrawn the special levy of £2 per 2,000 lb. nett weight of the dried fruit known as stalk raisins, stalk muscatels and loose muscatels, imposed by Government Notice No. 1202 of 1951, which is hereby repealed.

And I do further make known that the said special levy shall not be payable in respect of any of the said dried fruit forming part of the 1954 crop or produced after the date of publication of this notice.

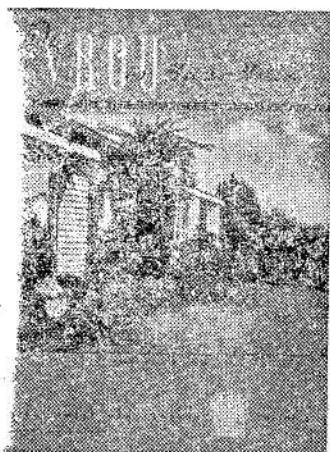
PROHIBITION ON THE SALE OF DRIED FRUIT.—

And I do further make known that the said prohibition shall not be applicable to raisins of the 1954 crop or raisins produced after the date of publication of this notice.
