PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HONOURABLE ERNEST GEORGE JANSEN, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

REAPPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE SPECIAL COURTS FOR HEARING INCOME TAX APPEALS.

Whereas by Proclamation No. 6 of 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General did by virtue of the powers vested in him by sub-section (5) (a) of section *seventy-nine* of the Income Tax Act, 1941, appoint the following persons as members of the Special Courts for hearing income tax appeals, constituted under the provisions of sub-section (3) of that section:—

As an accountant member thereof:—

Henry Edmond Bird, of Johannesburg.

As commercial members thereof:—

Thomas Holding Schutte, of Johannesburg.

William Rowland Whiting, of Johannesburg;

And whereas the appointments of the aforementioned members expired on the 12th December, 1954;

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by the first proviso to sub-section (5) (a) of section *seventy-nine* of the Income Tax Act, 1941, I do hereby reappoint the aforementioned persons as members of the said Special Courts for hearing income tax appeals for a further period of five years from the date of this Proclamation, subject to the provisions of the said sub-section (5) (a) of section *seventy-nine* of the Income Tax Act, 1941;

And further, in terms of the provisions of the said sub-section (5) (a) of the said section, I do hereby appoint as a member of the said Special Courts for hearing income tax appeals, the following person:—

As an accountant member thereof:—

Barry Sluyter Wichahn, of Pretoria.
