PROROGASIE EN BYEENROEPING VAN DIE PARLEMENT.

NADEMAAL artikel *twintig* van die Zuid-Afrika Wet,
1909, bepaal dat die Goewerneur-generaal na goeëdunke tye
vir die hou van die sessies van die Parlement kan vasstel,
en ook die Parlement van tyd tot tyd by proklamasie of
andersins kan prorogeer;

EN NADEMAAL dit raadsaam is om die Parlement te
prorogeer en op te roep om weer byeen te kom;

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen,
by hierdie proklamasie—

- (i) die Parlement tot Vrydag, die Agtiende dag
van Januarie 1957 prorogeer; en
- (ii) die Parlement oproep om op daardie datum
byeen te kom, en hierby verklaar dat die Vyfde
Sessie van die Elfde Parlement van die Unie
van Suid-Afrika op Vrydag, die Agtiende dag van
Januarie 1957 te Kaapstad 'n aanvang sal neem
vir die afhandeling van sake.

PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HONOURABLE ERNEST GEORGE
JANSSEN, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF
THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

PROROGATION AND SUMMONING OF PARLIAMENT.

WHEREAS by section *twenty* of the South Africa Act,
1909, it is provided that the Governor-General may appoint
such times for holding the sessions of Parliament as he
thinks fit, and may also from time to time, by proclamation
or otherwise, prorogue Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that Parliament shall
be prorogued and summoned to meet again;

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the power
and authority vested in me, I do by this my proclamation—

- (i) prorogue Parliament until Friday, the Eighteenth
day of January, 1957; and
- (ii) summon Parliament to meet on that day and
hereby declare that the Fifth Session of the
Eleventh Parliament of the Union of South
Africa will commence at Cape Town on Friday,
the Eighteenth day of January, 1957, for the
dispatch of business.
