MEALIE CONTROL SCHEME.

PRICES OF MEALIES AND MEALIE PRODUCTS.—AMENDMENT.

In terms of sub-section (1) of section *twenty-nine* of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), as amended, I, STEPHANUS PETRUS LE ROUX, Minister of Agriculture, do hereby make known that the Mealie Industry Control Board, referred to in section 3 of the Mealie Control Scheme, published by Proclamation No. 99 of 1955, has, in terms of section 25 of that Scheme and with my approval, amended the prohibitions made known by Government Notice No. 743 of 27th April, 1956, in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto.

And I do hereby further make known that the said amendment shall come into operation as from date of publication hereof.
