DIE SUID-AFRIKAANSE VERPLEEGSTERS- RAAD.

REGULASIES VIR DIE OPLEIDING EN EKSAMI- NEER VIR DIE SERTIFIKAAT IN OPERASIE- SAALTEGNIK.

Die Minister van Gesondheid het, in uitoefening van die bevoegdheid hom verleen by subartikel (1) van artikel elf van die Wet op Verpleging, 1957 (Wet No. 69 van 1957), sy goedkeuring geheg aan die volgende regulasies betreffende die opleiding en eksamineer vir die sertifikaat in operasiesaaltegniek, gemaak deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Verpleegstersraad ter vervanging van die regulasies afgekondig by Goewermenskennisgewing No. 2318 van 23 Oktober 1953, soos gewysig by Goewermenskennisgewing No. 104 van 21 Januarie 1955:—

1. VEREISTES VIR TOELATING TOT OPLEIDING.

'n Kandidaat vir toelating tot opleiding moet aan die persoon in beheer van die opleidingskool voorle—

- (1) bewys van lopende registrasie ingevolge die Wet as 'n algemene verpleegster;
- (2) bewys van minstens twee jaar ondervinding, alles-insluitende, as 'n geregistreerde verpleegster in die operasiesaal van 'n inrigting of inrigtings deur die raad goedgekeur.

OPMERKING.—Ooreenkomstig Goewermenskennisgewing No. 1129 van 8 Augustus 1958, moet 'n leerling 'n aansoek om registrasie binne ses (6) weke na die datum van aanvangs van opleiding by die raad indien.

2. OPLEIDINGSKOLE.

(1) 'n Opleidingskool bestaan uit 'n hospitaal of groep hospitale wat, na die raad se oordeel, weens die gehalte en omvang van die materiaal en onderrig aldaar verskaf, geskik is om kandidate op te lei in die aangeleenthede wat in hierdie regulasies voorgeskryf is.

(2) Geen hospitaal of groep hospitale word as 'n opleidingskool goedgekeur nie, tensy—

- (a) bewys tot tevredenheid van die raad gelewer word dat in die hospitaal of groep hospitale fasiliteite beskikbaar is vir leerlinge om operasies in die volgende by te woon:—

Snykunde (algemeen);
Ginekologie;
Urologie;
Ortopedie;
Oogheelkunde;
Oor-, neus- en keelheelkunde;

- (b) bewys tot tevredenheid van die raad gelewer word dat in die hospitaal of groep hospitale fasiliteite beskikbaar is vir leerlinge om onderrig in verdoingsleer te ontvang;

- (c) alle lede van die verpleegpersoneel wat aan die opleiding van leerlingverpleegsters deelneem, geregistreerde algemene verpleegsters is, en dat die

THE SOUTH AFRICAN NURSING COUNCIL.

REGULATIONS FOR THE TRAINING AND EXAMINATION FOR THE CERTIFICATE IN OPERATING THEATRE TECHNIQUE.

The Minister of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sub-section (1) of section eleven of the Nursing Act, 1957 (Act No. 69 of 1957), has approved of the following regulations regarding the training and examination for the certificate in operating theatre technique, made by the South African Nursing Council in substitution for the regulations published under Government Notice No. 2318 of the 23rd October, 1953, as amended by Government Notice No. 104 of the 21st January, 1955:—

1. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO TRAINING.

A candidate for admission to training shall submit to the person in charge of the training school—

- (1) proof of current registration under the Act as a general nurse;
- (2) proof of at least two years of experience as a registered nurse in all in the operating theatre of an institution or institutions approved of by the council.

NOTE.—In terms of Government Notice No. 1129 of the 8th August, 1958, a student shall lodge an application for registration with the council within six (6) weeks of the date of commencement of training.

2. TRAINING SCHOOLS.

(1) A training school shall consist of a hospital or group of hospitals which, in the opinion of the council, is competent through the quality and extent of the material and instruction given thereat to train candidates in the matters prescribed in these regulations.

(2) No hospital or group of hospitals shall be approved of as a training school, unless—

- (a) proof is furnished to the satisfaction of the council that in the hospital or group of hospitals facilities are available for students to attend operations in the following:—

Surgery (general);
Gynaecology;
Urology;
Orthopaedics;
Ophthalmology;
Otorhinolaryngology;

- (b) proof is furnished to the satisfaction of the council that in the hospital or group of hospitals facilities are available for students to be instructed in anaesthetics;

- (c) all members of the nursing staff who take part in the training of students are registered general nurses, and the person in charge of the operating

persoon in die beheer van die operasie-afdeling vir die opleiding van leerlinge 'n algemene verpleegster is teenoor wie se naam 'n sertifikaat in operasiesaal-tegniek as 'n addisionele kwalifikasie geregistreer is; met dien verstande dat die raad gedurende sodanige tussentydperk as wat hy nodig mag ag, 'n geregistreerde algemene verpleegster teenoor wie se naam so 'n sertifikaat nie geregistreer is nie, maar wat 'n bevredigende diens tydperk van minstens twee jaar gelewer het in die hoedanigheid van toezighoudende operasiesaalsuster in 'n hospitaal wat deur die raad goedgekeur is, mag toelaat om in beheer van die opleiding te wees;

- (d) leerlinge minstens een dag per week vry gegee word wanneer hulle opleiding op dagdiens ontvang en minstens een nag per week wanneer hulle opleiding op nagdiens ontvang;
- (e) leerlinge by toelating tot opleiding geneeskundig ondersoek word;
- (f) die geregistreerde algemene verpleegster in beheer van die hospitaal aangedui staan as die persoon in beheer van die opleidingskool;
- (g) in die geval waar 'n opleidingskool wat uit 'n groep hospitale bestaan, 'n skema vir die oorplasing van leerlinge na die verskillende hospitale gedurende hulle opleidingstydperk, wat die soort opleiding aandui wat aan elke hospitaal deurloop moet word, aan die raad voorgelê word vir goedkeuring; met dien verstande dat 'n goedgekeurde skema onderhewig is aan wysiging na goeddunke van die raad;
- (h) die raad of 'n persoon wat opdrag daartoe van die raad het, die reg het om 'n opleidingskool te eniger tyd te inspekteer en om sodanige inligting as wat nodig geag mag word, te vra;
- (i) die raad te alle tye die reg het om sodanige inligting as wat hy nodig mag ag van 'n opleidingskool te vra, en op enige saak waar sy vereistes blykbaar nie behoorlik nagekom word nie, of op enige saak wat na sy mening die opleiding van leerlinge benadeel, te wys, en om in enige geval wat onbekend bly sy goedkeuring te weerhou, op te hef of in te trek.

(3) Nieteenstaande die voorwaardes en vereistes in paragraaf (2) vervat, kan die raad na sy goeddunke 'n hospitaal of groep hospitale as 'n opleidingskool goedkeur indien sodanige hospitaal of groep hospitale nie aan een of meer van genoemde voorwaardes en vereistes voldoen nie. Sodanige goedkeuring kan vir sodanige tydperk of op sodanige voorwaardes as wat die raad mag bepaal verleen word.

3. OPLEIDINGSTYDPERK.

(1) Die opleidingstydperk is tweehonderd-en-veertig (250) dae (uitgesonderd dae vry en verlof) wat minstens agt (8) uur elk duur en wat binne 'n tydperk van nie langer nie as vyftien (15) maande voltooi moet word, tensy die raad anders bepaal.

(2) In die geval van 'n oorplasing van een opleidingskool na 'n ander, word opleiding by die eerste opleidingskool deurloop, nie erken nie, tensy die raad anders bepaal.

4. VOORLESINGS EN DEMONSTRASIES.

Elke leerling moet—

- (1) minstens twaalf (12) lesings en demonstrasies in operasiesaaltegniek bywoon, met inbegrip van alle metodes van herstel van bewussyn;
- (2) minstens vyftien (15) lesings en minstens vyftien (15) demonstrasies oor die verpleegster se pligte in die saal vir operasies genoem in regulasie 2 (2) (a) bywoon;
- (3) minstens drie (3) lesings en minstens drie (3) demonstrasies oor die voorbereiding vir narkose bywoon;
- (4) minstens vyf-en-veertig (45) lesings en demonstrasies oor instrumente vir alle tipes operasies bywoon;
- (5) minstens twaalf (12) lesings oor toegepaste anatomie bywoon.

5. PRAKTISE OPLEIDING.

Elke leerling moet die operasiesaalsuster met minstens twee (2) operasies bystaan, by minstens twee (2) operasies as operasiesaalsuster onder toezig van die operasiesaalsuster optree en as die verantwoordelike operasiesaalsuster

department for the training of students is a general nurse against whose name a certificate in operating theatre technique is registered as an additional qualification; provided that the council may, during such interim period as it may deem necessary permit a registered general nurse against whose name such a certificate is not registered but who has satisfactorily served for a period of not less than two years as a supervising theatre sister in a hospital approved of by the council, to be in charge of the training;

- (d) students are allowed at least one day off-duty per week when in training on day duty and at least one night off-duty per week when in training on night duty;
- (e) students are medically examined on admission to training;
- (f) the registered general nurse in charge of the hospital is designated as the person in charge of the training school;
- (g) in the case of a training school consisting of a group of hospitals a scheme for the posting of students to the various hospitals during their period of training, indicating the type of training to be undergone at each hospital, is submitted for the council's approval; provided that any approved scheme shall be subject to amendment at the council's discretion;
- (h) the council, or a person deputed thereto by the council, shall have the right to inspect a training school at any time and to call for such information as may be deemed necessary;
- (i) the council shall at all times have the right to call for such information from a training school as it may deem fit and to point out any matter in which its requirements appear to be insufficiently met, or any matter which in its opinion adversely affects the training of students, and to withhold, suspend or withdraw approval in any case which remains unsatisfactory.

(3) Notwithstanding the conditions and requirements set out in paragraph (2), the council may, in its discretion, approve of a hospital or of a group of hospitals as a training school if such hospital or group of hospitals does not comply with one or more of the said conditions and requirements. Such approval may be granted for such period and upon such conditions as the council may determine.

3. PERIOD OF TRAINING.

(1) The period of training shall be two hundred and fifty (250) days (excluding days off and leave) of at least eight (8) hours duration each and shall be completed within a period of not more than fifteen (15) months, unless the council determines otherwise.

(2) In the case of a transfer from one training school to another, training undergone at the first training school shall not be recognised, unless the council determines otherwise.

4. LECTURES AND DEMONSTRATIONS.

Every student shall attend—

- (1) at least twelve (12) lectures and demonstrations in theatre technique, including preparation for all forms of resuscitation;
- (2) at least fifteen (15) lectures and at least fifteen (15) demonstrations covering the nurse's duties in the theatre for operations, referred to in regulation 2 (2) (a);
- (3) at least three (3) lectures and at least three (3) demonstrations in the preparation for anaesthetics;
- (4) at least forty-five (45) lectures and demonstrations on instruments for all types of operations;
- (5) at least twelve (12) lectures in applied anatomy.

5. PRACTICAL TRAINING.

Every student shall assist the theatre sister at not less than two (2) operations, shall act as theatre sister under the supervision of the theatre sister at not less than two (2) operations, and shall act as the responsible theatre

6. DIE EKSAMEN.

(1) Dwarsdeur die opleidingskursus moet 'n operasiesuster deur die raad aangestel aan elke leerling punte toeken vir operasiesaaltegniek, met inbegrip van die regmaak van die tafel en voorbereiding vir 'n operasie. 'n Sertifikaat van bevredigende prestasie moet aan die einde van elke leerling se opleidingskursus by die raad ingedien word.

(2) Die eksamen bestaan uit twee gedeeltes naamlik—

(a) 'n skriftelike eksamen wat twee (2) uur duur. Hierdie gedeelte tel veertig (40) persent van die gemiddelde puntetal;

(b) 'n mondelinge en praktiese eksamen. Hierdie gedeelte tel sestig (60) persent van die gemiddelde puntetal.

7. TOELATING TOT DIE EKSAMEN.

'n Kandidaat vir toelating tot 'n eksamen moet die volgende aan die raad voorleë:—

(1) 'n Sertifikaat deur die persoon in beheer van die opleidingskool—

(a) dat die kandidaat teen die datum van die eksamen aan regulasies 4 en 5 sal voldoen het;

(b) dat die kandidaat die opleidingstydperk voorgeskryf in regulasie 3 nie later nie as die laaste dag van die maand waarin die eksamen gehou word, sal voltooi;

(2) 'n aansoek om toelating ooreenkomstig regulasie 8.

8. DATUMS VAN EKSAMENS, AANSOEKE OM TOELATING EN HERTOELATING EN EKSAMENFOOIE.

(1) Die persoon in beheer van 'n opleidingskool moet die raad onmiddellik in kennis stel, en volle besonderhede verstrek, indien 'n leerling om enige rede hoegenaamd nie meer na indiening van 'n aansoek om toelating of hertoelating ooreenkomstig hierdie regulasie tot 'n eksamen toegelaat kan word nie.

(2) Die eksamen word vierkeer per jaar gedurende die maande Februarie, Mei, Augustus en November gehou, en aansoeke om toelating en hertoelating moet op of voor 7 Desember, 7 Maart, 7 Junie en 7 September, onderskeidelik, by die raad ingedien word.

(3) 'n Bedrag van drie ghienies (£3. 3s.) moet by die eerste aansoek om toelating tot die eksamen aan die raad betaal word.

'n Bedrag van twee ghienies (£2. 2s.) moet by elke aansoek om hertoelating betaal word.

(4) 'n Aansoek binne sewe (7) dae na die sluitingsdatum voorgeskryf vir die indiening van aansoeke om toelating en hertoelating tot 'n eksamen ingedien, word slegs by betaling van 'n addisionele bedrag van een ghienie (£1. 1s.) aangeneem.

(5) 'n Aansoek langer as sewe (7) dae na die sluitingsdatum voorgeskryf vir indiening van aansoeke om toelating of hertoelating tot 'n eksamen ingedien, word nie aangeneem nie.

(6) 'n Aansoek om toelating of hertoelating tot 'n eksamen word nie as ingedien beskou nie, tensy 'n aansoekvorm, behoorlik ingevul, sodanige sertifikate as wat van toepassing mag wees, die eksamenfooi, en waar van toepassing, die bedrag voorgeskryf in paragraaf (4), die raad bereik het.

(7) Eksamengelde word nie terugbetaal of op 'n daaropvolgende eksamen oorgedra in 'n geval waar 'n kandidaat haar aansoek om toelating of hertoelating tot 'n eksamen terugtrek of van 'n eksamen afwesig is nie, tensy die raad anders bepaal.

9. HERTOELATING TOT DIE EKSAMEN.

Na elke mislukte poging tot die eksamen, moet 'n leerling 'n verdere opleidingstydperk van ses (6) maande deurloop, gedurende welke tydperk sy 'n eweredige aantal voorlesings en demonstrasies, en die helfte van die aantal operasies genoem in regulasies 4 en 5, onderskeidelik, moet bywoon.

sister at not less than two (2) operations, in each of the types of operations referred to in regulation 2 (2) (a) and shall scrub up for the operations concerned.

6. THE EXAMINATION.

(1) Throughout the course of training a theatre sister appointed by the council shall mark each student on theatre technique, including the setting of the table and the preparation for an operation. A certificate of satisfactory performance shall be submitted to the council at the conclusion of each student's course of training.

(2) The examination shall consist of two portions being—

(a) a written examination of two (2) hours duration. This portion shall carry forty (40) per cent of the aggregate marks;

(b) an oral and practical examination. This portion shall carry sixty (60) per cent of the aggregate marks.

7. ADMISSION TO THE EXAMINATION.

A candidate for admission to an examination shall lodge with the council—

(1) a certificate from the person in charge of the training school—

(a) that by the date of the examination the candidate will have complied with regulations 4 and 5;

(b) that the candidate will complete the period of training prescribed in regulation 3 not later than the last day of the month in which the examination is held;

(2) an application for admission in terms of regulation 8.

8. DATES OF EXAMINATION, APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION AND RE-ADMISSION AND EXAMINATION FEES.

(1) The person in charge of a training school shall inform the Council forthwith, giving full particulars, if for any reason a student becomes ineligible for admission to an examination subsequent to the lodging of an application for admission or re-admission in terms of this regulation.

(2) The examination shall be held four times a year, during the months of February, May, August and November, and applications for admission and re-admission shall be lodged with the council on or before the 7th December, the 7th March, the 7th June and the 7th September respectively.

(3) A fee of three guineas (£3. 3s.) shall be paid to the council upon the first application for admission to the examination.

A fee of two guineas (£2. 2s.) shall be paid upon each application for re-admission.

(4) An application lodged within seven (7) days after the closing date prescribed for the lodging of applications for admission or re-admission to an examination, shall be accepted only on payment of an additional fee of one guinea (£1. 1s.).

(5) An application lodged more than seven (7) days after the closing date prescribed for the lodging of applications for admission or re-admission to an examination, shall not be accepted.

(6) An application for admission or re-admission to an examination shall not be deemed to have been lodged unless an application form, duly completed, such certificates as may be applicable, the examination fee and, where applicable, the fee prescribed in paragraph (4) shall have reached the council.

(7) Examination fees shall not be refunded or carried forward to a succeeding examination in the event of a candidate withdrawing her application for admission or re-admission to an examination or being absent from an examination, unless the council determines otherwise.

9. RE-ADMISSION TO THE EXAMINATION.

After each unsuccessful attempt at the examination, a student shall undergo a further period of training of six (6) months during which time she shall attend a proportionate number of lectures and demonstrations and half the number of operations referred to in regulations 4 and 5 respectively.

10. EKSAMENPUNTE.

(1) Suksesvolle kandidate word aangedui as „geslaag” of „geslaag met lof”.

(2) Om in die eksamen te slaag, moet 'n kandidaat minstens vyftig (50) persent gemiddeld, en minstens sestig (60) persent in die gedeelte van die eksamen waarna in regulasie 6 (2) (b) verwys word, behaal.

(3) Om met lof te slaag, moet 'n kandidaat minstens vyf-en-sewentig (75) persent gemiddeld, en minstens vyf-en-sewentig (75) persent in die gedeelte van die eksamen waarna in regulasie 6 (2) (b) verwys word, behaal.

(4) Kandidate word nie in volgorde van verdienste geplaas nie en geen inligting aangaande punte of plekke van kandidate word verstrek nie, behalwe in verband met 'n prys of toekenning deur die raad goedgekeur.

11. EKSAMENSENTRUMS.

Eksamens word op sodanige plekke afgeneem as wat die raad mag bepaal.

12. EKSAMINATORE.

Eksaminatore word deur die raad aangestel. Die raad kan 'n moderator vir die skriftelike gedeelte van die eksamen aanstel.

13. REGISTRASIE VAN ADDISIONELE KWALIFIKASIE EN SERTIFIKAAT VAN VOLTOOIING VAN OPLEIDING.

Aan 'n kandidaat wat in die eksamen geslaag het, word 'n sertifikaat van registrasie van 'n addisionele kwalifikasie sonder betaling van 'n fooi uitgereik; met dien verstande dat so 'n sertifikaat nie uitgereik word nie alvorens—

- (1) 'n kennisgewing van voltooiing van opleiding ooreenkomstig regulasie 4 (3) van Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1129 by die raad ingedien is;
- (2) die sertifikaat voorgeskryf in regulasie 6 (1) by die raad ingedien is.

14. OPLEIDING VAN ALGEMENE VERPLEGERS.

Hierdie regulasies is *mutatis mutandis* op die opleiding van algemene verplegers van toepassing; met dien verstande dat hulle nie op vroulike pasiënte opgelei word nie.

15. TOEPASSING OP DIE GEBIED SUIDWES-AFRIKA.

Hierdie regulasies is in die gebied van toepassing.

DOEANEWET, 1955.—OPLEGGING VAN 'N GEWONE DUMPINGREG (DUMP 11).

Ek, THEOPHILUS EBENHAEZER DÖNGES, Minister van Finansies, handelende kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel drie-en-tagtig van die Doeanewet, No. 55 van 1955, verklaar hierby dat 'n gewone dumpingreg, soos in paragraaf (a) van artikel vier-en-tagtig van genoemde Wet omskryf, op ondergenoemde goedere wat uit ondervermelde gebied in die Unie ingevoer word of wat van daardie gebied afkomstig is, gehef word bo en behalwe enige ander reg wat daarop betaalbaar is, en ingevolge artikel ses-en-tagtig van vermelde Wet maak ek hierby bekend dat die dumpingreg van toepassing is ten opsigte van enige sodanige goedere wat onder items 901 en 933 van die Derde Bylae van daardie Wet ingesluit word.

10. EXAMINATION MARKS.

(1) Successful candidates shall be shown as having “passed” or “passed with honours”.

(2) To pass in the examination, a candidate shall obtain at least fifty (50) per cent in the aggregate and at least sixty (60) per cent in the portion of the examination referred to in regulation 6 (2) (b).

(3) To pass with honours a candidate shall obtain at least seventy-five (75) per cent in the aggregate and at least seventy-five (75) per cent in the portion of the examination referred to in regulation 6 (2) (b).

(4) Candidates shall not be placed in order of merit and no information in regard to marks or places of candidates shall be given, except in connection with a prize or award approved of by the council.

11. EXAMINATION CENTRES.

Examinations shall be held at such places as the council may determine.

12. EXAMINERS.

Examiners shall be appointed by the council. The council may appoint a moderator for the written portion of the examination.

13. REGISTRATION OF ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION AND CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF TRAINING.

A candidate who has passed in the examination shall be issued with a certificate of registration of an additional qualification without the payment of a fee; provided that such certificate shall not be issued until—

- (1) a notice of completion of training in terms of regulation 4 (3) of Government Notice No. 1129 has been lodged with the council;
- (2) the certificate prescribed in regulation 6 (1) has been lodged with the council.

14. TRAINING OF GENERAL NURSES (MALES).

These regulations shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the training of general nurses (males), provided that they shall not be trained on female patients.

15. APPLICATION TO THE TERRITORY OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA.

These regulations shall apply in the territory.

DEPARTMENT OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE.

CUSTOMS ACT, 1955.—IMPOSITION OF AN ORDINARY DUMPING DUTY (DUMP 11).

I, THEOPHILUS EBENHAEZER DÖNGES, Minister of Finance, acting in terms of the powers vested in me by section eighty-three of the Customs Act, No. 55 of 1955, hereby declare that an ordinary dumping duty, as defined in paragraph (a) of section eighty-four of the said Act, shall, in addition to any other duty payable thereon, be levied upon the following goods imported into the Union from, or originating in, the territory mentioned hereunder, and I hereby notify, in terms of section eighty-six of the said Act, that the dumping duty shall apply to any such goods included under items 901 and 933 of the Third Schedule to that Act.
