Kort titel.

1. Die Skatkisrekening word hiermee belas met die somme geld wat nodig mag wees vir die diens van die Unie vir die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1960 eindig, maar gesamentlik hoogstens sesmiljoen seshonderd drie-en-twintigduisend vyfhonderd vyf-en-twintig pond ten laste van die Inkomsterekening benewens die somme waarmee bedoelde Rekening deur die Begrotingswet, 1959 (Wet No. 77 van 1959), belas is.

2. Die Skatkisrekening word verder belas met die somme geld wat nodig mag wees vir die diens van die Unie vir die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1960 eindig, maar gesamentlik hoogstens eenhonderd twee-en-sewentigduisend pond ten laste van die Bantoe-onderwysrekening benewens die somme waarmee bedoelde Rekening deur die Begrotingswet, 1959 (Wet No. 77 van 1959), belas is.

3. Die Skatkisrekening word verder belas met die somme geld wat nodig mag wees vir die diens van die Unie vir die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1960 eindig, maar gesamentlik hoogstens eenmiljoen agt-en-twintigduisend vierhonderd nege-en-veertig pond ten laste van die Leningsrekening benewens die somme waarmee bedoelde Rekening deur die Begrotingswet, 1959 (Wet No. 77 van 1959), belas is.

4. Die geld wat deur hierdie Wet beskikbaar gestel word, moet aangewend word vir die dienste in besonderhede in die aangehegte Bylae vermeld en meer omstandig uiteengesit in die Begroting van Addisionele Uitgawes [U.G. 2—1960], soos deur die Parlement goedgekeur en vir geen ander doel nie.

5. Met goedkeuring van die Minister van Finansies kan 'n besparing onder die een subhoof van 'n begrotingspos aangewend word tot dekking van uitgawes bo die gemagtigde bedrag onder 'n ander subhoof, of van uitgawe onder 'n nuwe subhoof van dieselfde begrotingspos: Met dien verstande dat die somme wat in kolom 2 van die Bylae voorkom, nie oorskry mag word nie, en besparings daarop ewemin aangewend mag word vir enige ander doel as dié waarvoor die geld hierby toegestaan word soos in die gemelde Bylae aangedui.

ACT

To apply a further sum not exceeding seven million eight hundred and twenty-three thousand nine hundred and seventy-four pounds towards the service of the Union for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1960.

*(English text signed by the Governor-General.)
(Assented to 21st March, 1960.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The Exchequer Account is hereby charged with such sums of money as may be required for the service of the Union (and chargeable to the Revenue Account) for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1960, not exceeding in the aggregate six million six hundred and twenty-three thousand five hundred and twenty-five pounds, in addition to the sums with which that Account has been charged by the Appropriation Act, 1959 (Act No. 77 of 1959). Exchequer Account charged with sum not exceeding £6,623,525 on Revenue Account.
2. The Exchequer Account is further charged with such sums of money as may be required for the service of the Union (and chargeable to the Bantu Education Account) for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1960, not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and seventy-two thousand pounds, in addition to the sums with which that Account has been charged by the Appropriation Act, 1959 (Act No. 77 of 1959). Exchequer Account charged with sum not exceeding £172,000 on Bantu Education Account.
3. The Exchequer Account is further charged with such sums of money as may be required for the service of the Union (and chargeable to the Loan Account) for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1960, not exceeding in the aggregate one million twenty-eight thousand four hundred and forty-nine pounds, in addition to the sums with which that Account has been charged by the Appropriation Act, 1959 (Act No. 77 of 1959). Exchequer Account charged with sum not exceeding £1,028,449 on Loan Account.
4. The money appropriated by this Act shall be applied to the services detailed in the Schedule hereto, and more particularly specified in the Estimates of Additional Expenditure [U.G. 2—1960] as approved by Parliament, and to no other purpose. How money to be applied.
5. With the approval of the Minister of Finance, a saving Minister may on any sub-head of a vote may be made available to meet excess expenditure on any other sub-head, or expenditure on a new sub-head of the same vote: Provided that the sums appearing in column 2 of the Schedule shall not be exceeded, nor shall savings thereon be available for any purpose other than that for which the money is hereby granted as indicated in the said Schedule. Minister may approve variation.
6. This Act shall be known as the Additional Appropriation Short title. Act, 1960.

DIT WORD BEPAAL deur Haar Majesteit die Koningin, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Unie van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Skatkisrekening belas met £60,000,000 op Inkomsterekening, £2,000,000 op Bantoe-onderwysrekening en £18,000,000 op Leningsrekening.

Somme ingevolge hierdie Wet uitgereik, word beskou as voorlopige voorskotte.

1. Op en na die eerste dag van April 1960 mag die somme geld gesamentlik ten bedrae van hoogstens sestigmiljoen pond vir inkomstedienste, tweemiljoen pond vir Bantoe-onderwys en agtienmiljoen pond vir leningsdienste wat van tyd tot tyd nodig mag wees vir die diens van die Unie vir die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1961 eindig uit die Skatkisrekening uitgereik word, totdat die Parlement in 'n Begrotswet daarvoor voorsiening maak.

2. Alle somme kragtens die bepalings van hierdie Wet uitgereik, word beskou as voorskotte op rekening van geld wat deur die Parlement in 'n Begrotswet toegestaan sal word vir die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1961 eindig, en by die inwerkingtreding van daardie Begrotswet tree hierdie Wet buite werking en word gelde wat kragtens hierdie Wet reeds uitgereik is, beskou as uitrekings kragtens daardie Begrotswet en moet sodanige uitrekings ooreenkomsdig die bepalings daarvan verantwoord word: Met dien verstande dat daar nie beskou word dat dienste waarvoor geen uitgawe gedurende die boekjaar wat op die een-en-dertigste dag van Maart 1960 eindig, behoorlik kragtens 'n Begrotswet gemagtig is nie, of waarvoor geen wetlike magting bestaan nie, deur artikel een van hierdie Wet gemagtig word nie.

ACT

To apply a sum not exceeding eighty million pounds towards the service of the Union for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1961.

(Afrikaans text signed by the Governor-General.)
(Assented to 21st March, 1960.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:—

1. On and after the first day of April, 1960, there may be issued out of the Exchequer Account such sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of sixty million pounds for revenue services, two million pounds for Bantu education and eighteen million pounds for loan services as may from time to time be required for the service of the Union for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1961, until such time as provision is made therefor by Parliament in an Appropriation Act.

Exchequer Account charged with £60,000,000 on Revenue Account, £2,000,000 on Bantu Education Account and £18,000,000 on Loan Account.

2. All sums issued under the provisions of this Act shall be deemed to be advances on account of grants to be made by Parliament in an Appropriation Act for the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1961, and upon the commencement of such Appropriation Act, this Act shall cease to have effect and issues already made hereunder shall be deemed to be issues under that Appropriation Act, and shall be accounted for in accordance with the provisions thereof: Provided that no services upon which expenditure has not been duly authorised under an Appropriation Act during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1960, or for which there is no statutory authority, shall be deemed to be authorised under section one of this Act.

Sums issued under this Act to be advances in anticipation.

3. This Act shall be known as the Part Appropriation Act, Short title. 1960.
