BYLAE.

Die volgende regulasie word na regulasie 4bis ingevoeg:

VERWYDERING VAN SEKERE PERSONE UIT DIE UNIE.

4ter. Die Minister kan uit hoofde van die omstandighede wat aanleiding gegee het tot die arrestasie en aantding van enige persoon wat kragtens regulasie 4 arresteer is en aangehou word, en wat nie ingevolge bepalings van die Wet op Suid-Afrikaanse Burger-skap, 1949 (Wet No. 44 van 1949) 'n Suid-Afrikaanse burger deur geboorte of afkoms is nie, daardie persoon 'n ongewenste inwoner van die Unie van Suid-Afrika is en kan by bevel onder sy hand bedoelde persoon onverwyld uit die Unie laat verwyder, en enige lanige verklaring en bevel is afdoende en is nie aan pêl na of hersiening deur 'n gereghof onderhewig."

AMENDMENT OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS.

BY VIRTUE of the powers vested in me by the Public Safety Act, 1953 (Act No. 3 of 1953), I hereby amend in accordance with the Annexure hereto, the Emergency Regulations promulgated under Proclamation No. 91 of the 30th March, 1960, and the Emergency Regulations promulgated under Proclamation No. 93 of the 1st April, 1960, as well as the Emergency Regulations promulgated under Proclamation No. 124 of the 11th April, 1960, as amended by Proclamation No. 97 of the 2nd April, 1960, Proclamation No. 127 of the 22nd April, 1960, and Proclamation No. 139 of the 28th April, 1960, and hereby declare that the amendment shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th April, 1960.

ANNEXURE.

The following regulation is inserted after regulation 4bis:

"REMOVAL OF CERTAIN PERSONS FROM THE UNION.

4ter. The Minister may, by reason of the circumstances which gave rise to the arrest and detention of any person who has been arrested and is being detained under regulation 4 and who is not a South African citizen by birth or descent by virtue of the South African Citizenship Act, 1949 (Act No. 44 of 1949), declare that person to be an undesirable inhabitant of the Union of South Africa, and may, by order under his hand, cause such person to be removed forthwith from the Union, and such declaration and order shall be final and shall not be subject to appeal to or review by any court of law."
