

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

Under section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Melrose House, Pretoria, to be a national monument.

Description

Melrose House, as well as the outbuildings, situate on Erven 775 and 776, Pretoria, in the District of Pretoria.

Architectural and Historical Significance

Melrose House is a good example of a Victorian manor house. The Peace of Vereeniging was signed in the dining-room of the house.
