Hierby word bekend gemaak dat die Staatspresident sy goedkeuring geheg het aan die onderstaande Wet wat hierby ter algemene inligting gepubliseer word:—

Wet No. 19, 1972

VEEARTSWYSIGINGSWET, 1972.

WET

Tot wysiging van die Veeartswet, 1933, om teksverbeterings in artikel 1, 3 en 5 aan te bring; om 'n reg op registrasie as veeartse aan sekere persone te verleen; om voorsiening te maak vir skorsing of beperkings waar 'n geregistreerde veearts verstandelik of liggaamlik onbekwaam geword het; om die genoemde Wet in die gebied Suidwes-Afrika toe te pas; en om vir bykomstige aangeleenthede voorsiening te maak.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Wysiging van artikel 1 van Wet 16 van 1933, soos gewysig deur artikel 1 van Wet 49 van 1963.

1. Artikel 1 van die Veeartswet, 1933 (hieronder die Hoofwet genoem), word hierby gewysig—

- (a) deur in paragraaf (a) van subartikel (1) die woorde „Minister van Landbou-tegniese Dienste” deur die woorde „Minister van Landbou” te vervang; en
- (b) deur in paragraaf (c) van daardie subartikel die woorde „Vereniging van Veeartse” deur die woorde „Veterinêre Vereniging” te vervang.

2. Artikel 3 van die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig deur in paragraaf (e) (iii) die woorde „Vereniging van Veeartse” deur die woorde „Veterinêre Vereniging” te vervang.

3. Artikel 5 van die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig deur in subartikel (1) die woorde „Vereniging van Veeartse” deur die woorde „Veterinêre Vereniging” te vervang.

4. Artikel 10 van die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig deur die volgende subartikel by te voeg:

„(4) Elke persoon wie se naam in die Bylae by die Veeartswysigingswet, 1972, verskyn, is daarop geregtig om, teen betaling van registrasiegeld van twintig rand, as veearts ingevolge hierdie Wet geregistreer te word, en die registrateur moet, na betaling van bedoelde geld deur iemand wie se naam aldus verskyn, die betrokke persoon in die register vermeld in artikel 7 inskrywe en aan hom 'n sertifikaat van registrasie as veearts uitreik.”.

VETERINARY AMENDMENT ACT, 1972.

Act No. 19, 1972

ACT

To amend the Veterinary Act, 1933, in order to effect textual improvements in sections 1, 3 and 5; to confer on certain persons a right to be registered as veterinarians; to provide for suspension or restrictions where a registered veterinarian has become mentally or physically disabled; to apply the said Act in the territory of South-West Africa; and to provide for incidental matters.

(Assented to 23rd March, 1972.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 1 of the Veterinary Act, 1933 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended—
 (a) by the substitution in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) for the words "Minister of Agricultural Technical Services", of the words "Minister of Agriculture"; and
 (b) by the deletion in paragraph (c) of that subsection of the word "Medical".
Amendment of section 1 of Act 16 of 1933, as amended by section 1 of Act 49 of 1963.
2. Section 3 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion in paragraph (e) (iii) of the word "Medical".
Amendment of section 3 of Act 16 of 1933, as amended by section 2 of Act 49 of 1963.
3. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion in subsection (1) of the word "Medical".
Amendment of section 5 of Act 16 of 1933, as amended by section 3 of Act 49 of 1963.
4. Section 10 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection:
 "(4) Every person whose name appears in the Schedule to the Veterinary Amendment Act, 1972, shall be entitled to registration as a veterinarian under this Act against payment of a registration fee of twenty rand, and the registrar shall, after payment of such fee by any person whose name so appears, enter the person in question upon the register referred to in section 7 and issue to him a certificate of registration as a veterinarian.".

Wet No. 19, 1972**VEEARTSWYSIGINGSWET, 1972.**

Invoeging van artikel 13A in Wet 16 van 1933.

5. Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Hoofwet na artikel 13 ingevoeg:

„Skorsing 13A. (1) Wanneer dit aan die Veeartsraad blyk of beperking dat 'n ingevolge hierdie Wet geregistreerde veearts weens verstandelike verstandelik of liggaamlik in so 'n mate onbekwaam of liggaamlike onbekwaamheid geword het dat dit met die openbare belang in stryd sou wees om hom toe te laat om sy praktyk as veearts voort te sit, kan die Veeartsraad na goedvinde 'n ondersoek *mutatis mutandis* in ooreenstemming met die bepalings van artikels 14 en 15 ten opsigte van daardie persoon hou.

(2) Indien die Veeartsraad na 'n ondersoek ingevolge subartikel (1) bevind dat die persoon ten opsigte van wie die ondersoek gehou is, onbekwaam geword het soos in daardie subartikel beoog, kan hy by skriftelike bevel—

- (a) daardie persoon vir 'n bepaalde tydperk in die beoefening van sy praktyk as veearts of die verrigting van handelinge wat spesiaal tot die beroep van 'n veearts behoort, skors; of
- (b) die voorwaardes oplê wat hy goedvind, onderworpe waaraan daardie persoon geregtig is om sy praktyk as veearts voort te sit.

(3) Die Veeartsraad kan die geldigheidsduur van 'n bevel kragtens subartikel (2) uitgereik, verleng vir 'n tydperk deur hom bepaal, of so 'n bevel intrek of wysig.

(4) Iemand op wie 'n skorsingsbevel kragtens hierdie artikel van toepassing is, word gedurende die geldigheidsduur daarvan geag nie kragtens hierdie Wet as veearts geregistreer te wees nie.

(5) Iemand wat 'n kragtens subartikel (2) (b) opgelegde voorwaarde oortree of versuim om daaraan te voldoen, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig en by skuldigbevinding strafbaar met 'n boete van hoogstens eenhonderd rand of gevangenisstraf vir 'n tydperk van hoogstens drie maande.”.

Invoeging van artikel 17A in Wet 16 van 1933.

6. Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Hoofwet na artikel 17 ingevoeg:

„Toepassing in Suidwes-Afrika. 17A. Hierdie Wet en 'n wysiging daarvan is ook van toepassing in die gebied Suidwes-Afrika, met inbegrip van die Oostelike Caprivi Zipfel.”.

VETERINARY AMENDMENT ACT, 1972.

Act No. 19, 1972

5. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 13:

"Suspension or restriction on account of mental or physical disability." **13A.** (1) Whenever it appears to the Veterinary Board that a veterinary registered under this Act has become mentally or physically disabled to such an extent that it would be contrary to the public interest to allow him to continue to practise as a veterinarian, it may, if it deems fit, hold an enquiry *mutatis mutandis* in accordance with the provisions of sections 14 and 15 in respect of such person.

(2) If the Veterinary Board, after holding an enquiry under subsection (1), finds that the person in respect of whom the enquiry has been held, has become disabled as contemplated in that subsection, it may, by order in writing—

- (a) suspend that person for a specified period from practising as a veterinarian or performing any acts specially pertaining to the calling of a veterinarian; or
- (b) impose such conditions as it deems fit, subject to which that person shall be entitled to continue to practise as a veterinarian.

(3) The Veterinary Board may extend the period of validity of an order made under subsection (2) for any period determined by it, or withdraw or amend such an order.

(4) A person who is subject to an order of suspension under this section, shall during the period of its validity be deemed not to be registered as a veterinarian under this Act.

(5) Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with a condition imposed under subsection (2) (b), shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred rand or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months.”.

6. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 17:

"Applica- **17A.** This Act and any amendment thereof shall tion in South-West apply also in the territory of South-West Africa, Africa. including the Eastern Caprivi Zipfel.”.

7. This Act shall be called the Veterinary Amendment Act, Short title. 1972.
