WET

Tot wysiging van die Wet op die Beheer van Medisyne en Verwante Stowwe, 1965, ten einde die magtiging van persone as inspekteurs verder te reël; voorsiening te maak vir delegering van bevoegdhede; en die bevoegdheid om regulasies uit te vaardig nader te omskryf.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

artikel 26 van
Wet 101 van 1965,
soos vervang deur
artikel 24 van
Wet 65 van 1974.

1. Artikel 26 van die Wet op die Beheer van Medisyne en Verwante Stowwe, 1965 (hieronder die Hoofwet genoem), word hierby gewysig deur subartikel (2) deur die volgende subartikel te vervang:

„(2) Elke inspekteur moet van 'n deur die Sekretaris ondertekende sertifikaat voorsien word waarin verklaar word dat hy kragtens hierdie Wet as 'n inspekteur gemagtig is.”.

artikel 34A in
Wet 101 van 1965.

2. Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Hoofwet na artikel 34 ingevoeg:

„Delegering van bevoegdhede. 34A. Die Sekretaris kan 'n beampte in die Departement van Gesondheid skriftelik magtig om in die algemeen of in 'n bepaalde geval of in gevalle van 'n bepaalde aard, 'n bevoegdheid, plig of werksaamheid uit te oefen of te verrig wat by of ingevolge hierdie Wet aan die Sekretaris verleen of opgedra is.”.

3. Artikel 35 van die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig—

(a) deur in subartikel (1) paragraaf (xxiii) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:

„(xxiii) tot magtiging en reëling van die koop, verkryging, aanhou of gebruik van gelyste stowwe deur bepaalde persone of klasse persone;”; en

(b) deur in subartikel (1) na paragraaf (xxvi) die volgende paragraaf in te voeg:

„(xxviA) aangaande die prosedure wat gevolg moet word indien 'n gelyste stof onbruikbaar geword het, en die verslag wat ten opsigte daarvan verskaf moet word.”.

MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTROL
AMENDMENT ACT, 1976

Act No. 19, 1976

ACT

To amend the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 1965, so as to further regulate the authorizing of persons as inspectors; to provide for the delegation of powers; and to further define the power to make regulations.

(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 15 March 1976.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 26 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 1965 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following subsection:

Amendment of section 26 of Act 101 of 1965, as substituted by section 24 of Act 65 of 1974.

“(2) Every inspector shall be furnished with a certificate signed by the Secretary and stating that he has been authorized as an inspector under this Act.”.

2. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 34:

Insertion of section 34A in Act 101 of 1965.

“Delegation of powers. 34A. The Secretary may in writing authorize any officer of the Department of Health to exercise or perform in general or in a particular case or in cases of a particular nature, any power, duty or function conferred or imposed on the Secretary by or in terms of this Act.”.

3. Section 35 of the principal Act is hereby amended—

Amendment of section 35 of Act 101 of 1965, as substituted by section 31 of Act 65 of 1974.

(a) by the substitution in subsection (1) for paragraph (xxiii) of the following paragraph:

“(xxiii) authorizing and regulating the purchase, acquisition, keeping or use of Scheduled substances by particular persons or classes of persons;”;

(b) by the insertion in subsection (1) after paragraph (xxvi) of the following paragraph:

“(xxviA) as to the procedure to be followed if a Scheduled substance has become unfit for use, and the report to be furnished in respect thereof;”.

4. This Act shall be called the Medicines and Related Substances Control Amendment Act, 1976.
