WET

Tot wysiging van die Wet op Kerninstallasies (Lisensiëring en Sekerheidstelling), 1963, om voorsiening te maak vir swaarder strawwe vir oortreding van sekere bepalings daarvan.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Vervanging van artikel 11 van Wet 43 van 1963, soos gewysig deur artikel 10 van Wet 91 van 1976.

1. Artikel 11 van die Wet op Kerninstallasies (Lisensiëring en Sekerheidstelling), 1963, word hierby gewysig deur artikel 11 5 deur die volgende artikel te vervang:

„Geheimhouding.

11. Iemand wat sonder magtiging van die raad enige inligting openbaar wat hy by die uitoefening van sy bevoegdhede kragtens hierdie Wet bekom het, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig en by skuldigbevinding 10 strafbaar met **['n boete van hoogstens tweehonderd rand of, by wanbetaling van die boete, met gevangenisstraf vir 'n tydperk van hoogstens ses maande, of met sowel dié boete as dié gevangenisstraf]** die strawwe wat by artikel 34 (iii) van die 15 Wet op Atoomkrag, 1967 (Wet No. 90 van 1967), vir 'n oortreding van artikel 34 (f) van laasgenoemde Wet voorgeskryf word.”.

NUCLEAR INSTALLATIONS
(LICENSING AND SECURITY) AMENDMENT ACT, 1978.

Act No. 22, 1978

ACT

To amend the Nuclear Installations (Licensing and Security) Act, 1963, so as to provide for more severe penalties for a contravention of certain provisions thereof.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 7 March 1978.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 11 of the Nuclear Installations (Licensing and Security) Act, 1963, is hereby amended by the substitution for section 11 of the following section:

“Secrecy.

11. Any person who without the authority of the board, discloses any information obtained by him in the exercise of his powers under this Act, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to **[a fine not exceeding two hundred rand or, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment]** the penalties prescribed by section 34 (iii) of the Atomic Energy Act, 1967 (Act No. 90 of 1967), for a contravention of section 34 (f) of the latter Act.”

Substitution of section 11 of Act 43 of 1963, as amended by section 10 of Act 91 of 1976.

2. This Act shall be called the Nuclear Installations (Licensing and Security) Amendment Act, 1978.

Short title.
