WYSIGINGSWET OP NASIONALE WELSYN, 1978.

WET

Tot wysiging van die Nasionale Welsynswet, 1965, ten einde die bepalings wat verband hou met die omstandighede waaronder persone nie as maatskaplike werkers geregistreer mag word nie, te herroep; en om 'n bykomende misdryf te skep.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Herroeping van artikel 34 van Wet 79 van 1965.

Wysiging van artikel 37 van Wet 79 van 1965.

1. Artikel 34 van die Nasionale Welsynswet, 1965, word hierby herroep. 5

2. Artikel 37 van die Nasionale Welsynswet, 1965, word hierby gewysig deur paragraaf (a) van subartikel (1) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:

„(a) die titel ‚geregistreerde maatskaplike werker‘ gebruik of hom regstreeks of onregstreeks as ‚n geregistreerde 10 maatskaplike werker voordoen of aan ‚n inrigting aan die opleiding van enigiemand in enige aspek van maatskaplike werk deelneem nie tensy hy ingevolge artikel 33 as ‚n maatskaplike werker geregistreer is, hetsy voorwaardelik of andersins of, in die geval van 15 iemand wat aldus aan sodanige opleiding deelneem, aan sodanige inrigting binne ‚n tydperk van vyf jaar na 1 Julie 1966 aangestel was; of‘.”

NATIONAL WELFARE AMENDMENT ACT, 1978.

Act No. 77, 1978

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Words underlined with solid line indicate insertions in existing enactments.

ACT

To amend the National Welfare Act, 1965, so as to repeal the provisions relating to the circumstances under which persons may not be registered as social workers; and to create an additional offence.

(*English text signed by the State President.*)
(Assented to 29 May 1978.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 34 of the National Welfare Act, 1965, is hereby repealed. Repeal of section 34 of Act 79 of 1965.
2. Section 37 of the National Welfare Act, 1965, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph: Amendment of section 37 of Act 79 of 1965.
 - “(a) use the title ‘registered social worker’ or directly or indirectly hold himself out as a registered social worker or take part at any institution in the training of any person in any aspect of social work unless he is registered under section 33, whether conditionally or otherwise, as a social worker or, in the case of a person so taking part in such training, was appointed at such institution within a period of five years after 1 July 1966; or”.
3. This Act shall be called the National Welfare Amendment Act, 1978. Short title.

GENERAL EXPLORATION ACT

ACT

To amend the General Exploration Act, 1908, so as to widen the
provisions relating to the grant of exploration licences, and to
banish from the law all undesirable or doubtful matter, and to
correct any unnecessary offence.

It is the intention of the State President, the Senate and the
House of Assembly to give Royal Assent to the Schedule of Royal Assent to the
Bill.

Section 3 of the Mineral Welfare Act of 1908 is hereby repealed,
and the following section substituted therefor:

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
