WET

Om 'n beperking te plaas op die afdwinging in die Republiek van sekere buitelandse vonnis, bevele, opdragte, arbitrasietoekennings en versoekbrieue; om 'n verbod te plaas op die verstrekking van inligting betreffende ondernemings ingevolge buitelandse bevele, opdragte of versoekbrieue; en om voorsiening te maak vir aangeleenthede wat daarmee in verband staan.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

1. (1) Ondanks 'n andersluidende bepaling van 'n wet of ander regstreeël, en behalwe met die toestemming van die Minister van Ekonomiese Sake—

(a) word geen vonnis, bevel, opdrag, arbitrasietoekenning of versoekbrief wat buite die Republiek gelewer, gegee of uitgereik is, of van buite die Republiek afkomstig is en wat voortspruit uit 'n handeling of transaksie in 10 subartikel (3) bedoel, in die Republiek afgedwing nie;

(b) mag niemand ingevolge 'n bevel, opdrag of versoekbrief wat buite die Republiek uitgereik of van buite die Republiek afkomstig is, enige inligting verstrek nie betreffende enige onderneming, hetsy dit in of buite die 15 Republiek gedryf word.

(2) Die toestemming in subartikel (1) (b) bedoel, kan—

(a) verleen word of by kennisgewing in die Staatskoerant of by skriftelike magtiging aan 'n bepaalde persoon gerig;

(b) verleen word onderworpe aan die voorwaardes wat genoemde Minister goedvind;

(c) betrekking hê slegs op bepaalde goedere of ondernemings of klasse goedere of ondernemings, of op bevele, opdragte of versoekbrieue in 'n bepaalde land 25 uitgereik of van 'n bepaalde land afkomstig;

(d) indien dit by kennisgewing in die Staatskoerant verleen word, slegs op bepaalde persone of klasse persone betrekking hê.

(3) By die toepassing van subartikel (1) (a) is 'n handeling of transaksie 'n handeling of transaksie wat te eniger tyd, hetsy voor of na die inwerkingtreding van hierdie Wet, plaasgevind het en in verband staan met die produksie, invoer, uitvoer, veredeling, besit, gebruik of verkoop van of eiendomsreg op enige stof of materiaal, van watter aard ook al, hetsy binne, buite, in of uit die 35 Republiek, deur, namens of van produsente van sodanige stof of materiaal.

2. Iemand wat die bepaling van artikel 1 (1) (b) oortree, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig en by skuldigbevinding strafbaar met 'n boete

ACT

To restrict the enforcement in the Republic of certain foreign judgments, orders, directions, arbitration awards and letters of request; to prohibit the furnishing of information relating to businesses in compliance with foreign orders, directions or letters of request; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(Assented to 20 June 1978.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any law or other legal rule, and except with the permission of the Minister of Economic Affairs—
- (a) no judgment, order, direction, arbitration award or letters of request delivered, given or issued or emanating from outside the Republic and arising from any act or transaction contemplated in subsection (3), shall be enforced in the Republic;
 - (b) no person shall in compliance with any order, direction or letters of request issued or emanating from outside the Republic, furnish any information as to any business whether carried on in or outside the Republic.
- (2) The permission contemplated in subsection (1) (b) may—
- (a) be granted either by notice in the *Gazette* or by written authority addressed to a particular person;
 - (b) be granted subject to such conditions as the said Minister may deem fit;
 - (c) relate only to specified goods or businesses or classes of goods or businesses, or to orders, directions or letters of request issued in or emanating from a specified country;
 - (d) if it is granted by notice in the *Gazette*, relate only to specified persons or classes of persons.
- (3) In the application of subsection (1) (a) an act or transaction shall be any act or transaction which took place at any time, whether before or after the commencement of this Act, and is connected with the production, importation, exportation, refinement, possession, use or sale of or ownership to any matter or material, of whatever nature, whether within, outside, into or from the Republic, by, on behalf of or of producers of such matter or material.
2. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section 1 (1) Offences and 35 (b) shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction liable to a fine penalties.
