PRIVATE ACT

To amend the Saint Andrew's College Grahamstown (Private) Act, 1932.

(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 12 July 1985.)

Preamble.

WHEREAS for the better administration of Saint Andrew's College, Grahamstown, it is expedient to amend the Saint Andrew's College Grahamstown (Private) Act, 1932 (Act No. 15 of 1932) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), so as to—

- (a) substitute the words "Church of the Province of Southern Africa" for the words "Church of England";
- (b) alter the requirements relative to members of the Council; and
- (c) alter the composition of the Council:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution, in the eighteenth clause of the Trust Deed as substituted by section 2 of the principal Act and in sections 4 and 5 and the First Schedule, for the words "Church of England", wherever they occur, of the words "Church of the Province of Southern Africa".

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the 10 substitution for paragraph (c) of the following paragraph:

"(c) the third clause of the Trust Deed as set forth in the Second Schedule to this Act shall not be amended in such manner as to abolish the **[requirement]** requirements that at least two-thirds of the members of the 15 Council shall be Communicants, the Chairman shall be a Communicant, and the remaining members shall be Christians and members in good standing of their respective churches."

3. The following clause is hereby substituted for the third 20 clause in the Trust Deed and in the Second Schedule to the principal Act:

"THIRD. (1) **[That]** The said Council shall consist of **[nine]** fifteen elected members, of whom **[four shall form a quorum, such members being Communicants of the 25 Church of England, and resident within fifteen miles**

NADEMAAL dit vir die beter administrasie van die Saint Andrew's College, Grahamstad, dienstig is om die Saint Andrew's College, Grahamstad (Private) Wet, 1932 (Wet No. 15 van 1932) (hieronder die Hoofwet genoem), te wysig ten einde—

Aanhel.

- (a) die woorde "Church of England" deur die woorde "Church of the Province of Southern Africa" te vervang;
- (b) die vereistes met betrekking tot lede van die raad te verander; en
- (c) die samestelling van die raad te verander:

WORD DAAR DERHALWE BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

1. Die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig deur die woorde "Church of England", waar dit ook al in die agtiende klousule van die trustakte soos deur artikel 2 van die Hoofwet vervang en in artikels 4 en 5 en die Eerste Bylae voorkom, deur die woorde "Church of the Province of Southern Africa" te vervang.

Vervanging van "Church of England" deur "Church of the Province of Southern Africa" in Wet 15 van 1932.

2. Artikel 3 van die Hoofwet word hierby gewysig deur paragraaf (c) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:

Wysiging van artikel 3 van Wet 15 van 1932.

- 15 “(c) die derde klousule van die trustakte, soos uiteengesit in die Tweede Bylae tot hierdie Wet, nie gewysig word op so 'n wyse dat die **[vereiste]** vereistes dat minstens twee derdes van die lede van die raad kommunikante moet wees, die voorsitter 'n kommunikant moet wees, en die oorblywende lede Christene en presterende lede van hul onderskeie kerke moet wees, afgeskaf word nie.”

(2) Five elected members of the Council shall form a quorum.

(3) At least two-thirds of all the members of the Council, both elected and nominated, shall be Communicants, the Chairman shall be a Communicant, and the remaining members shall be Christians and members in good standing of their respective churches. 10

(4) The Council may appoint an alternate to any elected member of the Council not resident within the magisterial district of Albany. 15

(5) At least two-thirds of such alternates shall be Communicants and the remaining alternates shall be Christians and members in good standing of their respective churches. 20

(6) Such alternates shall be entitled to receive copies of all minutes, reports and other documents submitted to the Council from time to time and to attend any meeting of the Council and to participate therein, but shall only be entitled to vote at such a meeting if their respective principals are not present at the meeting when a vote is taken." 25
