DECLARATION OF THE FIRST DAY OF MAY AS A PUBLIC HOLIDAY

Under the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Public Holidays Act, 1952 (Act No. 5 of 1952), I hereby declare the first day of May as a public holiday throughout the Republic to be commemorated as Worker's Day.

Proclamation No. 168, 1988, is hereby withdrawn.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Republic of South Africa at Pretoria this Twenty-fifth day of October, One thousand Nine hundred and Eighty-nine.
