WYSIGINGSWET OP PLAASLIKE RADE (VOLKSRAAD), 1990

WET

Tot wysiging van die Wet op Plaaslike Rade (Volksraad), 1987, ten einde die omskrywing van Minister aan te pas; en die Minister van Begroting en Plaaslike Bestuur te magtig om sekere werksaamhede aan sekere beamptes op te dra; en om voorsiening te maak vir aangeleenthede wat daarmee in verband staan.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Wysiging van artikel 1 van Wet 94 van 1987

1. Artikel 1 van die Wet op Plaaslike Rade (Volksraad), 1987, word hierby gewysig deur die omskrywing van "Minister" deur die volgende omskrywing te 5 vervang:

"Minister" die Minister in die Ministersraad van die Volksraad belas met plaaslike bestuursaangeleenthede;".

Invoeging van artikel 6A in Wet 94 van 1987

2. Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Wet op Plaaslike Rade (Volksraad), 10 1987, na artikel 6 ingevoeg:

"Minister kan sekere werksaamhede aan beamptes opdra

6A. (1) Die Minister kan enige bevoegdheid of plig wat by regulasie kragtens artikel 6 aan hom toevertrou is, deleger of opdra aan 'n beampte in die Staatsdepartement wat deur hom geadministreer word. 15

(2) Iemand aan wie 'n bevoegdheid of plig kragtens subartikel (1) gedelegeer of opgedra is, oefen daardie bevoegdheid uit en verrig daardie plig onderworpe aan die voorskrifte van die Minister."

LOCAL COUNCILS AMENDMENT ACT (HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY),
1990

Act No. 51, 1990

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

ACT

To amend the Local Councils Act (House of Assembly), 1987, so as to adjust the definition of Minister; and to authorize the Minister of the Budget and Local Government to assign certain functions to certain officers; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(Assented to 7 June 1990.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 1 of Act 94 of 1987

1. Section 1 of the Local Councils Act (House of Assembly), 1987, is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "Minister" of the following definition:

"Minister" means the Minister in the Ministers' Council of the House of Assembly charged with local government matters;"

Insertion of section 6A in Act 94 of 1987

2. The following section is hereby inserted in the Local Councils Act (House of Assembly), 1987, after section 6:

"Minister may assign certain functions to officers

- 6A. (1) The Minister may delegate or assign to an officer in the department of State administered by him, any power or duty entrusted to the Minister by regulation under section 6.

(2) A person to whom a power or duty has been delegated or assigned under subsection (1) shall exercise that power and perform that duty subject to the directions of the Minister."

Short title

3. This Act shall be called the Local Councils Amendment Act (House of Assembly), 1990.
