**ACT**

**To amend the Judges' Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act, 1989, so as to provide for the performance of service as Chief Justice by a Chief Justice who has been discharged from active service; and to provide for matters connected therewith.**

*(English text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 23 June 1993.)*

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

**Insertion of section 7A in Act 88 of 1989**

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the Judges' Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act, 1989, after section 7: 5

**“Performance of service as Chief Justice by Chief Justice discharged from active service**

**7A.** (1) A Chief Justice who has been discharged from active service, except a Chief Justice who has been discharged from active service in terms of section 3(1)(b), (c) or (d), may, at the request of the State President, from the date on which he has been discharged from active service, perform service as Chief Justice of South Africa for a period determined by the State President, which shall not extend beyond the date on which such Chief Justice attains the age of 75 years. 10

(2) A Chief Justice who performs service in terms of subsection (1) shall monthly be paid such remuneration as the State President may determine.”. 15

**Short title**

2. This Act shall be called the Judges' Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Amendment Act, 1993. 20

**D**AAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident en die Parlement van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

**Invoeging van artikel 7A in Wet 88 van 1989**

1. Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Wet op Besoldiging en Diensvoorwaardes van Regters, 1989, na artikel 7 ingevoeg:

**"Verrigting van diens as Hoofregter deur Hoofregter wat van aktiewe diens onthef is**

10           **7A. (1) 'n Hoofregter wat van aktiewe diens onthef is, uitgesond**  
          **'n Hoofregter wat ingevolge artikel 3(1)(b), (c) of (d) van aktiewe diens onthef is, kan, op versoek van die Staatspresident, vanaf die datum waarop hy van aktiewe diens onthef is, diens as Hoofregter van Suid-Afrika verrig vir 'n tydperk deur die Staatspresident bepaal, wat hoogstens sal strek tot die datum waarop sodanige Hoofregter die ouderdom van 75 jaar bereik.**

15           **(2) Aan 'n Hoofregter wat ingevolge subartikel (1) diens verrig, word maandeliks die vergoeding betaal wat die Staatspresident bepaal."**
