TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS:
POLICING SERVICES

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section (7) (a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993 (Act No. 200 of 1993), and for the better achievement of section 235, I, after consultation with the Premiers of the Provinces of KwaZulu/Natal, Northern Cape, Northern Transvaal, the North-West, Eastern Cape, Eastern Transvaal, Pretoria-Witwatersrand-Vereeniging, the Orange Free State and Western Cape, take the legislative measures as set in the Schedule hereto.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Republic of South Africa at Pretoria this Thirtieth day of July One thousand Nine hundred and Ninety-four.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Proclamation, unless the context otherwise indicates—

Ondanks die bepalings van enige Wet, sal elke lid van 'n mag geag word die bevoegdhede en pligte te besit wat aan 'n lid van enige ander mag in terme van enige Wet opgedra of opgelê is en die Minister kan gelas dat enige lid van enige mag enige deel van die nasionale grondgebied kan binnegaan en om enige bevoegdheid uit te oefen en plig uit te voer wat aan 'n lid van 'n mag in terme van 'n Wet wat in sodanige grondgebied van toepassing is, opgedra of opgelê is. 'n Lid wat aangesê is om 'n gedeelte van die nasionale grondgebied binne te gaan wat deur 'n ander mag as waarvan hy lid is, gepolisieëer word, sal dit doen onder die bevel en beheer van 'n lid deur die Minister aangewys en onderworpe aan die voorskrifte van die Minister.

“Minister” means the Minister of Safety and Security.

Powers and duties of members of the Force

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any Act, every member of a force shall be deemed to have the power and the duties conferred or imposed on a member of any other force in terms of any Act and the Minister may order any member of any force to enter any part of the national territory and to exercise the powers and perform the functions conferred or imposed on a member of a force in terms of an Act applicable in such part. A member ordered to enter a part of the national territory which is policed by a different force than the one of which he is a member, shall do so under the command and control of a member designated by the Minister and subject to the directions of the Minister.
