

NOTICE 486 OF 1997**SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION****DISCUSSION PAPER ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

The Commission has published, for general information and comment, Discussion Paper 70 on Domestic Violence.

It is clear that the law does not hold an exclusive position in either the response to, or the prevention of, domestic violence. However, when victims of domestic violence do turn to the law for protection, the law should be effective and efficient in its response. The objective of the recommendations contained in the Discussion Paper is therefore to ensure that the substance and procedures of domestic violence legislation are well tailored to the needs of those suffering abuse in a domestic context.

The Commission's recommendations are progressive and constitute a substantial broadening of the limited scope of the existing Prevention of Family Violence Act, No. 133 of 1993. The most important recommendations are the following:

- Provision should be made for the granting of interim interdicts upon application even though the respondent has not been given prior notice of the application. In granting the interim interdict the court should issue a suspended warrant for the arrest of the respondent.
- Protection should be offered to any victim who is in a "domestic relationship" with the abuser. "Domestic relationship" should include persons (whether the same or opposite gender) who live or lived together in a relationship in the nature of marriage, although they are not, or were not, married to each other, or are not able to be married to each other. It should also include engagement and dating relationships and persons who share or have shared the same household.
- "Domestic violence" should be defined as including, but not limited to, physical abuse or threat of physical abuse; sexual abuse or threat of sexual abuse; intimidation; harassment; or destruction of property. Account should be taken of the fact that a number of acts that form part of a pattern of behaviour may amount to domestic violence, even when some or all of those acts, when viewed in isolation, may appear to be trivial.
- The court should be empowered to prohibit the abuser to physically or sexually abuse the applicant; threaten to physically or sexually abuse the applicant; intimidate the applicant; harass the applicant; damage property in which the applicant may have an interest; threaten to damage property in which the applicant may have an interest; enter, watch, loiter near, prevent or hinder access to or from, the applicant's place of residence, business, employment, educational institution, or any other place that the applicant visits often; follow the applicant or stop or approach the applicant in any place; make any contact with the applicant by telephone or any form of written communication; enlist the help of another person to act in any of the above ways; enter the shared residence, enter a specified part of the shared residence or a specified area in which the shared residence is situated; prevent the applicant or any relevant child who ordinarily lives or lived in the shared residence from entering or remaining in the shared residence or a specified part of the shared residence; commit any other act specified in the interdict.
- The court should be empowered to order that all or any of the prohibitions or conditions contained in the interdict apply for the benefit of any child whose interests the court considers relevant.
- In granting an interdict the court should be empowered to make a temporary maintenance, custody or access order.
- The contravention of the conditions of an interdict granted in terms of domestic violence legislation should be an offence which is prosecuted in the criminal court.

KENNISGEWING 486 VAN 1997**SUID-AFRIKAANSE REGSKOMMISSIE****BESPREKINGSTUK OOR HUISHOUDELIKE GEWELD**

Die Kommissie het Besprekingstuk 70 oor Huishoudelike Geweld vir algemene inligting en kommentaar gepubliseer.

Dit is duidelik dat die reg nie 'n eksklusiewe posisie beklee met betrekking tot óf die reaksie op óf die voorkoming van huishoudelike geweld nie. Wanneer slagoffers van huishoudelike geweld hulle egter tot die reg vir beskerming wend, behoort die reaksie van die reg effektiief en doelmatig te wees. Die oogmerk van die aanbevelings in die Besprekingstuk is derhalwe om te verseker dat die substansie en procedures van wetgewing oor huishoudelike geweld goed aanpas by die behoeftes van diegene wat in 'n huishoudelike konteks aan mishandeling onderwerp word.

Die Kommissie se aanbevelings is progressief en bring 'n aansienlike verbreding mee aan die beperkte omvang van die bestaande Wet op die Voorkoming van Gesinsgeweld, No. 133 van 1993. Die belangrikste aanbevelings is die volgende:

- Voorsiening moet gemaak word vir die verlening van interim interdikte op aansoek al het die respondent nie vroeëre kennis van die aansoek gekry nie. By die verlening van die interim interdik moet die hof 'n opgeskorte lasbrief vir die inhegtenisneming van die respondent uitreik.
- Beskerming moet verleen word aan enige slagoffer wat in 'n "huishoudelike verhouding" met die misbruiker is. "Huishoudelike verhouding" moet insluit persone (hetselfde of teenoorgestelde geslag) wat saamwoon of saam gewoon het in 'n verhouding in die aard van 'n huwelik, alhoewel hulle nie met mekaar getroud is of was nie, of nie bevoeg is om met mekaar te trou nie. Dit moet ook insluit verlowingsverhoudings en uitgaanverhoudings en persone wat dieselfde huishouding deel of gedeel het.
- "Huishoudelike geweld" moet omskryf word as insluitende, maar nie beperk tot nie, fisiese misbruik of dreigement van fisiese misbruik; seksuele misbruik of dreigement van seksuele misbruik; intimidasie; teistering; of vernietiging van eiendom. Kennis moet geneem word van die feit dat 'n aantal handelinge wat deel uitmaak van 'n patroon van optrede tot huishoudelike geweld aanleiding kan gee, al sou alle of sommige van sodanige handelinge, wanneer in isolasie beskou, as niksbeduidend voorkom.
- Die hof moet die mag hê om die misbruiker te verbied om die applikant fisies of seksueel te misbruik; te dreig om die applikant fisies of seksueel te misbruik; die applikant te intimideer; die applikant te teister; eiendom waarin die applikant 'n belang het te beskadig; die applikant se woning, besigheid, werksplek, opvoedkundige instelling, of enige ander plek wat die applikant dikwels besoek, te betree, dop te hou, in die nabyheid te draal, of toegang daarot of daarvan te voorkom of verhinder; die applikant te agtervolg of in enige plek te stop of te nader; enige kontak met die applikant te maak by wyse van telefoon of enige geskrewe vorm van kommunikasie; die hulp van 'n ander persoon te verkry om op enige van voormalde wyses te handel; die gesamentlike woning te betree; 'n gespesifieerde deel van die gesamentlike woning of 'n gespesifieerde area waarin die gesamentlike woning geleë is te betree; die applikant of enige relevante kind wat gewoonlik in die gesamentlike woning woon of gewoon het te verhinder om die gesamentlike woning of 'n gespesifieerde deel van die gesamentlike woning te betree of daarin te bly; enige ander handeling wat in die interdik gespesifieer is te verrig.

NOTICE 487 OF 1997
SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION

The South African Law Commission has published an issue paper on access to the criminal justice system for general information and comment. The issue paper forms part of the Commission's comprehensive review of the Criminal Procedure Act and it follows the publication of its interim report which addressed the issue of delays in the finalisation of criminal cases. The South African criminal justice system is experiencing a legitimacy crisis, the essence of which lies in the superimposition of a foreign legal system with its concomitant western legal postulations upon those of Africa.

It has often been stated that the judicial system is in need of fundamental changes in order to make it more accessible to the public, that legal procedures should be simplified, that terminology should be less technical, that the judicial system should serve the community and that it should also reflect the different schools of thought in the community.

The key objective of the justice system in the new democratic South Africa is expressed in three words: Access to justice. The notion that all South Africa's people should have access to justice help to determine the need and role of courts, the nature and role of other mechanisms and procedures to facilitate justice, the role of lawyers and the legal profession, the role and place of the prosecuting authority in the system of justice, the role of paralegal and advice offices, the role of legal education, the approach to legal qualifications and the rules relating to admission as legal practitioners, the role of the public and NGO's as well as the role of modern technology.

To this end the issue paper explores possibilities to improve access to the criminal justice system. A number of possibilities are proposed to improve access to criminal courts and to restore legitimacy to the criminal justice system, including the structure, jurisdiction and availability of criminal courts; physical access to court buildings; equality of access; the promotion of community participation in the criminal justice process through the introduction of the jury system, the extension of the use of assessors in criminal cases, the establishment of community courts and the introduction of courts of petty sessions.

The paper also invites proposals for the improvement of the efficiency of the criminal justice system including proposals for the improvement of control over the administration of the criminal justice system; the introduction of charters for criminal courts; proposals for case management; professional development programmes; improved understanding of the role of the criminal courts and the creation of an accessible and intelligible criminal procedure.

The lack of legal representation in criminal cases has been the single largest factor inhibiting access to the criminal justice system. In order to address this problem the paper invites proposals on the restructuring of legal aid services including the need to assess the demand for legal services; the identification of resources available; the role of the legal profession in expanding legal services in criminal cases; equitable use of resources; the role of paralegals in the criminal justice system; the establishment of community legal centres; the role of university and legal aid institutions; the establishment of a telephonic legal aid service; the reduction of the costs of legal representation in criminal cases and proposals to improve access through community legal education. The closing date for comment is 31 May 1997.

Daar is al dikwels in die verlede gesê dat die regstelsel fundamentele veranderings moet ondergaan om dit meer toeganklik vir die publiek te maak, regsprosedures moet vereenvoudig word, terminologie moet minder tegnies wees, die regstelsel moet die belang van die gemeenskap dien en dit moet uitdrukking gee aan die verskillende denkrigtings in die gemeenskap.

Die hoofoogmerk van die regstelsel in die nuwe demokratiese bedeling kan saamgevat word in drie woorde: Toegang totregspleging. Die gedagte dat alle Suid-Afrikaners toegang tot dieregspleging moet hê lewer 'n bydrae tot die identifisering van die behoeftes en die rol van die howe, die aard en rol van ander meganismes en procedures om reg te laat geskied, die rol vanregsverteenvoordigers en dieregsprofessionele, die rol en plek van die vervolgingsgesag in dieregspleging, die rol van "paralegals" en ander regshulpinstellings, die rol van opvoeding totregsgeletterdheid, die benadering totregskwalifikasies en reëls met betrekking tot die toelating vanregspraktisys, die rol van die publiek en nie-regeringsorganisasies sowel as die rol van moderne tegnologie.

Ten einde bogenoemde te bepaal ondersoek die besprekingstuk moontlikhede om toegang tot dieregspleging te verbeter. 'n Aantal moontlikhede word voorgestel om toegang tot die howe te verbeter en om die legitimiteit van die strafregspleging te herstel insluitend die struktuur, jurisdiksie en beskikbaarheid van strafhowe; fisiese toeganklikheid vanhofgeboue; gelykheid van toegang; die bevordering vangemeenskapsbetrokkenheid by die strafregspleging deur die instelling van die juriestelsel; die uitbreiding van die gebruik vanassessore in strafsake; die daarstelling van gemeenskapshowe en die instelling van 'n strafhof vir geringe oortredings.

In die besprekingstuk word ook 'n uitnodiging gerig om voorstelle te doen vir die verbetering van die effektiwiteit van die strafregstelsel insluitend voorstelle oor die verbetering van die beheer oor die administrasie van die strafregstelsel; die daarstelling van 'n handves met riglyne vir strafhowe; voorstelle oor die bestuur vanhofrolle; professionele ontwikkelingsprogramme; 'n beter begrip van die rol van die howe en die daarstelling van 'n verstaanbare en toeganklike strafprocedure.

Die afwesigheid vanregsverteenvoordiging in strafsake is die grootste enkele faktor wat toegang tot diestrafregspleging inkort. SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION

It is widely acknowledged that the maintenance system is in disarray. Complaints range from the treatment, attitudes and facilities encountered at maintenance courts to the seeming impunity with which persons manage to evade their legal duty to maintain their dependants. Consequently the Minister of Justice has requested the Commission to investigate possibilities for the improvement of the current maintenance system.

As part of this investigation the Commission has published an issue paper on the Review of the Maintenance System (Issue Paper 5). The aim with the issue paper is to elicit comments on the issues pertaining to the maintenance system and to use these comments to assist the Commission in identifying the most suitable options for reform.

The issues discussed in the paper range from topics such as the shortage of human resources to the orders made by maintenance courts and their enforcement. The paper also deals with the question whether the judicial system, and especially the criminal law, is the correct vehicle for the implementation of the duty to support one's dependants.

The options for reform which are discussed in Issue Paper 5 include:

- Replacing the procedure for the implementation of duty of support with an administrative system for the determination of the amounts of maintenance payments and the collection thereof;
- separating the office of maintenance officer from that of public prosecutor to allow for the appointment of career-oriented maintenance officers;
- prescribing guidelines for maintenance officers to follow in the course of the investigation of a complaint;

- requiring the courts to make a garnishee order simultaneously with the making of a maintenance order in all cases where this will be appropriate and allowing the courts to make a maintenance order in the absence of a respondent where it is clear that the respondent refuses to attend court proceedings after being notified thereof;
- discouraging the courts from routinely suspending sentences for the failure to comply with maintenance orders by limiting the discretion to impose a suspended sentence to certain conditions such as submission to correctional supervision; and
- separating the procedures for the execution of an order of a maintenance court from the conviction of the defaulter and allowing for the authorisation of a warrant of execution or the making of a garnishee order whenever a person falls in arrears with maintenance payments.

The Board on Tariffs and Trade received a petition requesting action against the alleged subsidised export of porcelain insulators originating in India.

Petition

The petition was lodged by **Cullinan Industrial Porcelain**, the local manufacturer of the products in South Africa. The petitioner alleges that the Indian government subsidises porcelain insulators in the form of a deduction equal to 100 per cent of the export profits in computing the company's taxable income.

Product

The product being investigated is porcelain insulators, classifiable under tariff subheading 8546.20.10.

Subsidised export

The petitioner alleges that the Indian government subsidises porcelain insulators in the form of an exemption of export profits from taxation. This was alleged to be a countervailable subsidy in accordance with the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures. Based on the available information, the subsidy was calculated to be 31,64 per cent of the export value.

Material injury and causality

The petitioner alleges that the domestic South African industry is suffering material injury owing to the importation from India of subsidised porcelain insulators.

Procedure

After unsuccessful requests for consultation with the Indian government, and having decided that there is sufficient evidence to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Board has commenced an investigation in terms of section 4 of the Board on Tariffs and Trade Act, 1986. In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Board will send questionnaires to all known importers and exporters, and known representative associations. Interested parties may submit their views in writing, preferably by completing the relevant questionnaire, and by submitting evidence supporting their replies. Parties who wish may arrange with the Investigating Officer to conduct informal discussions and present further evidence. The reasons for such a request must be indicated.

INCOME TAX: STAMP DUTY: MORTGAGE BONDS AND COSTS CLAUSES

- Item 7 of Schedule 1 to the Stamp Duties Act, 1968 (Act No. 77 of 1968) (the Stamp Duties Act), provides that in determining the amount of any debt secured or to be secured, which amount forms the basis of the stamp duty, any sum separately secured by the bond to cover costs incurred in connection with the debt is excluded from the dutiable amount.

2. Considerable uncertainty has recently arisen as to the liability in terms of the Stamp Duties Act of the so-called "cost clause" (or additional sum) where the clause is so worded that the amount primarily intended to cover costs is also available to secure further advances to the mortgagor.
3. The view is held by the South African Revenue Service that even if an amount is separately secured in terms of a bond to primarily cover costs, such amount will be subject to stamp duty if it is also available to secure future debts (further advances to the mortgagor).

Only an amount which is separately secured to exclusively cover costs, which amount is not available to secure further advances, may be excluded from the dutiable amount.

Where it is not clear from the reading of the bond whether the amount specified for costs is or is not available to secure further advances, the amount will be subject to stamp duty.

4. Where any doubt exists as to the liability of an instrument the document should be forwarded to the appropriate Receiver of Revenue for consideration.

Slegs 'n bedrag wat apart gesekureer is om uitsluitlike kostes te dek, welke bedrag nie beskikbaar is om verdere voorskotte te sekureer nie, kan van die belasbare bedrag uitgesluit word.

Waar dit nie duidelik uit die bewoording van die verband is of die bedrag wat vir kostes gespesifiseer is, vir verdere voorskotte beskikbaar is al dan nie, sal sodanige bedrag onderworpe wees aan seëlregte.

4. Waar enige twyfel bestaan betreffende die aanspreeklikheid van 'n instrument moet die dokument aan die betrokke Ontvanger van Inkomste vir oorweging voorgelê word.
