TECHNIKON FREE STATE

AMENDMENT OF STATUTE

The Council of the Technikon Free State has, with the approval of the Minister of Education, under section 18 of the Technikons Act, 1993 (Act No. 123 of 1993), framed the amendments to the Statute set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. In the Schedule, unless the context otherwise indicates, the expression "the Statute" means the Statute promulgated by Government Notice No. 1649 of 7 October 1994, as amended by Government Notices Nos. 1781 of 8 November 1996 and 1699 of 25 October 1996 and as corrected by Government Notice No. 1937 of 29 November 1996.

2. The following paragraph is substituted for paragraph 22 of the Statute:

"Vice-rectors and registrar

22. (1) Whenever it is necessary to appoint or elect vice-rectors as members of the Council as contemplated in section 16 (2) (b) of the Act, no more than four (4) vice-rectors determined by lot, shall be appointed in writing by the Chairperson of the Council.

(2) A registrar shall be appointed, in writing by the Chairperson of the Council.”.

3. The following paragraph is substituted for subparagraph 31 (1) of the Statute:

“31. (1) The date of retirement of an employee of the Technikon—

- (a) who is a member of the academic staff shall be the first day of the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which he or she attains the age of 60 years;
 - (b) other than a member of the academic staff shall be the first day of the calendar month in which he or she attains the age of 60 year; and
 - (c) notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, all employees may, on their request, retire after the age of 55 years, provided that the Council has been notified of their intention to retire, at least three calendar months prior to their retirement.”.

WYSIGING VAN STATUUT

Die Raad van die Technikon Vrystaat het kragtens artikel 18 van die Wet op Technikons, 1993 (Wet No. 123 van 1993), met goedkeuring van die Minister van Onderwys die wysiging aan die Statute uiteengesit in die Bylae hiervan, opgestel.

BYLAE

1. In hierdie Bylae, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken die uitdrukking “die Statute” die Statute aangekondig by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1649 van 7 Oktober 1994, soos gewysig by Goewermentskennisgewings Nos. 1781 van 8 November 1996 en 1699 van 25 Oktober 1996 en soos reggestel deur Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1937 van 29 November 1996.

2. Paragraaf 22 van die Statuut word deur die volgende paragraaf vervang:

“Viserektore en registrateur

22. (1) Indien dit nodig word om viserektore aan te stel of te verkies as Raadslede, soos beoog in artikel 16 (2) (b) van die Wet, word nie meer as vier (4) viserektore, deur loting bepaal, skriftelik aangestel deur die Voorsitter van die Raad.

(2) ‘n Registrateur word skriftelik aangestel deur die Voorsitter van die Raad.”.

3. Subparagraaf 31 (1) van die Statuut word deur die volgende paragraaf vervang:

“31. (1) Die aftreedatum van ‘n werknemer van die Technikon—

- (a) wat ‘n lid van die akademiese personeel is, is die eerste dag van die kalenderjaar wat onmiddellik volg op die kalenderjaar waarin hy of sy die ouderdom van 60 jaar bereik;
 - (b) anders as ‘n lid van die akademiese personeel, is die eerste dag van die kalendermaand wat onmiddellik volg op die kalendermaand waarin hy of sy die ouderdom van 60 jaar bereik; en
 - (c) nieteenstaande die algemeenheid van die voorafgaande kan alle werknemers op hul versoek aftree na bereiking van die ouderdom van 55 jaar, met dien verstande dat hulle aan die Raad ten minste drie kalendermaande kennis gee van hulle voorneme om af te tree.”.

The purpose of the proposed Act will be to establish a commercialised, accountable and focused entity to take over the execution and operation of national roads activities from the Chief Directorate: Roads of the Department and the South African Roads Board, while the Minister and the National Department of Transport will remain responsible for policy and regulation. The principles involved are supported by the Committee of Ministers of Transport (MINCOM) and approved by the Cabinet. Furthermore the proposed Act will repeal the National Roads Act, 1971, and the South African Roads Board Act, 1988.

Since the working document on the proposed South African National Roads Agency Bill provides for far-reaching amendments to the existing road network management system and the powers and functions of existing road authorities, wide consultation and participation in respect of the proposed Act is being undertaken to canvas the views of role players.

It is important to note that the attached working document is not yet a bill but is hereby published for general information and comment prior to the presentation of the actual bill to Parliament.

ANNEXURE A**WORKING DOCUMENT FOR A
SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL ROADS AGENCY BILL**

To provide for the financing, strategic planning, design, construction, acquisition, operation, control and maintenance of national roads; to this end to establish an entity that will be charged with a focused attention to these matters; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

Whereas the national roads of South Africa are a means to facilitate economic growth and economic empowerment, and to create wealth;

Whereas the management of the national roads resource should be conducted as effectively, efficiently, accountably and safely as possible, in a focused manner;

Whereas the national roads of South Africa have suffered extensive deterioration due to a lack of adequate funding in the past;

Whereas the costs of building and maintaining national roads should be borne by the users thereof, jointly with the State, wherever feasible;

Whereas there is a need to foster a sound financial base for national roads;

Whereas there is a need to separate the policy and regulation functions of government from the execution and operation activities.

Now, therefore, be it enacted by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa as follows:

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PART I**DEFINITIONS****1. Definitions**

In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise—

- "Agency"** means the South African National Roads Agency established by section 4;
- "Board"** means the Board of Directors referred to in section 10;
- "committee"** means a committee established under section 12;
- "construct"**, in relation to a road, includes acquiring land, reconstructing, widening, rehabilitating, diverting, altering, repairing and, unless the context indicates otherwise, maintaining, and "construction" has a corresponding meaning;
- "Department"** means the National Department of Transport;
- "Department of Finance"** means the National Department of Finance;
- "Gazette"** means the *Government Gazette*;
- "guideline"** means a non-mandatory direction;
- "interstate bridge"** means a bridge across the boundary between the Republic and any adjoining country;
- "interprovincial bridge"** means a bridge across the boundary between adjoining provinces of the Republic;
- "land"** includes a real right in or over land;
- "Minister"** means the National Minister of Transport;
- "Minister of Finance"** means the National Minister of Finance;
- "municipality"** means any form of local government contemplated in Chapter 7 of the Constitution and the Local Government Transition Act, 1993 (Act No. 209 of 1993), and includes a metropolitan council, metropolitan local council, local council, district council, rural council, representative council, services council or services board;
- "national road"** means a road or route declared or deemed to be a national road under section 23 and includes a toll road and inter-provincial bridges on a national road, as well as interstate bridges, whether or not such bridges are part of a national road;
- "policy"** means an adopted framework or basis of action needed to overcome identified problems and achieve stated goals and objectives;

"prescribed" or **"prescribed by regulation"** means prescribed by the Minister by regulation in the *Gazette*;

"public road" means a road which the public has the right to use;

"road" means a public road and includes, in addition to the roadway—

- (a) the land of which the road consists or over which the road reserve in question extends;
- (b) anything on that land forming part of, or connected with, or belonging to the road;
- (c) land acquired for the construction of a connection between a national road and another road;

"this Act" includes any regulations made thereunder;

"toll plaza" means a structure on a toll road where toll is payable under this Act, or any electrical, electronic or mechanical device on a toll road for recording the liability to pay toll, or any combination of such structure and such device;

"toll road" means a national road or a portion thereof which has been declared a toll road under section 16 and of which notice has been given in terms of that section in the *Gazette*.

PART II

POLICY

2. National roads policy

(1) The Minister may by proclamation in the *Gazette*, determine national policy including but not limited to—

- (a) the government's goals in relation to national roads;
- (b) the policy objectives to be pursued to achieve the government's goals in relation to national roads;
- (c) the measurable targets (key performance indicators) to be met to achieve those goals and policy objectives,

or prescribe such policy in greater detail, whereupon such policy shall be implemented by the Agency.

(2) The Minister must publish in the *Gazette* for comment details of any policy he or she intends to determine in terms of subsection (1).

3. Strategic or economic interests of the Republic

Should the Agency act in a manner contrary to the strategic or economic interests of the Republic, the Minister may direct the Agency by means of a written notice to discontinue that activity within a stated period, in which case the Agency shall comply with the notice in all respects.

PART III

ESTABLISHMENT OF SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL ROADS AGENCY

4. Establishment of South African National Roads Agency

(1) On a date to be determined by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*, an agency known as the South African National Roads Agency shall be established as a public company.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Companies Act, 1973 (Act No. 61 of 1973), the Minister shall sign the memorandum of association and the articles of association of the Agency on behalf of the State.

(3) The Registrar of Companies shall register the signed memorandum and articles and endorse thereon a certificate that the Agency is incorporated.

(4) The provisions of sections 66 and 344 (d) of the Companies Act, 1973, shall not apply to the Agency.

(5) The Minister may in consultation with the Agency by notice in the *Gazette* declare that any provision of the Companies Act, 1973, shall not apply to the Agency, and revoke such a notice in consultation with the Agency.

5. Objects and ancillary powers of the Agency

(1) The objects of the Agency shall be the strategic planning, design, construction, operation, control, rehabilitation and maintenance of national roads or any facility or service normally related to the functioning of national roads, and the Agency shall have the exclusive right and duty to achieve these objects in the Republic.

(2) The Agency shall have such ancillary powers as are necessary to accomplish its objects effectively, including but not limited to—

- (a) generating revenue from the development and management of its assets, which revenue shall be used to achieve its objects: Provided that no property may be expropriated for this sole purpose and that it shall not interfere with the achievement of the main objects of the Agency stated in subsection (1);
- (b) advising the Minister on matters related to national roads;
- (c) conducting research or causing research to be done, instituting any inquiry or causing any inquiry to be instituted or collecting information or causing information to be collected, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, in connection with national roads.

(3) The Agency may at the request of or in agreement with a foreign country, finance, plan, design, construct, acquire, provide, operate, control, and maintain roads of a national character in such country, and charge fees, levies or tolls in that regard, in which case the relevant negotiations with the foreign country shall be conducted by the Minister.

(4) The Agency shall perform such other functions as are conferred on it by or under any other act, provided that the required funding is made available for this purpose.

(5) The Agency may subcontract any of its activities.

6. Succession to the South African Roads Board

(1) On the date mentioned in section 4 (1) the South African Roads Board created by section 2 of the South African Roads Board Act, 1988 (Act No. 74 of 1988) shall cease to exist, unless the Minister shall prolong its existence by proclamation in the *Gazette*.

(2) From the date mentioned in subsection (1), the powers and duties of the South African Roads Board conferred by any law that is not repealed by this Act shall be performed by the Director-General of the Department until such law is replaced by other legislation or until the Minister shall provide otherwise by proclamation in the *Gazette*. Such proclamation shall provide for the necessary transitional arrangements.

(3) The Agency shall succeed to such assets and liabilities of the South African Roads Board as the Minister shall determine by proclamation in the *Gazette* and shall be the legal successor to the South African Roads Board.

(4) Subject to subsections (1) and (2), any reference to the South African Roads Board in any law or any document executed by that Board shall be construed as a reference to the agency, unless provided otherwise by regulation.

7. Transfer of personnel, assets and liabilities

- (1) Subject to this section the Minister shall by agreement—
- (a) transfer to the Agency the responsibility for the financing, strategic planning, design, construction, acquisition, operation, control, and maintenance of all of the national roads which have been or are in the process of being declared, planned, designed, constructed, acquired, operated or controlled on the date of commencement of this Act in terms of section 4 of the National Roads Act, 1971;
 - (b) transfer to the Agency ownership of such movable and immovable assets owned by or liabilities, rights and obligations of the State, including all assets and liabilities of the National Roads Fund referred to in section 2 of the National Roads Act, 1971 (Act No. 54 of 1971), as may be necessary for achieving the objects of the Agency, as consideration for the shares and loan account referred to in section 8.
- (2) The agreement mentioned in subsection (1) must make provision for—
- (a) the relationship between the Agency and the Minister as representing the State as sole member and shareholder of the Agency;
 - (b) the extent of the assets, liabilities, rights and obligations to be transferred in terms of that subsection; and
 - (c) any other matter which the Minister deems expedient for the functioning of the Agency.
- (3) The Minister may, in accordance with an agreement between the Department and the Agency, transfer permanently to the Agency any person who is an officer or employee in the Department in terms of section 8 (1) and (3) of the Public Service Act, 1994 (Act No. 111 of 1994), with the concurrence of such person.
- (4) (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the Minister may make available to the Agency the services of any officer or employee of the Department in terms of section 15 (3) and (4) of the Public Service Act, 1994 (Act No. 111 of 1994), with the concurrence of such person, and place such person under the control of the Agency for such period as the Minister may deem fit, but without prejudice to such person's position as such officer or employee.
- (b) The Agency must compensate the Department at a rate determined by the Minister for the services of any person so made available to the Agency.
 - (c) The Minister may delegate on such conditions as he or she may deem fit, to an officer in the Department any power granted to him or her under this subsection.
- (5) Notwithstanding section 5 of the State Land Disposal Act, 1961 (Act No. 48 of 1961), and section 18 of the Deeds Registries Act, 1937 (Act No. 47 of 1937), a registrar defined in section 102 of the Deeds Registries Act, 1937, shall on submission of a certificate by the Minister that State land or any real right or registrable lease in State land has been transferred under subsection (1), or that a servitude exists over State land so transferred, free of charge make such entries and endorsements as he or she deems necessary in any appropriate register, title deed or other document in order to register the transfer in the name of the Agency or confirm the existence of the servitude over the State land so transferred in favour of any other person.

(6) Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in any law, no servitude or other right of any kind in respect of State land transferred to the Agency shall be acquired by prescription.

(7) The Agency shall be substituted for the State as a contracting party in respect of any contract transferred to the Agency, without the substitution bringing about novation of such contract.

(8) Any litigation in relation to the construction, maintenance, management, operation or control of a national road transferred to the Agency which arose—

- (a) before the transfer date contemplated in subsection (1) shall be conducted by or against the State and
- (b) which arose on or after such transfer date, shall be conducted by or against the Agency.

(9) Notwithstanding any other law, the Agency shall be exempt from any stamp duties, transfer duties or registration fees payable in terms of any law in relation to the transfer of assets under subsection (1).

8. Shares in the Agency

(1) As consideration for the net assets after deduction of liabilities referred to in section 6, the Agency shall issue fully paid up shares and/or a loan account in the Agency to the State, and the rights attaching to such shares or loan account shall be exercised by the Minister.

(2) The value of the assets acquired by the Agency in terms of subsection (1) and the extent of the loan account in relation to the value of the shares shall be determined by the Minister in agreement with the Minister of Finance, after consultation with the Agency, and such value shall be deemed to be reasonable consideration for such transfer.

(3) The shares in the Agency held by the State may not be sold or transferred or otherwise disposed of without the authority of an act of Parliament.

(4) The liability of the State as the holder of shares in the Agency shall be limited to any unpaid amount in respect of the shares so held.

9. Liquidation

The Agency shall not be liquidated or placed under judicial management except on the authority of an act of Parliament.

PART IV

MANAGEMENT

10. Board of Directors and Chief Executive Officer

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Companies Act, 1973 (Act No. 61 of 1973), the articles of association of the Agency shall provide for the board of directors of the Agency to be constituted and to function according to the provisions of this Act.

(2) The Board shall consist of eleven members, appointed by the Minister, of whom—

- (a) one shall be a non-executive chairperson;
- (b) one shall *ex officio* be the Chief Executive Officer of the Agency;
- (c) one shall represent the Department of Finance;
- (d) four shall represent road users;
- (e) four shall have special knowledge and experience in matters relating to the activities of the Agency.

(3) The Board must appoint a managing director who shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Agency. The Chief Executive Officer may not engage in paid employment outside the duties of his or her office without the approval of the Board.

11. Period and conditions of office and remuneration of Board members

(1) A member of the Board, excluding the Chief Executive Officer, shall hold office for the period and on the conditions specified by the Minister upon his or her appointment, but not exceeding two years, or if no such period is specified, for a period of two years from the date of his or her appointment, and may be re-appointed on the termination of such period.

(2) Board members, with the exception of the Chief Executive Officer, shall be remunerated at a daily rate determined by the Minister for each day or part thereof that they are engaged in matters relating to the Agency.

(3) A member of the Board vacates his or her office if he or she resigns or becomes subject to any disqualification applicable to a director in terms of the Companies Act, 1973.

(4) The Minister may remove from office any member of the Board who—

- (a) has failed to comply with a condition of his or her appointment;
- (b) in the opinion of the Minister, has been guilty of improper conduct or has regularly neglected his or her duties as a member of the Board;
- (c) in the opinion of the Minister, is unable to perform efficiently his or her duties as a member of the Board;
- (d) has failed to attend three consecutive meetings of the Board without good reason;
- (e) in the opinion of the Minister, as a result of information that has come to his or her notice, will not be likely to be impartial in the exercise of his or her duties.

(5) A member of the Board, other than a person who is in the full-time employment of the State, shall be appointed on the conditions of service, including conditions relating to the payment of remuneration and allowances, subject to subsection (2), which the Minister determines.

(6) A member who is in the full-time service of the State shall not be paid any remuneration in addition to his or her salary and allowances as such.

(7) Any vacancy on the Board shall be filled by the appointment by the Minister of another person within three months, with regard to section 10 (2).

12. Committees

(1) The Board may form committees to assist it in the performance of its functions and duties, which may be temporary or permanent, to investigate, research or attend to specific matters.

(2) Any vacancy on a committee may be filled by the appointment by the Board of another person.

13. Meetings of Board and committees

(1) Board meeting will be held at the times and places determined by the Board.

(2) A quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be six members.

(3) The decision of the majority of the members present at any meeting shall constitute the decision of the Board and in the event of an equality of votes, the person presiding at the meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to his or her deliberative vote.

(4) The Board may make rules and regulations not inconsistent with this Act regarding meetings of the Board and committees, personnel and financial matters and any other matter that will promote the achievement of its objects or the better performance of its functions.

(5) The Board may delegate or assign any power, function or duty imposed upon it by this Act to the Chief Executive Officer or to any member of the Board, any committee, or any employee of the Agency, with or without the authority to delegate such power or function further, but shall not be divested of any power, function or duty so delegated or assigned, and may amend or withdraw any decision made by such a delegate in the exercise of a power or the performance of a function or duty so delegated or assigned.

14. Employment practices

(1) The Agency must establish employment practices which are equitable, transparent, competitive and based on merit.

(2) Subsection (1) will not prevent the implementation of employment practices for categories of preference in employment and the protection and advancement of persons or categories of persons disadvantaged by unfair discrimination.

PART V

FUNDING AND ACCOUNTABILITY

15. Funding of the Agency

(1) The Agency shall be funded from—

- (a) the share capital and loan account referred to in section 8;
- (b) all tolls payable under this Act;
- (c) interest on invested cash balances;
- (d) any other money received by the Agency in terms of or for the purposes of this Act;
- (e) money appropriated by Parliament to supplement its funds;
- (f) a levy on petroleum fuel contemplated in subsection (3);
- (g) money received by the Agency from the development and management of its assets under section 5 (2);
- (h) fines or penalties imposed under this Act;
- (i) fines and penalties collected under subsection (2);
- (j) loans made under subsection (4) (a);
- (k) levies, fees or rent collected in terms of section 24 (g);
- (l) money received from any other source.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, the Agency may enter into agreements with provinces and municipalities as to joint law enforcement exercises regarding the conduct of motorists, freight transport operators and other persons on or in relation to national roads and as to the sharing of fines and penalties imposed for offences in this regard.

(3) (a) The Minister may, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance and the National Minister of Minerals and Energy, by notice in the *Gazette*, or by notice in writing served on any person whether personally or by post, impose a levy on every litre of petrol or distillate fuel which is sold or supplied by any person at any point in the Republic for consumption, or imported by any person into the Republic.

- (b) A notice contemplated in paragraph (a) shall state—
- (i) the amount of the levy;
 - (ii) the interest or penalty payable in the event of non-payment or late payment of the levy;
 - (iii) the times when and manner in which the levy shall be paid;
 - (iv) the person liable for payment;
 - (v) the person responsible to collect the levy;
 - (vi) any other provision which the Minister deems necessary for the efficient administration of the imposition, payment, or collection of the levy or the efficient application of this subsection, including provision regarding the purpose for which distillate fuel or petrol in respect of which the levy has been imposed may be used.
- (c) The Minister may in a notice exempt any person, in part or in full, from compliance with any provision thereof.
- (d) The Minister may at any time amend or withdraw such a notice.
- (e) For the purposes of this subsection—
- “distillate fuel” means diesel fuel, and includes any other substance, or any mixture of diesel fuel and any other substance, which is normally capable of being used as fuel in a compression ignition engine;
- “petrol” includes any substance, or any mixture of petrol and any other substance, which is normally capable of being used as fuel in a spark ignition engine.
- (4) (a) The Minister may from money made available by Parliament for the purpose, grant loans to the Agency for the purposes of this Act.
- (b) The Agency shall pay interest on a loan so granted, and repay it in such instalments and within such period as the Minister may determine in consultation with the Minister of Finance.
- (5) The Agency may with the approval of the Minister granted in consultation with the Minister of Finance, on such conditions as the Agency may deem fit, raise money for the purposes of this Act by way of loan from any source other than a source contemplated in subsection (4).
- (6) The Agency shall pay all expenditure incurred in connection with the exercise or performance of its powers, functions or duties in terms of this Act.
- (7) The Agency must keep separate account of all money received by way of toll or connected to toll roads and interest on investment of such money, and must utilize the money in that account for—
- (a) recovering expenditure in connection with the acquisition of land, investigations and surveys relating to and the designing, planning and construction of and any other work in connection with toll roads, and the erection of any toll plaza and facilities in connection therewith;
 - (b) the maintenance and operation of toll roads and any toll plazas and facilities;
 - (c) the redemption of any loan taken out under subsection (4) in respect of toll roads, including the payment of interest on such loan.
- (8) The Agency may further, as its discretion and subject to such conditions as it may deem fit—
- (a) defray the cost or part of the cost incurred by a province or municipality in connection with a road or other works which by agreement between the Agency and such province or municipality have become necessary as a result of the construction or maintenance of a national road;

- (b) pay an amount to any person for loss, damage or inconvenience which, in the opinion of the Agency, he or she has suffered or will suffer as a result of the exercise or performance of the powers, functions or duties conferred on or entrusted to the Agency or any other person under this Act, and for which no compensation is payable in terms of this Act.

16. Levying of toll

- (1) The Agency may—
- subject to subsection (3), declare a national road or portion thereof, including any bridge or tunnel on a national road, as a toll road, for the purposes of this Act, and amend or withdraw any such declaration;
 - in respect of the driving of any vehicle on a toll road, levy and collect a toll the amount of which has been determined and made known in terms of subsection (4) and which shall be payable at a toll plaza by the person so driving the vehicle, or at any other place subject to such conditions as the Agency may determine;
 - grant exemption from the payment of toll on a particular toll road—
 - in respect of a vehicle of a category determined by the Agency, or in respect of any such vehicle used on the toll road, at a time so determined; or
 - to a person of a category determined by the Agency, irrespective of the vehicle used by such person on the toll road, or to any such person using a vehicle on the toll road at a time so determined;and withdraw such exemption;
 - restrict the levying of toll on a particular toll road to the hours or other times determined by the Agency;
 - suspend the levying of toll on a particular toll road for a specified or an unspecified period and in respect of all vehicles or in respect of vehicles of a category determined by the Agency, and resume the levying after a suspension.
- (2) A declaration under subsection (1) of a toll road, together with a description of such road or portion, shall be made known by notice in the *Gazette*.
- (3) The Agency shall not declare a toll road unless—
- it has a writing afforded the premier or premiers in question and any municipality affected thereby the opportunity to comment on the proposed declaration and has considered such comments; and
 - it has invited, in the manner prescribed, interested parties to make written representations to it, which may include representations on the position of the toll plaza, and has considered the representations, if any;
 - it has given the premiers and municipalities contemplated in paragraph (a) an indication of the approximate position of the proposed toll plaza.
- (4) The amount of toll levied under subsection (1), any rebate thereon and any alteration thereof—
- shall be determined by the Minister on the recommendation of the Agency;
 - may differ in respect of—
 - different toll roads;
 - different vehicles or different categories of vehicles driven on a toll road;
 - different times at which any vehicle or any vehicle of a particular category is driven on a toll road;

- (iv) different persons or different categories of persons, irrespective of the vehicle driven by such persons;
- (c) shall be made known by notice in the *Gazette*;
- (d) shall be payable from a date and time determined by the Agency, which shall be mentioned in the notice whereby it is made known, and which shall not be earlier than the prescribed period after the date on which the notice appears.

(5) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Act—

- (a) the Agency may under the conditions and for the period it deems fit, in terms of an agreement authorize any person to finance, plan, design, construct, operate, control and maintain a national road or any portion thereof which has been declared to be a toll road under this section, or any portion of such a toll road so declared;
- (b) such person shall, subject to paragraph (c), be entitled to levy and collect toll on such road or portion thereof, for his or her own account during the said period and may for that purpose erect a toll plaza or plazas and facilities in connection therewith on the toll road, or portion thereof; and
- (c) toll under paragraph (b) shall only be levied in accordance with an agreement with the Agency and provided that the amount of such toll has been approved by the Minister.

(6) Any person who refuses or fails to pay toll at a toll plaza or any other place contemplated in subsection (1) for which he or she is liable, shall be liable to pay to the Agency a penalty in the amount and manner prescribed, and shall be guilty of an offence and be liable on conviction to imprisonment for the prescribed period in lieu of or in addition to such penalty.

(7) Where a person has refused or failed to pay a toll as contemplated in subsection (6), the Agency may record points against that person's name in the manner prescribed, and impose penalties as prescribed after a prescribed number of points have been so recorded. Regulations made under this subsection may provide for companies, close corporations or other institutions to pay such penalties where the company, corporation or institution has accumulated the prescribed number of points through violations by its employees, members or office bearers.

(8) Nothing in this section will prevent the Agency from instituting civil action to claim tolls or penalties payable to it under this Act.

(9) For purpose of subsection (6), it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that the vehicle concerned was driven by the registered owner thereof.

(10) The Minister may make regulations or guidelines on notice to be given and public participation procedures to be applied, in addition to those mentioned in subsection (3), on the planning and declaration of a toll road, and regarding amounts and methods of determining tolls.

17. Business and financial plan

(1) The Agency must submit to the Minister a business and financial plan not later than 30 days prior to the commencement of each financial year.

(2) The business and financial plan shall contain the prescribed information and any other information the Minister may require in respect of the ensuing financial year and include a five-year strategic plan.

(3) The structure of the business and financial plan, procedure for approval by the Minister and consultation requirements shall be as prescribed.

(4) The business and financial plan shall be approved by the Minister and on approval be published as a public document.

(5) Nothing in this section shall preclude the Agency from entering into longer term planning.

18. Bookkeeping and auditing

(1) The Agency must, in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice, keep such accounting and related records as are necessary to represent fairly the state of affairs and business of the Agency and to explain its transactions and financial position.

(2) The accounting and related records of the Agency shall be audited annually by an auditor registered in terms of section 15 of the Public Accountants' and Auditors' Act, 1991 (Act No. 80 of 1991).

19. Financial year

The financial year of the Agency shall end on 31 March.

20. Annual report

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Companies Act, 1973 (Act No. 61 of 1973), the Agency shall within five months after the end of every financial year, submit to the Minister a report pertaining to the financial state of affairs and business of the Agency as at the end of the immediately preceding financial year, consisting of—

- (a) a balance sheet, an income statement and a cash-flow statement which reflect a true and correct view of the state of affairs of the Agency as at the end of that financial year;
- (b) a report by the Board in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2);
- (c) a report by the auditor in accordance with the provisions of subsection (3);
- (d) such other statements or reports as may be required by the Minister.

(2) The report of the Board referred to in subsection (1) (b) shall deal with the state of affairs, the activities and operations, and the financial position of the Board, and shall—

- (a) set out the objects and functions of the Agency determined by law and any relevant policy determined under section 2;
- (b) state the extent to which the Agency has achieved or advanced its objects during the financial year concerned and specifically the detailed objectives of the business and financial plan;
- (c) contain relevant performance information regarding the economic, efficient and effective application of resources and specifically a comparison between planned and actual performance indicators as set out in the business and financial plan; and
- (d) indicate the amount of money, if any, received from the State and any other commitment furnished by the State.

(3) The auditor's report referred to in subsection (1) (c) shall state separately in respect of each of the following matters whether in the auditor's opinion—

- (a) the balance sheet, income statement and cash-flow statement, as well as any other furnished information, fairly represent the financial position and results obtained by the Agency in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice applied, if applicable, on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year;
- (b) the information furnished in terms of paragraph (a) is fair in all material respects and, if applicable, on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year;
- (c) the transactions of the Agency that had come to the auditor's notice in the course of his or her examination were made in accordance with this Act and any applicable directives or regulations made thereunder;

- (d) the transactions that had come to his or her attention during auditing were in all material respects in accordance with the objects and functions of the Agency; and
- (e) there are adequate measures and procedures for the proper application of sound economic, efficient and effective management;
- (f) attention should be drawn to any other matters falling within the scope of the auditor's examination which, in his or her opinion, should in the public interest be brought to the notice of the Minister and Parliament.

(4) The Minister must cause copies of the financial report submitted to him or her in terms of subsection (1) to be tabled in Parliament within 30 days of its receipt, or, if Parliament is not then in session, within 30 days after commencement of its next ensuing session.

(5) The provisions of the Reporting by Public Entities Act, 1992 (Act No. 93 of 1992), shall apply to the Agency except as modified, supplemented or excluded by the Minister by proclamation in the *Gazette*.

21. Exemptions from taxes

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law (except a law relating to customs and excise, value added tax or services council levies), the Agency shall be exempt from the payment of any tax, transfer duty, stamp duty, levy or impost payable by the Agency to the State in terms of any law.

(2) The exemptions in subsection (1) shall apply to a subsidiary of the Agency for as long as the Agency, either itself or jointly with the State, owns all of the issued shares in such subsidiary.

22. Non performance of functions and duties

If the Agency fails to perform any function or duty imposed on it by this Act, or fails to do so within the prescribed time, the Minister may impose penalties on the Agency, or on its directors, in agreement with the Agency, which shall be paid into the National Revenue Fund referred to in section 213 of the Constitution.

PART VI

NATIONAL ROADS

23. Declaration of a national road

- (1) The Minister may by notice in the *Gazette*—
 - (a) declare any existing road or any route to be a national road.
 - (b) amend or repeal a notice issued under paragraph (a).
- (2) (a) A notice under subsection (1) shall be issued only on the recommendation of the Agency and with the concurrence of the premier of each province in which the road is situated, in the case of an existing road, and after consultation with the relevant premier in the case of a new road.
 - (b) If the concurrence to in paragraph (a) cannot be obtained, the matter may in terms of section 167 (4) (a) of the Constitution be referred to the Constitutional Court for its decision, after the Minister and the Premier have exhausted all mechanisms and procedures for resolving intergovernmental disputes, including the principles of co-operative government and intergovernmental relations provided for in section 41 of the Constitution.
- (3) The Agency shall apply to the relevant Registrar of Deeds within the prescribed period after the date of any declaration in terms of subsection (1) for the endorsement on the relevant title deeds of the fact of the declaration in the manner deemed most suitable by the Registrar.

24. General powers of the Agency and its employees regarding national roads

- (1) In addition to its powers as a public company to achieve its objects, the Agency shall have power—
- (a) to conduct on, or below the surface of, or in connection with, any land, any survey or investigation which the Agency deems desirable in connection with a national road, or the planning, designing, construction, operation, control or maintenance thereof with a view to the declaration of an existing road or any route as a national road;
 - (b) to provide, establish, erect and maintain facilities on national roads for the convenience and safety of road users;
 - (c) to fence any national road;
 - (d) by itself or in collaboration with or through any person or body, to do research or cause research to be done, or make any other investigation or cause any other investigation to be made, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, in connection with the financing, planning, design, construction, acquisition, operation, control or maintenance of roads, the materials or plant or other equipment for that purpose, the control of traffic on roads or any other matter which in the opinion of the Agency will further the objects of this Act;
 - (e) to recommend to the Minister the introduction of legislation relating to roads or road traffic;
 - (f) to do or cause to be done all such work in connection with roads (whether national or not) as the Minister may approve or may direct the Agency to do, at the request of a province or municipality, including the design, planning and construction thereof, with surveys and investigations;
 - (g) to authorize, approve or permit the construction or establishment of anything on or over, or below the surface of, a national road, and charge a levy, fee or rent for the use of that national road or access thereto for purposes relating to such construction or establishment;
 - (h) to authorize employees of the Agency to take steps on any national road or other property under the control of the Agency to prevent offences or other prohibited acts from being committed there, in the manner and on the conditions prescribed by regulation;
 - (i) to advise the Minister at his or her request on questions relating to roads which may arise with the government of any other country.

(2) Any employee of the Agency designated by the Board shall, in respect of any offence committed on a national road, have the powers of arrest and detention conferred on a peace officer by Chapter 5 of the Criminal Procedure Act, 1977 (Act No. 51 of 1977), and may further, on a national road, arrest without a warrant any person who is suspected on reasonable grounds of having committed an offence under this Act.

25. Closing and diversion of national road

- (1) The Agency may close a national road to traffic or divert the roadway of a national road when in its opinion it is necessary or desirable to do so.
- (2) Any persons who without the permission of the Agency uses a national road so closed to traffic, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to the penalties prescribed.

26. Entry upon land

- (1) A member or officer of the Agency or any other person authorized thereto in writing by the Board, may, subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), enter upon any land with the necessary workmen, machines, vehicles, instruments, tools or materials to carry out on, below the surface of, or, in connection with that land, or other land, any investigation, survey, observation or other act necessary for or connected with the exercise or performance of a power, function or duty conferred on or entrusted to the Agency in terms of this Act.

(2) Before taking any action under subsection (1), the Agency shall try to reach agreement with the owner or occupier of the land, but should it fail to reach such agreement, it must repair or pay compensation for any damage caused by the exercise of the powers conferred by this section and shall take all reasonable steps to minimise damage or inconvenience to any person.

(3) Any dwelling house or building may not be entered without the permission of the owner or occupier unless at least twenty-four hours' notice of the Agency's intention to do so has been given to the owner or occupier and it is essential for the Agency to enter the house or building to exercise or perform the relevant power, function or duty.

(4) Any proceedings by virtue of subsection (2) shall be instituted within 180 days after the cause of action has arisen, and written notice of any such proceedings and of the cause of action shall be given by the plaintiff to the Agency not less than 30 days before the proceedings are instituted.

27. Expropriation and vesting of certain land in the Agency

(1) The Agency may, subject to an obligation to pay compensation, expropriate land for a national road or for works or purposes in connection with a national road, including any access road, the acquisition, mining or treatment of gravel, stone, sand, clay, water or any other material or substance, the accommodation of road building staff and the storage or maintenance of vehicles, machines, equipment, tools, stores or material.

(2) Where land has been declared as a national road prior to the date contemplated in section 4 (1) in terms of any law, and where compensation has been paid to the owner of the relevant land in respect thereof, such land shall vest in the Agency on the said date provided that the prescribed notice has been given to the registered owner of the land, and the relevant registrar of deeds shall make such entries in the relevant land registers and endorse on the title deed or deeds of such land the fact that it is owned by the Agency, on application made by the Agency, with the relevant diagrams approved by the Surveyor-General where appropriate and such other accompanying documents as the registrar may require.

(3) The Agency may, subject to an obligation to pay compensation, and with the agreement of the relevant owner wherever possible—

- (a) take gravel, stone, sand, clay, water or any other material on or in land for the construction of a road or for works or purposes referred to in subsection (1);
- (b) take the right to use land temporarily for any purpose for which the Agency may expropriate such land.

(4) The provisions of sections 7 to 24 of the Expropriation Act, 1975 (Act No. 63 of 1975), shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in respect of the expropriation of property or the taking of property or a right in terms of this section, and in such application any reference in that Act—

- (a) to "Minister" and "State" shall be construed as a reference to the Agency;
- (b) to "section 2" shall be construed as a reference to this section;
- (c) to "this Act" shall be construed as a reference to this Act;
- (d) to "land" shall be construed as a reference also to a real right in or over land.

PART VIII**GENERAL PROVISIONS****28. Limitation of actions**

(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other law no action shall lie against the Agency in respect of damage due to any act or omission of the Agency in connection with any matter relating to the condition of a national road, or in respect of any act performed by an employee of the Agency or other authorized person in the execution of his or her duty in connection with such road, unless—

- (a) written notice of the action contemplated, setting out the cause of action and particulars of the claim, has been given to the Agency within 90 days after the cause of action arose;
- (b) a period of 90 days has expired after the date on which such notice was given to the Agency, unless the Agency has in writing denied liability in respect of the claim before the expiration of that period;
- (c) such action is instituted within 24 months after the cause of action arose.

(2) No action shall lie against the Agency or an employee of the Agency, or against any other person who has constructed a national road, in respect of damage sustained by any person in the use of any part of such national road other than the roadway.

29. Application of laws

(1) The Agency shall be exempted from the application of the provisions of any by-law or the requirements of any municipality relating to construction work on property under the control of the Agency, provided that the work is directly related to the main objects of the Agency.

(2) Subsection (1) shall not apply to buildings, excluding roads, to which the public has access or which are intended for use by employees of the Agency or other persons as offices or workshops.

30. Regulations**(1). The Minister may make regulations—**

- (a) regarding access to and egress from national roads;
- (b) regarding the closing or diversion of national roads;
- (c) regarding structures and other works on, over or below national roads and other related land;
- (d) regarding advertisements on or visible from national roads;
- (e) regarding the prohibition of depositing or leaving of refuse on or near national roads;
- (f) regarding the disposal of storm water on national roads;
- (g) providing for offences in relation to activities on or in connection with national roads, and providing for penalties on conviction for such offences;
- (h) providing for penalties to be paid by the Agency or its directors for failure by the Agency to do, or to do timeously, anything required by this Act, as contemplated in section 22;
- (i) which are not inconsistent with any law relating to traffic on, or the use of, public roads, in respect of traffic on a national road or the use or protection of a national road or the use or presence of vehicles or animals or any other thing on a national road;
- (j) prescribing a form to be used for any claim for compensation or any application, authorization, approval or permission contemplated in this Act, the information to be furnished in connection with such an application or the procedure to be followed in connection therewith;

- (k) regulation the disposal of things removed from land under this Act and recovery of costs in connection therewith;
 - (l) providing for an appeal to the Minister against any act, direction or decision of the Agency under this Act and regulating the manner in which and time within such appeal must be brought;
 - (m) providing for public participation procedures to be undertaken by the Agency in performing its functions and carrying out its duties;
 - (n) providing for any other matter that will promote the objects of this Act.
- (2) Different regulations may be made in respect of different national roads.

31. This Act binds the State

This Act shall bind the State.

32. Transitional provisions

Notwithstanding contrary provisions in any other law, the Minister may take such steps or authorize such things to be done as may be necessary to promote—

- (a) the transfer of assets and personnel referred to in section 7;
- (b) the commercialisation and setting up of business units in respect of activities related to national roads prior to the commencement by the Agency of its activities;
- (c) the financing, planning, design, construction, acquisition, operation, control and maintenance of national roads or any facility or service normally related to the functioning of national roads prior to the commencement of the activities of the Agency.

33. Repeal of laws

The following Acts are hereby repealed:

- (a) the National Roads Act, 1971 (Act No. 54 of 1971);
- (b) the South African Roads Board Act, 1988 (Act No. 74 of 1988).

34. Short title and commencement

- (1) This Act shall be called the **South African National Roads Agency Act, 1997**, and shall come into effect on a date determined by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.
- (2) Different parts or sections of this Act may be brought into effect on different dates.
