NOTICE 924 OF 1997

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS ACT, 1996 (ACT No. 84 OF 1996)

DATE BY WHICH THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY OF A SCHOOL WHICH WAS DECLARED TO BE A STATE-AIDED SCHOOL UNDER SECTION 29 (2A) OF THE EDUCATION AFFAIRS ACT, 1988 (HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY) (ACT No. 70 OF 1988), DEVOLVES UPON THE STATE

1. I, Sibusiso Mandlenkosi Emmanuel Bengu, Minister of Education, after consultation with the Council of Education Ministers, hereby give notice in terms of section 55 (1) of the South African Schools Act, 1996, that the immovable property of a school which was declared to be a state-aided school under section 29 (2A) of the Education Affairs Act, 1988 (House of Assembly) (Act No. 70 of 1988), devolves on the State, unless such property or portion of the property was lawfully alienated.

2. The date of expropriation shall be **1 September 1997**, on which date the ownership of the said property shall vest in the State.

3. (a) Any parties concerned who wish to make submissions regarding the immovable property of the school reverting back to the State must make written submissions to the Minister of Education and send it to:

(c) The submission must reach the Department of Education within 31 days after publication of this notice.

(d) Please also provide the name, address, telephone number and fax number of a person whom the Department could contact concerning the submission.

4. The title deed of the property concerned or, if this is not in the possession of the school, the name and address of the person in whose possession or under whose control it is, must also be posted to the above address not later than 1 November 1997.

5. Any claims for compensation resulting from this notice must be properly motivated and submitted separately from the above submission to reach the Minister in writing at the above address within 31 days after the publication of this notice.
