NOTICE 1235 OF 1997

INDEPENDENT BROADCASTING AUTHORITY

AMENDMENT OF BROADCASTING LICENCE: ELECTRONIC MEDIA NETWORK LIMITED (M-NET)

The Independent Broadcasting Authority, acting in terms of Section 52 (6) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, No 153 of 1993, ("the Act") hereby gives notice of its decision to amend the television broadcasting licence of Electronic Media Network Limited (M-Net).

The licence conditions, which are fully set out in the accompanying Schedules, are made in terms of Section 52(1)(d) of the Act, and constitute an amendment to M-Net's licence described as Consolidated Licence Conditions of M-Net: Radio Act, 1952, which came into effect on 1 January 1991 and which was grandfathered in terms of Section 46 (2) (a) of the Act.

The aforesaid amendments to the licence will take effect on 1 April 1999 or such earlier date as M-Net may agree to in writing.

BROADCASTING LICENCE CONDITIONS**

1. DEFINITIONS

In these licence conditions any word to which a meaning has been assigned in the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act (No. 153 of 1993) shall have that meaning unless the context indicates otherwise.

1.1 "advertisement" means a spot commercial for which the broadcaster receives a consideration, in cash or otherwise, and which promotes the interest of any person, product or service. This includes sponsorships, infomercials and paid-for public service announcements, but excludes self-promotions, supply agreements and free public service announcements;

1.2 "amendment" means an amendment as contemplated in section 52 of the Act;

1.3 "Community Services Network Channel" (CSN) means the broadcasting service provided by M-Net on the frequencies as set out in Schedule B and any other additional frequencies as may be approved by the Authority in writing;

1.4 "consent" means approval in writing by any Councillor or member of a committee of Council, the Chief Executive Officer or any staff member

duly authorised by the Council to act for and on behalf of the Authority;

1.5 "control" includes any instance of control as contemplated in section 1(2) of the Act and as read with Schedule 2 to the Act;

1.6 "effective date" means 1 April 1999;

1.7 "M-Net" means the Electronic Media Network Limited, duly incorporated in terms of the Companies Act, Registration No. 85/02853/06;

1.8 "M-Net Channel" means the broadcasting service provided by M-Net on the frequencies as set out in Schedule C and any other frequencies as may be approved by the Authority in writing;

1.9 "Open Window" means the period between 17h00 and 19h00 each day during which time the broadcast signal on the M-Net Channel is unencoded;

1.10 "records" means:

1.10.1 for the purposes of South African Drama, records as contemplated in the Regulations on South African Television Content;

1.10.2 for the purposes of advertising, records as contemplated in the Television Licensees Records Regulations;

1.11 "South African content" shall have the same meaning as contemplated in the Regulations on SA Television Content;

1.12 "South African drama" means drama as contemplated in the Regulations

on South African Television Content;

1.13 "South African Television Performance Period" means the period between 05h00 and 23h00 every day;

1.14 "subscriber" means someone who pays a fee per month or otherwise in order to receive the M-Net services. In the case where a contract is concluded for the reception and redirection of the M-Net service to a number of households, joined together in a collective unit such as a block of flats or a hotel, each individual residential unit is regarded as a "subscriber". In cases where it is practically difficult or impossible to identify the number of individual residential units, the total contract amount per collective unit will be divided by the fee fixed by M-Net for the individual subscriber in order to determine the number of subscribers;

1.15 "the Act" means the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act No. 153 of 1993, as amended, and regulations made from time to time under section 78 thereof;

1.16 "working day" means any day other than Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday;

1.17 "year" means the financial year of the licensee.

2. PREAMBLE

2.1 M-Net has provided a national pay-television broadcasting service in South Africa since 1985.

2.2 These conditions, made under section 52(1)(d) of the Act, constitute an amendment to M-Net's licence conditions described as *Consolidated*

Licence Conditions of M-Net : Radio Act, 1952 which came into effect on 1 January 1991 and which was grandfathered in terms of Section 46(2)(a) of the Act.

2.3 This is an amendment of the grandfathered licence and is binding on M-Net as of the effective date and terminates on 31 March 2002.

2.4 This licence is issued with due regard to:

2.4.1 The Objects of the Act and the regulatory framework as set out in the Triple Inquiry Report of the Authority on the viability and protection of public broadcasting services, cross-media control, South African music and local television content, as approved by Parliament.

2.4.2 The precepts of section 2 of the Act, which require that the Authority, *inter alia*:

2.4.2.1 "promote the most efficient use of the broadcasting services frequency bands;

2.4.2.2 encourage investment in the broadcasting industry;

2.4.2.3 promote the stability of the broadcasting industry; and,

2.4.2.4 ensure fair competition between broadcasting licensees".

2.5 The points of reference in drafting these amended conditions are the Act, the Triple Inquiry Report and the Position Paper on Private Television. The Authority recognises the absence of broadcast policy for pay television.

2.6 In considering this amendment, the Authority did not investigate issues related to the efficient use of frequencies given that this is a grandfathered licence and the frequency plan has not yet been completed.

2.7 Issues related to sports rights are subject to the outcome of a national policy which is being formulated in this regard.

2.8 In further considering this amendment, the Authority did not investigate cross-media ownership given that this is a grandfathered pay television licence.

2.9 In granting this amended licence the Authority has taken account of public representations.

3. INTRODUCTION

3.1 This is a licence to provide a private national pay-television broadcasting service and is conditional on compliance by the licensee with the provisions of the Act, the regulations prescribed or to be prescribed thereunder and all the terms, conditions and obligations set out in this licence.

3.2 In complying with these licence conditions, the licensee is encouraged to provide programming which reflects, through its content and sourcing, a South African identity in its diversity. The licensee is also encouraged to continue to contribute to and to promote the development and equal enjoyment of South African languages, cultures and provincial diversity.

4. PROVISION OF TWO SEPARATE CHANNELS

4.1 The licensee is licensed to provide an entertainment service, including but not limited to, feature films, sports events, magazine and community programming, documentary features, news, information programming and drama.

4.2 This licence grants to the licensee the right to the provision of the two distinct and separate channels described below, namely:

4.2.1 the M-Net Channel as set out in paragraph 1.8 above; and

4.2.2 the Community Services Network Channel as set out in paragraph 1.3 above.

4.3 THE M-NET CHANNEL

4.3.1 Subject to paragraph 4.4.1., the licensee may televise its programmes in encoded form only, for reception by persons who subscribe to its service.

4.3.2 During any one year, the licensee must allocate a weekly average of 6% of the South African Television Performance Period in encoded time to South African content on the M-Net channel.

4.3.3 The licensee may not provide a regular news service between the hours of 17h00 and 22h00 other than announcements of national importance.

4.4 THE OPEN WINDOW

4.4.1 The licensee may broadcast an unencoded signal on its M-Net Channel only during the period 17h00 to 19h00 each day.

4.4.2 During the broadcast of the unencoded signal on its M-Net Channel, the licensee must comply with the following programming requirements:

4.4.2.1 Generally, the Open Window must reflect at least three genres of the programming broadcast during encoded time. Compliance with this condition will be measured annually.

4.4.2.2 Ensure that a weekly average of 20% of its programming consists of South African drama. Compliance with this condition will be measured annually.

4.5 THE COMMUNITY SERVICES NETWORK CHANNEL

4.5.1 The licensee must allocate a weekly average of 9% of the South African Television Performance Period in encoded time to South African television content on the CSN channel. Compliance with this condition will be measured annually.

4.5.2 The licensee must ensure that it broadcasts a minimum of 50% of community services programming which must include minor sports and development sports programming. Compliance with this condition will be measured annually.

4.5.3 The licensee may provide such programming as it chooses for the remainder of the hours of broadcast on the CSN channel.

4.5.4 An average of 80% of community services programming should be broadcast between the hours of 06h00 and 00h00. Compliance with this condition will be measured annually.

4.5.5 In allocating broadcasting time to community affairs and events, the licensee must ensure that the programming caters for minority communities which are broadly reflective of South African society.

5. HOURS OF BROADCAST

The licensee is licensed to broadcast 24 hours per day on each channel and no change to the broadcasting hours may be effected without the written approval of the Authority.

6. NAME

6.1 This licence is granted to the Electronic Media Network Limited, described in paragraph 1.7 above.

6.2 The station identifications of the services broadcast by the licensee are "M-Net" and the "Community Services Network Channel".

6.3 The licensee may not change its name or station identifications without the written approval of the Authority.

7. PERIOD OF THE LICENCE

7.1 This licence is valid until 31 March 2002.

8. STATION IDENTIFICATION

The licensee must clearly identify itself at regular intervals not less than once every hour during the broadcast period.

9. FINANCES

9.1 Within three months after the end of each financial year, the licensee must submit to the Authority a copy of its audited financial statements; and,

9.2 The licensee must submit to the Authority any supporting vouchers and documentation as the Authority may require after receipt of the audited financial statements.

10. FEES

10.1 The licensee must pay to the Authority a maximum annual licence fee of 2% of turnover derived on both channels less agency fees and other deductions to a maximum of 20% of the 2%, or such lesser sum as the Authority may determine.

10.1.1 The Authority will announce a licence fee at the commencement of each financial year.

10.1.2 Should the licensee seek a reduced fee it must demonstrate good cause to the satisfaction of the Authority.

10.2 The licence fees are payable to the Authority within three months of the licensee's financial year-end.

10.3 In the event of the licensee applying to amend any of the terms and conditions of this licence, the licensee must pay to the Authority, with the application, a non-refundable *licence amendment fee* of R200 000 or such fee as may be prescribed by the Authority.

10.4 An application for renewal of this licence in terms of section 44, or of a transfer in terms of Section 74, must be accompanied by a non-refundable *licence renewal fee* of R300 000 or such fee as may be prescribed by the Authority.

11. ADVERTISEMENTS

11.1 The licensee must use no more than an average of six minutes per hour of encoded broadcasting time for the broadcasting of advertisements subject to the provisions of 11.2. This average will be measured over a year.

11.2 Advertising must not exceed a maximum of twelve minutes in any one hour of encoded time.

11.3 The licensee must use no more than an average of eight minutes per hour of the Open Window for the televising of advertisements subject to the provisions of 11.4. This average will be measured over a year.

11.4 Advertising must not exceed a maximum of twelve minutes in any one hour during the Open Window.

11.5 The licensee shall, in accordance with section 57(1) of the Act, comply with the Code of Advertising Practice of the Advertising Standards Authority of South Africa or any laws which affect the advertising of goods or services on electronic media.

12. OWNERSHIP AND CONTROL

The Authority encourages the licensee to include persons from previously disadvantaged groups in its ownership and control structures.

13. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT

13.1 The licensee must adopt equal opportunity employment practices.

13.2 The licensee must ensure that its management and staff are representative of South African society and that its human resource policies, particularly with regard to historically disadvantaged persons, take into account the development of managerial, production and technical skills and expertise.

14. COVERAGE AREA

Unless otherwise specified in writing by the Authority the licensee's coverage area shall be limited to those areas for which it has been previously licensed. A summary of the technical specifications is attached as Schedules B, C and D.

15. COMPLAINTS

15.1 The station manager or any other person designated by the station and in the station's full time employ must deal with complaints concerning the station from any source whatsoever and liaise with the Authority in regard to complaints of the nature contemplated in section 63(1) of the Act in relation to the licensee.

15.2 The Authority must be notified in writing within seven days of receipt of these licence conditions of the name and contact numbers of this person. Should the licensee propose to replace the person so appointed, the Authority must immediately be advised in writing of the name and contact numbers of the new appointee.

15.3 The licensee must ensure that it regularly broadcasts information to the public on how to lodge a complaint.

15.4 The licensee must adopt procedures acceptable to the Authority for handling complaints received from the public in respect of programmes broadcast under this licence.

15.5 Where the Broadcasting Monitoring and Complaints Committee ("the Committee") retains jurisdiction over any complaint against or investigation into the licensee, the licensee must comply with the procedures of the Committee in its adjudication of such complaint or investigation.

16. INFORMATION TO BE FURNISHED TO THE AUTHORITY

16.1 The licensee must inform the Authority of the name, nationality, residential and business addresses, or any changes thereto, of:

16.1.1 any person appointed as director, board member of the licensee, and of any director or board member of the licensee who resigns;

16.1.2 any person in a position to exercise direct or indirect control over the selection or scheduling of a significant proportion of the programmes of the licensee;

16.1.3 any person in a position to exercise direct or indirect control over a significant proportion of the operations of the licensee in providing the broadcasting service under this licence;

16.1.4 any person in a position to veto any action taken by the board of the licensee or any delegate of that board;

16.1.5 any person in a position to appoint, or secure or veto the appointment of any director or member of the board of the licensee;

16.1.6 any person who is in a position to give or exercise directly or indirectly any restraint or direction over any substantial issue affecting the management of affairs of the licensee.

16.2 The licensee must provide the Authority with the information contemplated in 16.1 in writing within thirty days of the effective date of this licence and thereafter within fourteen days of any change;

16.3 The licensee must inform the Authority, in writing, within fourteen days of any judgment awarded in a court of law against it or any person whose adverse financial position or misconduct could have any prejudicial effect on the service of the licensee.

16.4 The licensee must provide to the Authority the following documents:

16.4.1 the memorandum/articles of association of the licensee;

16.4.2 Any shareholders agreement to which it is a party or becomes a party;

16.4.3 any management agreement relating to the licensee, including any service agreement relating to the overall operations or affairs of the licensee or a significant proportion thereof;

16.4.4 any other agreement which is likely to affect the control, management, programming or operation of the service, and any material changes to ownership.

16.5 The licensee must provide to the Authority the documents contemplated above within 30 days of the issuing of this licence and in the case of any new or amended agreement within fourteen days of the date on which the agreements were signed.

16.6 This licence or any right(s) conferred in terms hereof shall not be ceded, transferred, assigned, pledged or otherwise disposed of by the licensee unless in compliance with prescribed procedures.

17. RECORDS

17.1 The licensee must submit to the Authority, on a quarterly basis, records of South African content, including South African Drama, broadcast in both the Open Window and encoded time during the previous quarter.

17.2 The licensee must retain, as required by the Act, recordings of programmes in a form acceptable to and compatible with the equipment used by the Authority.

17.3 The licensee must submit to the Authority, on a quarterly basis, records of advertisements broadcast every hour during the previous quarter.

18. NOTICES AND ADDRESSES

18.1 Any notice or certification given by the Authority must be in writing and:

18.1.1 if delivered by hand to the licensee's address supplied under 18.3 it shall be deemed, until the contrary is proved by the licensee, that it has been received by the licensee at the time of delivery;

18.1.2 if posted by pre-paid registered post from an address within the Republic of South Africa to the licensee at the address supplied by the licensee under 18.3, shall be deemed, until the contrary is proved by the licensee, to have been received by the licensee on the 14th day after the date of posting; and

18.1.3 if sent by facsimile transmission an acknowledgement of receipt of such communication must be sent to the Authority in writing within two working days of receipt thereof or such lesser period as may be determined by the Authority.

18.2 Any notice or communication given by the licensee to the Authority must be in writing and:

18.2.1 if delivered by hand to the Authority's address it shall be deemed, until the contrary is proved by the Authority, that it has been received by the Authority at the time of delivery;

18.2.2 if posted by pre-paid registered post from an address within the Republic of South Africa to the Authority at the address supplied by the Authority, shall be deemed, until the contrary is proved by the Authority, to have been received

by the Authority on the 14th day after the date of posting;

18.2.3 if sent by facsimile transmission an acknowledgement of receipt of such communication must be sent to the licensee in writing within two working days of receipt thereof; and

18.2.4 marked for the attention of such official as the Authority may designate from time to time in regard to the matter or type of matter, or failing such notification, the Chief Executive Officer.

18.3 The licensee shall provide the Authority with an address where it will accept formal service of letters, documents and legal process in this regard as well as a fax and telephone number on which it can be contacted. The licensee must further notify the Authority in writing of any change in such address, fax and telephone numbers prior to the changes being effected.

19. PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENTS

19.1 When requested by the National or a Provincial Commissioner of Police, the licensee must, without charge, broadcast any information or other matter concerning a disaster or immediate grave danger which the Commissioner may and on reasonable grounds request to be broadcast. Such request should be confirmed in writing within twenty-four hours. On receipt of such request the licensee must inform the Authority and a copy of the written request must be forwarded to the Authority within 48 hours.

19.2 When requested by the Authority the licensee must, without charge, broadcast such particulars at such intervals as the Authority may reasonably request for the purpose of publicising any applications, inquiries or hearings concerning the licensee.

20. GENERAL

20.1 Should any provision of this licence be invalid or unenforceable the remaining provisions shall nevertheless remain of full force and effect.

20.2 The licensee must comply with the Code of Conduct for Broadcasting Services in the Act or a code of conduct which is administered by a body which the Authority has acknowledged in writing in terms of section 56(2) of the Act.

21. EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS LICENCE

The conditions set out in this licence shall come into effect on 1 April 1999 except for those conditions which the licensee may agree to in writing or be willing to implement before 1 April 1999.

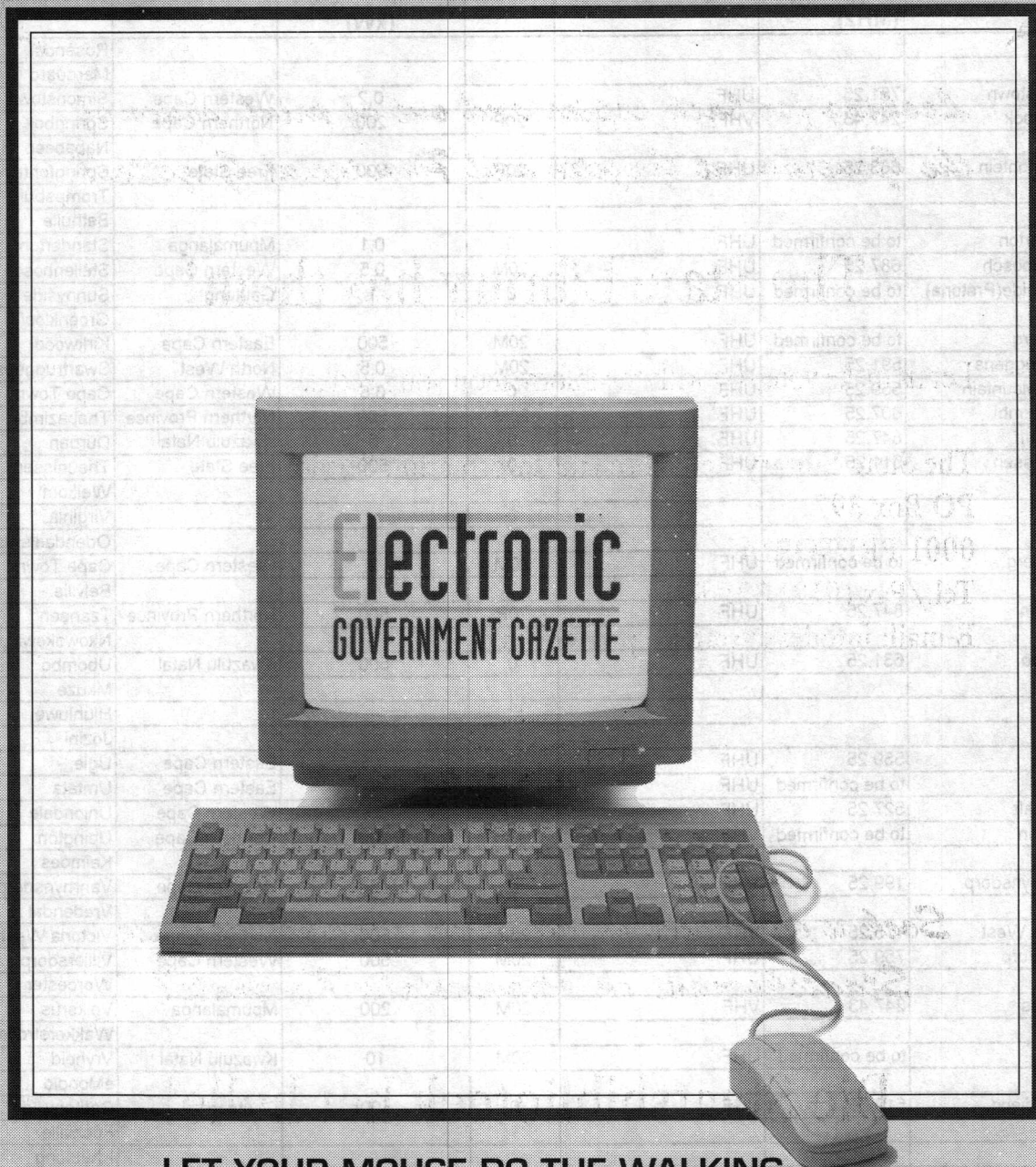

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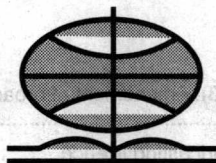
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
