NOTICE 1247 OF 1997 THREE RIVERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT VOTERS' ROLL

The voters' roll for the Three Rivers Irrigation District, District of Worcester, province of the Western Cape, as prepared by the Director-General of the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry in terms of section 83 of the Water Act, 1956 (Act No. 54 of 1956), is published below.

Mr B. van Zyl, Principle Engineer, of the Office of the Regional Director: Western Cape, has, in terms of section 84 of the said Act, been appointed returning officer for the election of members of the Irrigation Board for the Three Rivers Irrigation District. A nomination meeting for the election of four such members will be held on **Tuesday, 16 September 1997 at 14:00** at "Hexkoel" Orchard. If more nominations are received than there are vacancies, an election will be held immediately.

Persons whose names appear on the voters' roll are entitled to vote in person and representatives of registered companies or closed corporations must produce proof that they are either directors or shareholders of such companies or members of such closed corporations and that they are authorised to present such companies or closed corporations.

For every five hectares of scheduled area, or part thereof, a voter has one vote, up to a maximum of 10 votes.

In cases where owners have a joint vote and are scheduled for less than five hectares they must designate, in writing, one of their number to vote on their behalf.

The voters' roll will be revised before nominations are made. The scheduled area in this notice should not be seen as a confirmation of the water right of a property as the schedule area is only accepted for the purpose of the nomination meeting.

Samuel Johnson was born on 9th September 1709 at Lichfield in Staffordshire. He was the fourth of six children of Michael Johnson, a schoolmaster, and his wife, Catherine. He was educated at Lichfield and then at St John's College, Oxford, where he graduated in 1738. He then spent some time in France and Italy before returning to England in 1741. He was then employed as a schoolmaster at various places, but in 1750 he was appointed to the post of schoolmaster at the famous boarding school at Upton, near Lichfield. It was at Upton that he met and married his wife, Anne, in 1751. They had three children, two of whom died in infancy.
