The Independent Broadcasting Authority gives notice, in accordance with section 52(2)(a) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, Act 153 of 1993, that an application has been received in terms of section 52(1)(c) for amendments to the Public Television Broadcasting Licences of the South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC).

The Independent Broadcasting Authority *inter alia* recommended in its Triple Inquiry Report that the public broadcaster should strive to provide a truly national coverage, reaching all South Africans, even in the more remote areas of the country. The SABC accordingly intends to expand its television coverage to cater for those viewers who have previously been denied access to some of its Channels. This proposed expansion will be done in two phases:

- 1. the elimination of the SABC2/SABC3 transmitter switch in the Eastern Cape and Kwazulu/Natal and
- 2. the expansion of the transmitter network of SABC1 and SABC3 to achieve 85% population coverage.




