APPLICATION TO AMEND BROADCASTING LICENCE : SOUTH  
AFRICAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION (SABC)

The Independent Broadcasting Authority gives notice, in accordance with section 52(2)(a) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, Act 153 of 1993, that an application has been received in terms of section 52(1)(c) for amendments to the Public Television Broadcasting Licence of the South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC) to make provision for:

1. the incorporation of the complete transmitter network of Bop TV, consisting of 20 transmitters, into the SABC Public Television Broadcasting Licence in terms of the Former States Broadcasting Reorganisation Act, 1996 (Act 91 of 1996);
2. the following changes at the Johannesburg (Brixton) Transmitting station:
  - 2.1 the increase in effective radiated power to 100Kw;
  - 2.2 the change in transmission frequency from 591.25 MHz (CH 36) to 711.25 MHz (CH 51) and
  - 2.3 the use of a high power, omni-directional transmitting antenna.

These proposed changes will result in Bop TV being made available to viewers throughout much of Gauteng, who install an appropriate UHF receiving antenna.

The application, the relevant Schedules and any written representations received pursuant thereto are open for inspection by interested parties during the normal office hours of the Authority.
