NOTICE TO AMEND BROADCASTING LICENCES: SOUTH AFRICAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION (SABC) AND ELECTRONIC MEDIA NETWORK LIMITED (M-NET)

Frequency changes to self-help stations

The licensing of ETV on high power frequencies will cause interference to self-help stations from various broadcasters. The Independent Broadcasting Authority (the Authority) will therefore have to make changes to existing self-help stations in the interest of orderly frequency management and hereby gives notice, in accordance with section 52(2)(a) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, Act 153 of 1993, that in terms of section 52(1)(a) it intends to amend the broadcasting licences of the SABC and M-Net, as set out in the Schedule. The proposed amendment shall take effect on the date of gazetting of the Authority's decision to amend, accordingly, in terms of section 52(4).

The proposed frequency changes will have a minimum effect on the viewers without any change in ERP and polarisation. There are however three cases where VHF transmissions are changed to UHF transmissions. In two of the cases viewers will have to change receive antenna systems.
