WATER RESEARCH FUND: RATES AND CHARGES

1. I, Kader Asmal, in my capacity as Minister of Water Affairs and Forestry, hereby levy in terms of the authority vested in me by section 11 of the Water Research Act, 1971 (Act No. 34 of 1971), the following rates and charges which include Value Added Tax of 14%:

- (a) Two hundred and seventy two cents (272c) in respect of each hectare of land which at any time during the 1999/2000 water year is scheduled in terms of section 63 (7) of the Water Act, 1956 (Act No. 54 of 1956), or in respect of which an allocation has been made in terms of section 56 (3) of the said Water Act for the irrigation thereof at any time during the said water year with water supplied or made available from any Government water work. This rate shall be recovered by or on the instructions of the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, simultaneously with any rate or charge which I may levy in respect of the land concerned during the said period in terms of section 66 of the said Water Act or, if no such rate or charge is levied, the rate levied hereby shall be payable upon demand to the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry.
- (b) The amount mentioned in 1 (a) above in respect of each hectare of land scheduled under the control of an irrigation board or other statutory body in terms of section 88 of the said Water Act for the irrigation thereof at any time during the 1999/2000 financial year of such board or body with water supplied or made available from a Government water work or a water work belonging to such irrigation board or other statutory body. This rate shall be recovered by the irrigation board or other statutory body concerned and shall be remitted to the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry within thirty (30) days of the close of the financial year of that irrigation board or other statutory body.
- (c) With effect from 1 January 1999, to comma six five cents (2,65c) per cubic metre in respect of metered water supplied or made available from a Government water work for purposes other than the irrigation of land: Provided that if a gratis allocation has been made to specific consumer from a Government water work, the said charge shall not apply to that allocation, as it is deemed to be water supplied from his own sources by the consumer concerned. These charges shall be recovered by the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, simultaneously with any charge which I may levy in terms of section 66 of the said Water Act in respect of the supply of such water from the said date or shall be payable to him upon demand.
- (d) With effect from 1 January 1999, two comma six five cents (2,65c) per cubic metre in respect of the quantity of water supplied or made available for use for urban, industrial or domestic purposes by the Rand Water Board, by any regional services council established in terms of the Regional Services Councils Act, 1985 (Act No. 109 of 1985), by any regional water services corporation established in terms of the Water Services Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 27 of 1963) (Natal), by a joint services board established in terms of the KwaZulu and Natal Joint Services Act, 1990 (Act No. 84 of 1990), by the Pelgrimshoop Water Works Closed Corporation, by the Western Transvaal Regional Water Company (Pty) Ltd, by the North-West Water Supply Authority established in terms of the North-West Water Supply Authority Act, 1988 (Act No. 39 of 1988), by any water board or irrigation board established in terms of the said Water Act and by any local authority as defined by section 1 of the Remuneration of Town Clerks Act, 1984 (Act No. 115 of 1984), which is, on the date hereof, classified in terms of section 8 of this Act in Grades 3 to 15: Provided that there shall be deducted from the total quantity of water supplied or made available after 1 January 1999 by any one of the above-mentioned suppliers the quantity of water supplied or made available from a Government water work as contemplated in paragraph 1 (c) and the quantity of water obtained from any of the above-mentioned suppliers after that date in respect of which the charge referred to in paragraph 1 (c) or (d) has already been paid. The total amount payable in terms of this paragraph in respect of water supplied or made available shall be remitted by the supplier concerned, so as to reach the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, Private Bag X313, Pretoria, 0001, or such other offices as agreed upon, as follows:

(aa) In respect of the period 1 January to 30 June of each year, on or before 30 September of the same year; and

(bb) in respect of the period 1 July to 31 December of each year, on or before 31 March of the ensuing year.

The audited statements prescribed under section 11 (3) (b) of the said Water Research Act shall be submitted as soon as possible after the payments mentioned in paragraph 1 (d) have been made.

2. If such rates and charges remain wholly or partly unpaid after the due date, interest shall be charged on the outstanding amount at the standard rate of interest applicable on the date in terms of section 26 (1) of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), on loans granted by the State out of the State Revenue Fund.
3. For the purpose of this notice one cubic metre shall be equal to one kilolitre.

Hierdie belasting word verhaal deur, of in opdrag van, die Direkteur-Generaal: Waterwese en Bosbou gelyktydig met enige belasting of vordering wat ek gedurende die tydperk kragtens artikel 66 van genoemde Waterwet ten opsigte van die betrokke grond hef, en indien geen sodanige belasting of vordering gehef word nie, is die belasting wat hierby gehef word, op aanvraag van die Direkteur-Generaal: Waterwese en Bosbou betaalbaar.
- (b) Die bedrag in 1 (a) hierbo vermeld ten opsigte van elke hektaar grond wat onder beheer van 'n besproeiingsraad of ander statutêre liggaaam kragtens artikel 88 van genoemde Waterwet ingelys is met die oog op die besproeiing daarvan te eniger tyd gedurende die 1999/2000-boekjaar van so 'n raad of liggaaam met water wat verskaf of beskikbaar gestel word uit 'n Staatswaterwerk of 'n waterwerk wat aan sodanige besproeiingsraad of ander statutêre liggaaam behoort. Hierdie belasting word deur die betrokke besproeiingsraad of ander statutêre liggaaam verhaal en aan die Direkteur-Generaal: Waterwese en Bosbou oorbetaal binne dertig (30) dae na die sluiting van daardie besproeiingsraad of ander statutêre liggaaam se boekjaar.
- (c) Vanaf 1 Januarie 1999, twee komma ses vyf sent (2,65c) per kubieke meter ten opsigte van gemeterde water wat vir ander doeleindes as die besproeiing van grond uit 'n Staatswaterwerk verskaf of beskikbaar gestel word: Met dien verstande dat waar aan 'n bepaalde verbruiker 'n gratis toekenning uit 'n staatswaterwerk gemaak is, genoemde vordering nie op daardie toekenning van toepassing is nie deur dat dit geag word water te wees wat deur die betrokke verbruiker uit eie bronne voorsien is. Hierdie vordering word deur die Direkteur-Generaal: Waterwese en Bosbou verhaal, gelyktydig met enige vordering wat ek kragtens artikel 66 van genoemde Waterwet hef ten opsigte van die verskaffing van sodanige water vanaf genoemde datum, of is op aanvraag aan hom betaalbaar.
- (d) Vanaf 1 Januarie 1999, twee komma ses vyf sent (2,65c) per kubieke meter ten opsigte van die hoeveelheid water verskaf of beskikbaar gestel vir gebruik vir stedelike, nywerheids- of huishoudelike doeleindes deur die Randwaterraad, deur 'n streekdiensteraad ingestel kragtens die Wet op Streekdiensterade, 1985 (Wet No. 109 van 1985), deur 'n streekwaterdienstekorporasie ingestel kragtens die Ordonnansie op Waterdienste, 1963 (Ordonnansie No. 27 van 1963) (Natal), deur 'n gesamentlike diensteraad ingestel kragtens die Wet op Gesamentlike Dienste vir KwaZulu en Natal, 1990 (Wet No. 84 van 1990), deur die Pelgrimshoop Waterwerke Beslote Korporasie, deur die Wes-Transvaalse Streekwatermaatskappy (Edms.) Bpk., deur die "North-West Water Supply Authority" ingestel kragtens die "North-West Water Supply Authority Act, 1988 (Act No. 39 of 1988)", deur enige waterraad of besproeiingsraad wat kragtens genoemde Waterwet ingestel is, en deur enige plaaslike owerheid soos omskryf in artikel 1 van die Wet op die Besoldiging van Stadsklerke, 1984 (Wet No. 115 van 1984), wat op datum hiervan kragtens artikel 8 van dié Wet in Grade 3 tot 15 ingedeel is: Met dien verstande dat daar van die totale hoeveelheid water wat ná 1 Januarie 1999 verskaf of beskikbaar gestel word deur een van bogenoemde verskaffers, afgetrek moet word die hoeveelheid water wat verskaf of beskikbaar gestel is uit 'n Staatswaterwerk soos bedoel in paragraaf 1 (c) en die hoeveelheid water wat ná daardie datum van enige ander bogenoemde verskaffers verkry is ten opsigte waarvan die vordering in paragraaf 1 (c) en (d) bedoel, reeds betaal is. Die betrokke verskaffer moet toesien dat die totale bedrag betaalbaar ingevolge hierdie paragraaf ten opsigte van water verskaf of beskikbaar gestel, die Direkteur-Generaal: Waterwese en Bosbou, Privaat Sak X313, Pretoria, 0001, of sodanige ander kantore as waarop ooreengekom is, soos volg bereik:

- (aa) Ten opsigte van die tydperk 1 Januarie tot 30 Junie van elke jaar, voor of op 30 September van dieselfde jaar; en
- (bb) ten opsigte van die tydperk 1 Julie tot 31 Desember van elke jaar, voor of op 31 Maart van die daaropvolgende jaar.

Die geouditeerde state voorgeskryf by artikel 11 (3) (b) van genoemde Waternavorsingswet, moet so gou moontlik nadat die betaling genoem in paragraaf 1 (d) gedoen is, voorgelê word.

2. Indien sodanige belastings en vorderings na die betaaldag in die geheel of gedeeltelik nog onbetaalda is, word rente op die onbetaalde bedrag gehef teen die standaardrentekoers wat op daardie datum kragtens artikel 26 (1) van die Skatkiswet, 1975 (Wet No. 66 van 1975), van toepassing is op lenings wat uti die Staatsinkomstefonds deur die Staat toegestaan word.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE PROPOSED REGULATIONS

The Minister of Agriculture intends to make regulations in terms of section 20 of the Genetically Modified Organisms Act, 1997 (Act No. 15 of 1997), as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned thereto in the Act, shall have that meaning and –

"facility" means any place where the contained use of genetically modified organisms is undertaken;

"activity" means any work undertaken with regard to the development, production, use and application of genetically modified organisms;

"the Act" means the Genetically Modified Organisms Act, 1997 (Act No. 15 of 1997);

"the guidelines" mean the Guidelines and Procedures for Genetically Modified Organisms as approved by the Council in terms of section 5(l) of the Act.

Authority to import, export, develop, produce, use, release or distribute a genetically modified organism

2. (1) No applicant may import to or export from the Republic of South Africa, or develop, produce, use, release or distribute any genetically modified organism in the Republic of South Africa except in terms of a permit to undertake such an activity or in terms of any exemption granted to that applicant in terms of the Act.

(2) An applicant must, besides complying with the provisions of these regulations, comply with all other laws dealing with the importation and exportation of genetically modified organisms.

Registration of facility and maintenance of records

3. (1) Subject to the provisions of subregulation (4), all facilities shall be registered with the registrar.

(2) An application for the registration of a facility shall be made on a form as set out in Annexure B to these regulations.

(3) A separate application shall be lodged with the registrar in respect of each facility and each such application shall be accompanied by –

- (a) a locality map that clearly indicates where the facility is situated; and
- (b) the application fee specified in item 1 of Annexure A to these regulations.

(4) Applications for the registration of a facility active prior to the commencement of these regulations shall be submitted to the registrar within one year of the date of such commencement: Provided that, should the Minister deem it necessary, upon the advice of the Committee, that a facility should be registered prior to the expiration of the one-year period, the Minister may by way of a written notice to the user, require that a particular facility be registered within a period specified in that notice.

(5) Upon registration of a facility, the registrar shall furnish the applicant with a certificate of registration and a copy of the guidelines.

(6) (a) The user of a registered facility shall keep and maintain, *inter alia* in hard copy format, and upon request, make available to the registrar or an inspector-

- (i) the certificate of registration referred to in regulation 5;
 - (ii) a list of genetically modified organisms present at the facility;
 - (iii) a register of all personnel working with genetically modified organisms at the facility and of all persons authorised by the user to have access to that facility; and
 - (iv) records of all activities conducted with genetically modified organisms at the facility.
- (b) The register referred to in subregulation (a)(iii) shall contain the following information on each person listed therein:
- (i) first names and surname;
 - (ii) personal identity number or passport number;
 - (iii) residential address;
 - (iv) academic qualifications; and
 - (v) details of each activity and genetically modified organism that the person is working with or to which he or she has access.
- (c) The user shall notify the registrar of any change to the information provided in terms of this regulation and shall not dispose of any list, register and record maintained in terms of this regulation.

Applications for and issue of permits

4. (1) A person intending to conduct any activity specified in column 1 of the table below, shall conduct such activity under the authority of a permit issued by the registrar.

(2) An application for a permit referred to in subregulation (1) shall be made to the registrar on the corresponding application form specified in column 2 of the said table.

(3) An application referred to in subregulation (2) shall be made not less than the number of days specified in column 4 of the table, prior to the proposed commencement of the corresponding activity.

(4) Where an applicant is unable to provide any information requested in an application form, such applicant shall, when submitting the application form to the registrar, furnish the registrar with written reasons for such inability.

(5) The applicable application fee specified in Annexure A to these regulations shall accompany each application.

(6) The registrar shall, as soon as possible after receipt of an application referred to in subregulation (2)-

(a) acknowledge, in writing, receipt of such application;

(b) examine the conformity of the application to the requirements of the Act; and

(i) if the application does not conform to the requirements of the Act in any respect, immediately refer the application back to the applicant and request the applicant to rectify the application where it does not conform; or

(ii) if the application conforms to the requirements of the Act, submit the application to the Council for consideration.

(7) The Council may

- (a) approve an application referred to in subregulation (6)(b)(ii) and authorise the registrar to furnish the applicant with the applicable permit to undertake the activity concerned; or
- (b) refuse such application and furnish written reasons therefor.

(8) The registrar may, at his or her discretion, fast tract any application for an activity involving genetically modified organisms for which a permit had previously been issued.

Activity not requiring permit

5.(1) No permit shall be required for the conducting of any activity involving genetically modified organisms specified in Annexure G.

(2) Any person intending to conduct any activity referred to in subregulation (1) shall notify the registrar in writing thereof.

(3) Discontinuation of the activity referred to in subregulation (2) shall also be brought to the attention of the registrar, in writing.

Public notification of proposed trial release and general release of genetically modified organisms

6. (1) The public shall be notified of any proposed trial release and general release of genetically modified organisms.

(2) Public notification shall be in the form of a notice published in the printed media informing the public of the intended trial release.

(3) The notice referred to in subregulation (2) shall contain:

- (a) the full names and address of the applicant;
- (b) a full description of the genetically modified organisms that the applicant proposes to release;
- (c) a description of the proposed trial release, including the area and environment in which the release is to take place;
- (d) a request that interested and affected parties submit comments or objections in connection with the intended release to the registrar within a period specified in the notice: Provided that such period shall not be less

than thirty days after the date on which the notice appears in the media; and

(e) the address of the registrar to which comments or objections may be submitted.

(4) The applicant shall publish the notice in at least three newspapers circulating in the area in which the proposed release is to take place.

(5) Proof of notification as required in terms of this regulation shall accompany the application for the trial release.

(6) The registrar shall refer any comments or objections received from interested and affected parties to the Council.

(7) The Council shall, when considering an application for a trial release, consider all the comments and objections referred to it in connection with the said application.

(8) The provisions of subregulations (1) to (7) shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the general release of genetically modified organisms.

Accidents

7. In the event of an accident involving genetically modified organisms, it shall be the responsibility of the user concerned to ensure that –

(a) the registrar is notified immediately orally and in writing of such accident and that at the same time, or as soon as possible thereafter, supplied with information regarding –

(i) the circumstances of the accident;

(ii) the identity and quantity of the genetically modified organisms released;

(iii) any information necessary to assess the impact of the accident on the environment; and

(iv) the emergency measures taken to avoid or mitigate any adverse impact of such accident on the environment.

(b) all appropriate short-term, medium-term and long-term measures are taken to avoid or mitigate any adverse impact of such accident on the environment.

Requirements for effective management of waste

8.(1) Any person who possesses or controls waste shall manage and dispose of such waste so that the waste does not have any negative impact on the environment.

(2) The person mentioned in subregulation (1) shall comply with all relevant national, provincial and local authority legislation in his or her management and the disposal of the waste in his or her possession or under his or her control.

Inspections

9. All applicants and users shall provide access to any place or facility or documentation to an inspector to enable such inspector to exercise his or her functions in terms of the Act.

Provisions in regard to an appeal

10.(1) An appeal in terms of section 19 of the Act shall –

- (a) be lodged with the Minister in writing within thirty days from the date on which the appellant was notified in writing of the decision or action concerned;
- (b) state the reference number and the date of the document by means of which such appellant was notified of that decision or action;
- (c) state the grounds on which the appeal is based; and
- (d) be accompanied by the fee specified in item 7 of Annexure A to these regulations.

(2) An appeal shall be lodged with the office of the Minister and a copy thereof lodged with the registrar by the appellant.

(3) The appeal board may request the appellant to appear before the appeal board in order to clarify any issue on appeal.

(4) The appellant shall be notified in writing by the appeal board not less than three days in advance of the date, time and place at which he or she is to appear before the appeal board.

(5) The appellant shall be entitled to legal representation during any appearance before the appeal board.

(6) An appeal board shall provide the Minister with a decision on the appeal within thirty working days after an appeal has been lodged.

Offences and penalties

11. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision or requirement of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to the penalties as provided for in the Act.

PUBLICATION OF A DECISION IN TERMS OF SECTION 11 (7) OF THE PAN SOUTH AFRICAN LANGUAGE BOARD ACT, NO. 59 OF 1995: VIOLATION OF LANGUAGE RIGHTS

1. WHEREAS Professor Carstens has lodged a complaint with the Board, stating that the South African Post Office has contravened the provisions of section 6 of the Constitution Act, 1996, by introducing a language policy which states that—
 - (a) all formal business within the South African Post Office shall be conducted in English only.
 - (b) all signage to be erected at new or renovated post office buildings, post points, postal agencies and any other physical structures where signage is required, shall be in English.
2. AND WHEREAS the Board has investigated the complaint in terms of section 11 of the Pan South African Language Board Act;
3. NOW THEREFORE, the Board hereby publishes the following reasons for its decision together with the recommendations:
 - (a) that the South African Post Office has violated the language rights of its employees;
 - (b) the language policy of the South African Post Office ignores the Constitutional objective to elevate the status and advance the use of official languages particularly the historically diminished indigenous official languages;
 - (c) although the financial factor is one of the considerations to be taken into account, it must be considered within the context of the Constitution's main objective, namely, to promote multilingualism. Financial considerations must not be used as a scapegoat for defeating the aims of the Constitution which is the highest law of the land;
 - (d) the Board recommends that the South African Post Office must amend its language policy so as to make it more flexible and accommodative of the multilingual objective of the Constitution Act, 1996, and the Pan South African Language Board Act, 1995;
 - (e) the Board also recommends that the employees of the South African Post Office be involved in a process of consultation when drawing up its language policy; and
 - (f) in terms of section 8 (j) of the Pan South African Language Board Act, the Board may assist with and monitor the formulation of programmes and policies aimed at fostering the equal use of the official languages. On the basis of this provision the Board calls upon the South African Post Office to liaise with it so that the Board can assist in this regard.
