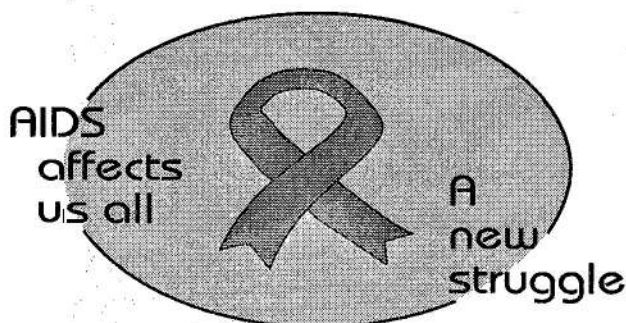

BOARD ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF HYDROGEN PEROXIDE ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM SOUTH KOREA

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) accepted the petition from the Petitioner on 31 March 1999. The notice of initiation was published in *Government Gazette* No. 20115 dated 28 May 1999 (Notice No. 1108).

The Petitioner alleged that hydrogen peroxide was being imported at allegedly dumped prices and that material injury to the SACU industry was occurring as a result.

The Board subsequently made a preliminary determination that provisional duties be imposed for a period of twenty six weeks in order to remove the injury, during the period of investigation as follows:

PROVISIONAL PAYMENT AMOUNTS

(Unit per kilogram of the alleged dumped imported good)

Hansol Chemical Corporation	147% ad valorem
Oriental Chemical Industries	167% ad valorem
Other manufactures in South Korea	167% ad valorem

The Board will also recommend to the Minister of Trade and Industry that in the absence of opposing responses, the duties be made final.

All responses must be received by the Director: Dumping Investigations not later than 30 days following the date of publication of this notice or, in the case of parties known to be interested, 30 days following the date on which the letter accompanying the above-mentioned report is received. The said letter shall be deemed to have been received seven days after the date of its dispatch.

Confidential and non-confidential versions of the response

Please note that all responses have to be completed twice, once as the confidential version and once as the non-confidential version if the response contains confidential information.

Oral representations

Oral representations to the Board may also be made on written request to the Board at least seven days prior to the expiry of the original 30-day period and by prior arrangement with the Directorate. Such oral representations must be made within the same time period as the written representations, unless prior written consent of the Board has been obtained for the oral representations to be made at a later date, which shall in any event not be later than 14 days after the written representations have been submitted.

Extensions

It should be noted that the investigation process is complex and that the Board is subject to strict time limits within which to complete the investigation. Late submissions will therefore not be accepted except with the prior written consent of the Board. The Board will give due consideration to written requests for an extension of not more than 14 days on good cause shown (properly substantiated), if such requests are received prior to the expiry of the original 30-day period. Merely citing insufficient time is not an acceptable reason for an extension.
