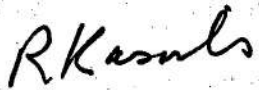
- (a) which live near or around state forests, and
- (b) which have not entered into a community forestry agreement in terms of section 29,

from the requirement to obtain any licence in terms of section 23(1)(c), (d) and (f)

1 This exemption is granted upon the following conditions-

- (a) The persons referred to may collect and remove firewood and other forest produce for household purposes only and may not sell or in any way deal in it for the purpose of gain
- (b) No live wood or branch may be collected, cut or removed
- (c) Only such forest produce as is customarily used for domestic, cultural, health or spiritual purposes may be collected and removed
- (d) Only such quantity of firewood or other forest produce may be collected and removed as can be carried on the person
- (e) No firewood or other forest produce may be collected or removed by means of any vehicle from within the forest
- (f) No firewood or forest produce may be collected or removed from-
 - (i) a protected area declared in terms of section 8, or
 - (ii) a controlled forest area declared in terms of section 17(2)
- (g) No firewood may be collected or removed-
 - (i) before sunrise or after sunset

- (ii) more than once a day by the same person or member of his or her household
 - (h) No hunting of any animal may be done
- 2 For the purposes of collecting and removing firewood and other forest produce in terms of this exemption the persons referred to must-
 - (a) enter and leave the state forest through designated entrances
 - (b) where possible, notify the forest officer or other person in charge of their entrance
- 3 For the purpose of ensuring sustainable production, the forest officer or other officer in charge may-
 - (a) limit or control the number of people allowed in the forest at any one time
 - (b) impose reasonable restrictions to prevent fires or harm to persons or property
 - (c) if the forest is a plantation, impose such restrictions as to ensure that its economic purpose is not defeated
 - (d) examine any firewood or forest produce collected or removed by any person
 - (e) limit or control the quantity of firewood that may be collected and removed by any person on any one day
 - (f) limit or control the collection and removal of firewood or forest produce derived from any species
 - (g) identify places at which or periods during which no collection and removal of firewood or forest produce may take place
 - (h) seek the assistance of the community in performing his or her tasks

HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA

RULES RELATING TO CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN PSYCHOLOGY

The Health Professions Council of South Africa intends, in terms of section 26 read with section 15B of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), to make the rules set out in the Schedule.

Interested persons are invited to submit any substantiated comments or representations on the proposed rules to the Registrar, P.O. Box 205, Pretoria, 0001 (for the attention of the Secretary: Professional Board for Psychology), within one month of the date of publication of this notice.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS

1. In these rules **"the Act"** means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), and, unless inconsistent with the context—

"Board" means the Professional Board for Psychology established by Government Notice No. R. 75 of 16 January 1998;

"continuing professional development" means the continuing education and training referred to in section 26 of the Act and prescribed in terms of these rules;

"practitioner" means a psychologist, a psychometrist or a registered counsellor registered in terms of the Act;

REQUIREMENTS

2. Any psychologist whose name on 1 January 2000 or any psychometrist whose name on 1 January 2001 or any registered counsellor whose name on 1 January 2001 appears on the register of psychologists or the register of psychometrists or the register of registered counsellors kept in terms of section 18 of the Act, shall be required to comply during sequential periods of two years with the conditions of continuing professional development laid down in these rules and, thereafter, during sequential periods of two years as a prerequisite for such practitioner, to retain his or her registration in terms of the Act.

3. Any psychologist who after 1 January 2000, or any psychometrist who after 1 January 2001, or any registered counsellor who after 1 January 2001, registers for the first time in terms of the Act as a psychologist or after 2001 as a psychometrist or after 2001 as a registered counsellor in any category of independent practice or public service, shall commence with his or her two year cycle on 1 January of the following year and shall be required to comply with the conditions of continuing professional development laid down in these rules during sequential periods of two years each, which shall be a prerequisite for such practitioner to retain his or her registration in terms of the Act.

4. Any psychologist whose name is restored to the register subsequent to 1 January 2000, or any psychometrist whose name is restored to the register subsequent to 1 January 2001 or any registered counsellor whose name is restored to the register subsequent to 1 January 2001 whose name is restored to the register of psychologists or psychometrists or registered counsellors subsequent to 1 January 2000, after it had been erased from the said register for a period exceeding twelve months, shall commence with his or her two year cycle on 1 January of the following year.

Provided that practitioners whose names had been erased for periods of less than twelve months, shall continue in their normal two year cycle.

5. For the purpose of continuing professional development, every practitioner shall be required to accumulate at least 50 points within any two year cycle, with a minimum of 12 points being accumulated in any one year.

6. The 50 points prescribed in rule 5 shall be accumulated by way of different educational or developmental activities accredited by the Board in any of the following categories of activities:

- (1) Formally organised learning activities
- (2) Small-group activities
- (3) Individual activities
- (4) Any other activities or category of activities which the board may accredit from time to time.

7. During any cycle of two years, no practitioner may accumulate more than seventy (70) percent or 35 points of his or her points from activities in any one of the categories specified in rule 6, provide that at least fifty (50) percent or 25 points are obtained in the practitioner's area of focus.

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8. During any cycle of two years, at least 5 points will have to be obtained by every practitioner in professional ethics.
9. Deferment of compliance with the requirements of continuing professional development will be granted by the board on application to individual practitioners on submission of adequate reasons and subject to such requirements as the Board may determine, in the case of—
- (a) a practitioner who is not practising his or her profession;
 - (b) a practitioner who resides outside South Africa for a period of time which will exceed twelve months;
 - (c) a practitioner who is engaged in education and training for an additional qualification.
 - (d) any other valid reason accepted by the Board.
10. In the event of a practitioner not complying with the conditions specified in these rules within the prescribed period of time, the Board may impose any one or more of the following conditions, namely—
- (a) granting the practitioner deferment for one extra year, on condition that the next two year cycle commences in that same year;
 - (b) requiring the practitioner to follow a remedial programme of continuing education and training as specified by the Board;
 - (c) requiring the practitioner to write an appropriate examination of the College of Professional Psychology of South Africa;
 - (d) register the practitioner in a category of registration which will provide for appropriate supervision and mentorship for a specified time period;
 - (e) erasing the name of the practitioner from the relevant register.
