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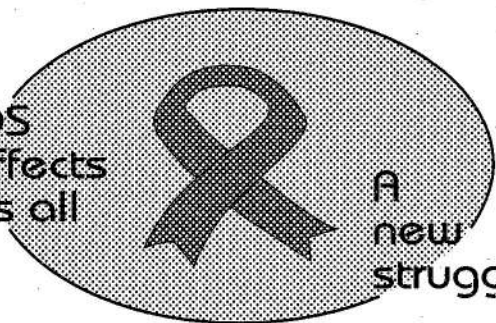

PROVINCIAL DIVISION OF THE HIGH COURT OF SOUTH AFRICA**

Notice is hereby given that the Judge President of the Orange Free State Provincial Division of the High Court of South Africa has, in terms of section 43 (2) (b) (i) of the Supreme Court Act, 1959 (Act No. 59 of 1959), amended Rule 2 of the Rules, regulating the conduct of proceedings of the Orange Free State Provincial Division of the High Court of South Africa, published under Government Notice No. R. 3290 of 12 September 1969, and in which subrule (1) was substituted by Government Notice No. 851 of 9 July 1999, by substituting the existing subrule (1) with the following new subrule (1):

TERMS:

- (1) (a) For the despatch of civil and criminal business of the Court there shall be four terms in each year, which terms are as follows for the year 2001:
- (i) From 22 January to 1 April, inclusive;
 - (ii) from 23 April to 24 June, inclusive;
 - (iii) from 23 July to 30 September, inclusive; and
 - (iv) from 15 October to 17 December, inclusive.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECESSES:

- (1) (b) The administrative recesses for the year 2001 are as follows:
- (i) From 1 January to 21 January, inclusive;
 - (ii) from 2 April to 22 April, inclusive;
 - (iii) from 25 June to 22 July inclusive;

NOTICE 1684 OF 2000**SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION****DISCUSSION PAPER 91: A NEW SENTENCING FRAMEWORK**

1. The Working Committee of the Commission recently approved the publication of Discussion Paper 91 for general information and comment. The Discussion Paper deals with a new sentencing framework for South Africa and contains recommendations on the enactment of a new Sentencing Framework Act.

2. The Commission accepts that there is substance to the criticism of the sentencing system that has been advanced in the past decade, both before and after the introduction of the 1997 Criminal Law Amendment Act. An ideal system should be seen to promote consistency in sentencing, deal appropriately with concerns that particular offences are not being regarded with an appropriate degree of seriousness, allow for victim participation and restorative initiatives and, at the same time, produce sentencing outcomes that are within the capacity of the State to enforce in the long term. The Commission therefore proposes a framework that in its view can meet all these desiderata to the greatest extent possible.

3. Such a framework will require the co-operation of the different branches of government. A single branch cannot solve the problem on its own. Reform proposals should combine, as far as possible, the advantages that may be derived from the involvement of all three branches of government in the sentencing process and eliminate the disadvantages inherent in giving a single one of them priority. In the model that the Commission proposes, sentencing decisions will continue to be made by the courts, but these decisions will be informed by new initiatives from the legislative and administrative branches that will meet the need for consistency, as well as for sensitivity to the seriousness of offences, the needs of victims and the capacity of the system to carry out sentences that have been imposed.

A NEW PARTNERSHIP

4. The key recommendation of the Commission is that the different arms of government enter into a new partnership on sentencing. To limit sentencing disparities there must be more

guidance for the courts on sentencing. In the first instance this will take the form of more specific guideline judgments and of normative sentencing guidelines. The Supreme Court of Appeal will give the guideline judgments in the course of the normal appellate process. These judgments will set guidelines in the light of principles developed by Parliament in legislation and information provided by a new Sentencing Council on sentencing patterns, the efficacy of various sentences and the capacity of the State to implement such sentences. The judiciary, key criminal justice departments, sentencing experts, and civil society through representatives of victims' organizations will be represented on this Council.

5. The Sentencing Council will be able to develop normative guidelines for categories of crime for which the Supreme Court of Appeal has not set guidelines. In addition the Sentencing Council will have to collect and publish comprehensive sentencing data on an annual basis. The Council would have to do research and publish reports on the efficacy and cost effectiveness of the various sentencing options provided by legislation and make policy recommendations on the further development of community corrections in particular.

6. The proposed combination of sentencing guidelines set by the courts with a Sentencing Council would have important structural advantages:

- a) The guideline-setting function of the Supreme Court of Appeal will retain a key role for the senior judiciary in sentencing decision-making, while provision for the Court to have placed before it information provided by the Sentencing Council would allow it to take into account factors that cannot normally be entertained when single cases are considered in isolation.
- b) The Sentencing Council set up in the way proposed will have the advantages of a sentencing commission in the sense that it would be able to take an overall view of the entire system and make recommendations based on requirements of principle in that light. Its information function will also be important, both in assisting the courts and in shaping public perceptions about the reality of sentencing options.
- c) The Sentencing Council will not be isolated from public opinion as it will have a duty to consult widely. In addition, both cabinet ministers and Parliament would be able to ask it directly to consider the development of guidelines for a category of offences that the public might regard as not being treated with the appropriate degree of seriousness.

7. A new sentencing framework requires not only a new partnership amongst the different arms of government. It requires also a new partnership between the State and the public in general and victims of crime in particular. The key to this partnership is improved provision for victim involvement in the sentencing process and recognition of victim concerns in the type of substantive sentences that are handed down.

8. At a substantive level, explicit attention is given to restitution and compensation for victims of crime. Restitution and compensation are key elements of the comprehensive new sentence of community corrections, which also allows victims to benefit from other orders such as community service by the offender and victim-offender mediation. Sentences may also be suspended on condition of restitution or compensation for victims of crime. In every case where neither of these sentences is imposed the court must consider whether a separate restitution or compensation order should be made.

9. The procedural innovations designed to benefit victims of crime include a requirement that prosecutors, when they intervene on sentence, must consider the interests of victims in every case. There is provision for victim impact statements to be presented to the courts so that they may learn what impact the crime had in practice. Victims must be told when and how they may be involved in the eventual release of sentenced offenders from prison. These innovations are backed by detailed rules to ensure that victims are told of their rights. There are also provisions to ensure that the income of offenders is revealed so that they can be ordered to make reparation for their crimes in an appropriate way.

10. The various changes that are proposed will be combined in a new piece of legislation, the Sentencing Framework Act. The Commission is putting forward a draft proposal for such a new Act. The new legislation will contribute to legal certainty by bringing together in one easily accessible law all the provisions dealing with the imposition of sentence. The general principles applicable to sentencing will be clearly stated. The publication of normative sentencing guidelines will simplify the task of the courts, thus contributing to speedy and effective justice and ensuring that offenders know what to expect. Simplified procedural rules will make it clear to the public what is happening in the sentencing process and encourage public participation in the administration of justice.

11. The Commission invites the comments of all parties who feel that they have an interest in the topic or may be affected by the measures discussed in the Discussion Paper. Individuals, organisations and institutions affected by the provisions of the proposed Sentencing Framework Act or who are likely to be affected by possible amendments to existing legislation should participate in this debate and are invited to indicate how the present law affects them, what their concerns are, what solutions they are able to propose and whether there are other issues and/or options affecting the law that must be explored.

Based on the outcome of these comments and discussions, a report containing the Commission's final recommendations will be prepared and presented to the Minister of Justice.

1. WHEREAS Radio Pretoria and Radio Riemland Trust submitted a complaint to the Board to the effect that Mrs. F. Sekha who represented the Independent Broadcasting Authority (IBA) on 26 January 1999 at, and chaired a licence application hearing of Radio Pretoria and its representatives, refused to hear the application in Afrikaans, and more particularly -
 - (a) that this decision infringed the Radio station's constitutional rights; and
 - (b) that this decision violated the rules of natural justice;
2. AND WHEREAS -
 - (a) Mrs. Sekha did not receive prior notification that Afrikaans will be used during the public hearing;
 - (b) Radio Pretoria did not receive prior notification that English must be used during the hearing; and
 - (c) the licence application submitted by Radio Riemland was postponed at the time and legal action was instituted against the IBA;
3. AND WHEREAS the Board investigated the complaint in terms of section 11(4) of the Pan South African Language Board Act, 1995;
4. NOW THEREFORE, since in this instance the conduct of the Chairperson did not do justice to section 6 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996), the Board hereby decides -
 - (a) that the IBA's language policy may not require that licence applicants and their legal representatives address the IBA in English at public hearings; and
 - (b) that the IBA must remove the uncertainties surrounding the language choices of licence applicants.
5. The Board hereby recommends -
 - (a) that the licence application forms of the IBA must request licence applicants to stipulate their preferred language at a licence hearing;

- (b) that the IBA must afford licence applicants an opportunity to testify in the official language of their choice;
- (c) that the IBA must arrange, at its own cost, for interpreters to be available to interpret the licence applicant's statements to the panel when necessary;
- (d) that if the IBA is unable to arrange for an interpreting service during a public hearing, it must notify the licence applicant accordingly well in advance and offer to carry the reasonable costs that may arise from arrangements undertaken by the applicant concerned; and
- (e) that the IBA must allow licence applicants to make use of their own interpreters and interpreting equipment if they so prefer. If agreed beforehand with the IBA, the reasonable costs of such arrangements are for the account of the IBA.

2. AND WHEREAS the Board also received a complaint from the Mineworkers' Union that the Head Office of ESKOM communicates externally in English only and is unable to provide a language policy when requested to do so;
3. AND WHEREAS the Board investigated the complaint in terms of section 11(4) of the Pan South African Language Board Act, 1995, and found that –
 - (a) ESKOM regularly sends out monolingual account statements; and
 - (b) ESKOM adopted English as the only official language for purposes of external communication;

 - (i) is contrary to the policy of multilingualism contained in the Constitution of South Africa Act, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996);

 - (b) that it is reasonable for the public to expect from ESKOM, a public entity which is the only provider of electricity services in the country, to take their language preferences into account.

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BOARD NOTICE 35 OF 2000**PUBLICATION OF A DECISION IN TERMS OF SECTION 11(7) OF THE PAN SOUTH AFRICAN LANGUAGE BOARD ACT, 1995 (ACT NO. 59 OF 1995)**

1. WHEREAS various complaints were submitted to the Board to the effect that the Municipality of Bloemfontein –
 - (a) sends out monolingual accounts despite section 6(3)(b) of the Constitution Act, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996), thereby curtailing the use of Afrikaans;
 - (b) is not seriously considering modifying this practice;
 - (c) infringes the democratic principles of the Constitution; and
 - (d) uses cost and administrative burden as justifications in this regard;
2. AND WHEREAS the Board investigated the complaint in terms of section 11(4) of the Pan South African Language Board Act, 1995, and found –
 - (a) that the language practice of the Municipality does not comply with the language policy norms outlined in the Constitution, namely –
 - (i) to take steps to ensure that parity of esteem is accorded to all languages and that they are treated equitably; and
 - (ii) to elevate the status and advance the use of historically diminished languages;
 - (b) that the Municipality resorted to practical considerations to avoid application of the constitutional language policy norms on the use of official languages;
3. NOW THEREFORE, the Board hereby decides –
 - (a) that the practice of the Municipality violates the language rights of the Afrikaans-speaking residents of Bloemfontein;
 - (b) that the potential negative impact of considerations of a financial and administrative nature on the policy of multilingualism may not be elevated to the status of a norm on the same level with the language policy norms outlined in the Constitution; and

- (c) that the Municipality must take the language usage and preferences of its residents into account in planning and finalising its accounts.
- 4. FURTHERMORE, the Board hereby recommends that the Municipality of Bloemfontein –
 - (a) take note of the available census figures concerning the variety of languages used in the Free State Province, and
 - (b) take steps to determine the language preferences of Bloemfontein residents beyond doubt.

1. NADEMAAL verskeie klagtes aan die Raad voorgelê is, waarvolgens die munisipaliteit van Bloemfontein -
 - (a) ondanks artikel 6(3)(b) van die Grondwet, 1996 (Wet No. 108 van 1996) eentalige rekeninge uitstuur, en daardeur die gebruik van Afrikaans inperk;
 - (b) nie die verandering van hierdie gebruik ernstig oorweeg nie;
 - (c) die demokratiese beginsels van die Grondwet skend; en
 - (d) kostes en administratiewe belading as regverdiging in hierdie verband gebruik;
2. EN NADEMAAL die Raad die klagtes ondersoek het ingevolge artikel 11(4) van die Wet op die Pan-Suid-Afrikaanse Taalraad, 1995, en bevind het -
 - (a) dat die taalpraktyk van die munisipaliteit nie voldoen aan die taalbeleidsnorme soos vervat in die Grondwet nie, naamlik -
 - (i) om stappe te doen om te verseker dat gelyke aansien aan alle tale verleen word, en dat hulle gelykwaardig hanteer word; en
 - (ii) om die status van histories miskende tale te verhoog, en die gebruik daarvan te bevorder;
 - (b) dat die Munisipaliteit praktiese oorwegings gebruik het om die toepassing van grondwetlike taalbeleidsnorme met betrekking tot die gebruik van amptelike tale te ontduik;
3. DERHALWE besluit die Raad hiermee -
 - (a) dat die Munisipaliteit se praktyk die taalregte van Afrikaanssprekende inwoners van Bloemfontein skend;
 - (b) dat die moontlike negatiewe uitwerking van finansiële en administratiewe oorwegings op die beleid van veeltaligheid nie verhef kan word tot die status van 'n norm op dieselfde vlak as die taalbeleidsnorme soos vervat in die Grondwet nie; en

- (c) dat die Munisipaliteit die taalgebruik en -voorkeure van sy inwoners in ag moet neem by die beplanning en afhandeling van rekeninge.
- 4. VERDER beveel die Raad hiermee aan dat die Munisipaliteit van Bloemfontein -
 - (a) kennis neem van die beskikbare sensussyfers met betrekking tot die verskeidenheid van tale wat in die Vrystaat gebruik word; en
 - (b) stappe doen om die taalvoorkeure van Bloemfontein se inwoners bo enige twyfel vas te stel.
