

PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF THE TELEVISION BROADCASTING LICENCE OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION (SABC) AND THE SIGNAL DISTRIBUTION LICENCE OF SENTECH (PTY) LTD (SENTECH)

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (the Authority), acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 52(2)(a) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 153 of 1993 (the Act), as amended, hereby gives notice that it intends amending the television broadcasting licence of the SABC and the signal distribution licence of Sentech in accordance with the provisions of section 52(1)(a) of the Act.

The proposed amendment would, if effected, result in SABC TV1 at Aurora being relocated from frequency 519.25 MHz at channel 27 to frequency 727.25 MHz at channel 53. Frequency 519.25 MHz at Piketberg would then be allocated to Midi TV (Pty) Ltd to enable the latter to expand its services. The proposed change would result in viewers at Aurora having to retune their television sets to receive SABC TV1 on the new channel. The Authority proposes this change in the interest of orderly frequency management.

The effective date of the amendment would be the date on which the Authority's decision on the amendment would be published.
