

In Notice 1135 multiplication schemes, chain letters and pyramid promotional schemes were declared unlawful by the Minister of Trade and Industry. The investigation will include the extending of certain clauses of the above mentioned Notice No 1135 of 1999 with the view to preventing the attempted circumvention of the mentioned Notice.
