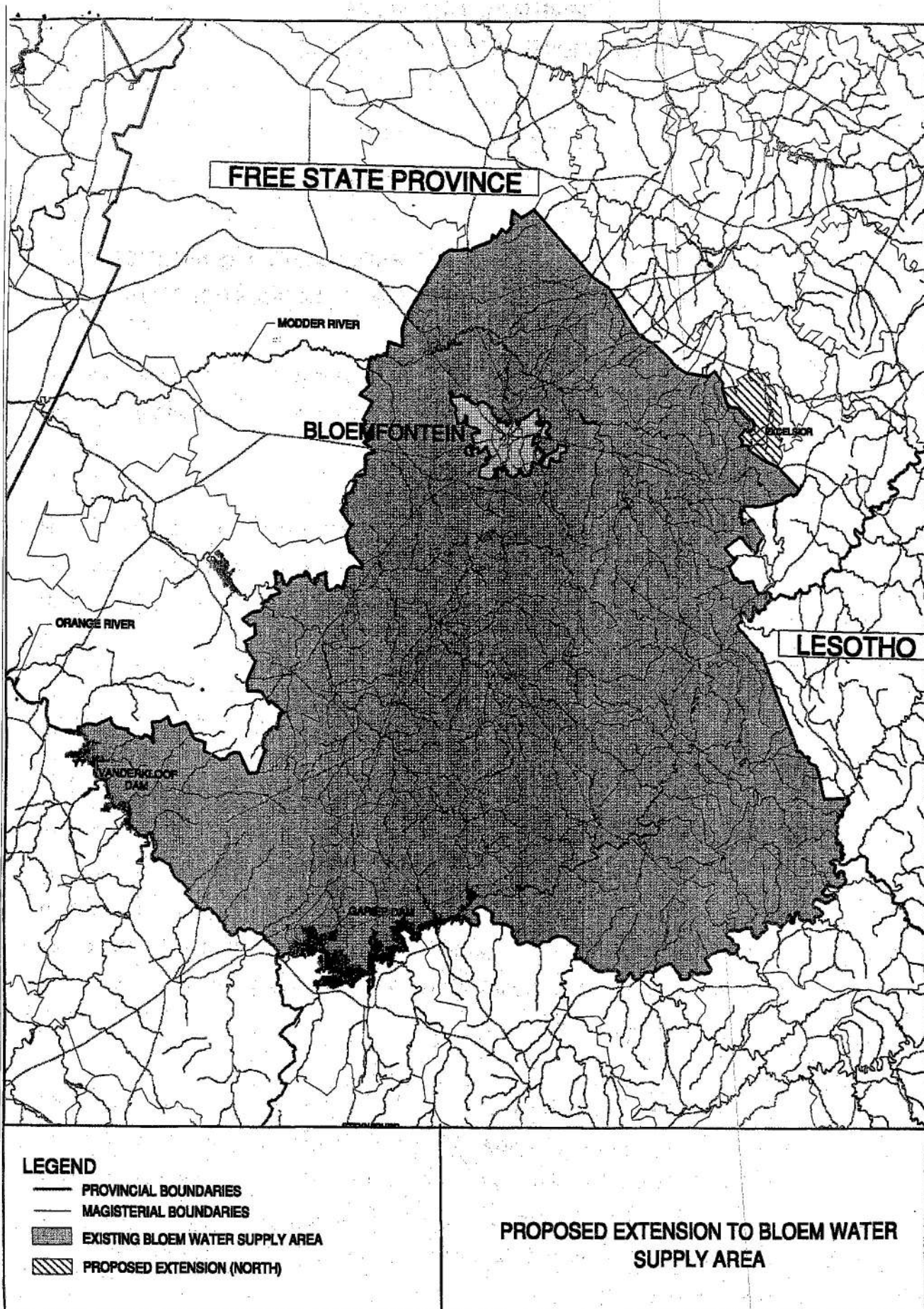

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### NOTICE 4614 OF 2000

#### SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION

#### REPORT - THE SIMPLIFICATION OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE: THE RIGHT OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS TO APPEAL ON QUESTIONS OF FACT

1. The Commission recently approved its third interim report in its investigation into the simplification of criminal procedure. The report deals with the right of the Director of Public Prosecutions to appeal on questions of fact.

2. As the law stands at present, an accused can appeal, subject to certain procedural qualifications, against any aspect of bail, a conviction or sentence in a criminal case. The accused may also have proceedings in lower courts reviewed and, in the case of the High Court, have irregularities dealt with by way of appeal or special entry.

3. The State, on the other hand, may appeal (also subject to similar procedural qualifications) against the granting of bail, an acquittal on a legal ground and also against an inadequate sentence. Experience has shown that these rights are used sparingly by the State. What the State does not have is any right to appeal against a finding of not guilty in relation to the facts of the case - the so-called appeal on the merits. The difference between questions of law and fact is often one of extreme difficulty to judge or apply and there are many reported cases dealing with the distinction. The same problem arose in the context of, for instance, tax appeals and because of the ever present difficulty the distinction in tax cases has been abolished without any deleterious effect.

4. In the present context there are conflicting policy considerations. The one is that an accused person has benefits and protections - some which are protected by the Constitution - which the prosecution, representing the community and the victims of crime, does not always enjoy. The administration of justice in South Africa (especially with regard to criminal procedure) has followed the English tradition and has always been characterised by liberality and respect for the individual.

5. On the other hand, there are the interests of society, whose members (not only the

victims) also enjoy the rights contained in the Bill of Rights and are entitled to a just and fair decision in criminal cases. They have an interest in the conviction and sentencing of a person who is clearly guilty and who, because of incompetence or obvious errors in the trial court, go free. The Commission concluded that it cannot be doubted that a significant number of criminals go unpunished due to numerous flaws in the administration of the criminal justice system.

6. In considering the question whether a procedure such as the right to appeal should be changed, the Commission also considered whether the system, which denies the State a full right of appeal, satisfies present demands and whether changes may contribute towards achieving justice in the administration of the criminal law. In the end, the question which the Commission had to answer essentially boiled down to this: since the State has a right of appeal in connection with bail, sentence and questions of law, why should it not have a similar right in relation to factual matters? Because that is the issue, the Commission did not reconsider the rights of the convicted to appeal or the existing rights of appeal afforded to the State - all subjects dealt with in earlier reports and, to some extent, in recent legislation - but focussed on the limited issue at hand. The Commission's brief is to simplify criminal procedure and in the course of the investigation it became clear that some changes, which are not directly related to the limited issue at hand, are also necessary. Some of these changes are cosmetic while others are aimed at simplifying criminal appeals generally. The Commission used this opportunity to also address these non contentious issues.

7. After considering the relevant international Human Rights documents, a comparative study on the right of the prosecution to appeal and the Constitution the Commission concluded that there is sufficient justification for the extension of the right of the Director of Public Prosecutions to appeal to include an appeal on questions of fact and recommends that the right of the Director of Public Prosecutions to appeal be extended to include questions of fact.

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**NOTICE 4615 OF 2000****SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION****DISCUSSION PAPER 94: SENTENCE AGREEMENTS**

1. The Commission recently approved the publication of a discussion paper on sentence agreements in its investigation into the simplification of criminal procedure. The discussion paper is published for general information and comment and it deals with the question whether provision should be made for plea agreements (plea bargaining) in South African criminal procedure.
2. The Commission concluded that the Criminal Procedure Act, because it gives a wide discretion to the prosecution, directly and indirectly, does provide for plea agreements. What it does not cover, is sentence agreements. Recent studies conducted in South Africa show that plea (and even sentence) negotiation is alive and well in South Africa and performs an important part in our criminal justice system.
3. There are two types of sentencing agreements. The one is where the prosecution, in exchange for a plea of guilty, undertakes to submit to the court a proposed sentence or agrees not to oppose the proposal of the defence. This type is known in our law. The agreement has no effect on the court and does not require any particular action from the court. The court can ignore the agreement or implement it. If it ignores the agreement, the plea of guilty stands, so does the sentence. The Commission concluded that there is no reason why this procedure should be dealt with by way of legislation. The second type is the case where the accused agrees with the state to plead guilty provided an agreed sentence is imposed and in the Commission's view it is this type of agreement that should be legalised and regulated.
4. A procedure which provides for sentence agreements will have important advantages for the criminal justice system. A serious matter is the backlog in courts and the inability of the Legal Aid Board to finance the defence of the indigent. A system which formalises plea agreements and which makes the outcome of the case more predictable will make it easier for practitioners to permit their clients who are guilty to plead guilty. Protection of the victim against publicity and against having to be subjected to cross-examination has also become a sensitive issue. Plea agreements may limit such exposure. The practice of plea negotiation in South

Africa could make an important contribution to the acceleration of the process. Statutory measures could be provided to meet legitimate objections so that the procedure could eventually be used to improve the effectiveness of the system of criminal law, while still maintaining established principles.

5. The Commission therefore recommends that sentence agreements be statutorily recognised and that legislation provide for the following principles and procedure.

6. The Commission invites the comments of all parties who feel that they have an interest in the topic or may be affected by the measures discussed in the Discussion Paper. Individuals, organisations and institutions affected by the provisions of the proposed Sentencing Framework Act or who are likely to be affected by possible amendments to existing legislation should participate in this debate and are invited to indicate how the present law affects them, what their concerns are, what solutions they are able to propose and whether there are other issues and/or options affecting the law that must be explored.

Based on the outcome of these comments and discussions, a report containing the Commission's final recommendations will be prepared and presented to the Minister of Justice.

**NOTICE 4616 OF 2000****SOUTH AFRICAN LAW COMMISSION****REPORT: A NEW SENTENCING FRAMEWORK**

1. The Commission recently approved the final report in its investigation into reform of the law relating to sentencing. The report deals with a new sentencing framework for South Africa and contains recommendations on the enactment of a new Sentencing Framework Act.
2. The South African sentencing system faces various problems. There is a perception that like cases are not being treated alike; that sentencers do not give enough weight to certain serious offences; that imaginative South African restorative alternatives are not being provided for offenders that are being sent to prison for less serious offences; that sufficient attention is not being paid to the concerns of victims of crime; and that, largely because of unmanageable overcrowding, sentenced prisoners are being released too readily.
3. Such a framework will require the co-operation of the different branches of government. A single branch cannot solve the problem on its own. Reform proposals should combine, as far as possible, the advantages that may be derived from the involvement of all three branches of government in the sentencing process and eliminate the disadvantages inherent in giving a single one of them priority. In the model that the Commission proposes, sentencing decisions will continue to be made by the courts, but these decisions will be informed by new initiatives from the legislative and administrative branches that will meet the need for consistency as well as sensitivity to the seriousness of offences, the needs of victims and the capacity of the system to carry out the sentences that have been imposed.

**A NEW PARTNERSHIP**

4. The key to the proposal is that the different arms of government enter into a new partnership. There will be more guidance for the courts on sentencing. In the first instance this will take the form of sentencing principles that are clearly articulated in legislation. In this way there will be a decisive break with common law, which has recognised divergent sentencing principles without establishing a clear relationship or hierarchy.



5. These principles will be supplemented by sentencing guidelines developed by an independent Sentencing Council for a particular category or sub-category of offence. The Sentencing Council will have to do research and consult widely before developing guidelines. It will have to collect and publish on an annual basis comprehensive sentencing data including a full list of all sentencing guidelines. The Council will also have to publish reports on the efficacy and cost effectiveness of the various sentencing options provided by legislation, determine the value of fine units and make policy recommendations on the further development of community penalties.

6. A new sentencing framework requires not only a new partnership amongst the different arms of government. It requires also a new partnership between the State and the public in general and victims of crime in particular. The key to this partnership is improved provision for victim involvement in the sentencing process and recognition of victim concerns in the type of substantive sentences that are handed down. The proposed new Sentencing Framework Bill addresses these issues in various ways.

7. Other innovations include attention to provisions for the major sentences of imprisonment for life or for a fixed period and provisions for the detention of dangerous criminals. Where such persons have committed offences that involved a serious physical injury and continue to present a major risk to the public, they may be detained for extended periods. Community penalties are expanded by further provision for correctional supervision and community service. Conditions that may be attached to these sentences are spelt out and the procedures for imposing them simplified. More emphasis is placed on restitution and compensation for victims of crime. To this end a new sentence of reparation is proposed. It includes elements of both restitution and compensation. The sentence may be imposed as an independent sentence, either on its own or together with other sentences. In addition imprisonment or a fine may be suspended on condition of reparation. The proposal is that the sentencing court must consider some form of reparation in every case. The method of calculating fines has also been overhauled. In the future fines will be more closely related to the means of the offender.

8. The procedural innovations designed to benefit victims of crime include a requirement that prosecutors, when they intervene on sentence, must consider the interests of victims in every case. There is provision for victim impact statements to be presented to the courts so that

they may learn what impact the crime had in practice. Victims must be told when and how they may be involved in the eventual release of sentenced offenders from prison. These innovations are backed by detailed rules to ensure that victims are told of their rights. There are also provisions to ensure that the income of offenders is revealed so that they can be ordered to make reparation for their crimes in an appropriate way.

9. The various changes that are proposed will be combined in a new piece of legislation, the Sentencing Framework Act.

**NOTICE 4667 OF 2000****BOARD ON TARIFFS AND TRADE****NOTICE OF INITIATION OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED CIRCUMVENTION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON BLANKETS, ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM CHINA AND TURKEY, BY THE IMPORTATION OF BLANKETING IN ROLL FORM**

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) received a petition alleging that circumvention of the anti-dumping duty imposed on blankets originating in or imported from China and Turkey is taking place through the importation of blanketing in roll form, thereby causing material injury to the SACU industry. The anti-dumping duty in question was imposed pursuant to Notice No. R 791 in *Government Gazette* No. 20226 on 18 June 1999. The reasons for the imposition of the anti-dumping duties were set out in the Board on Tariffs and Trade Report No. 3979 dated 10 June 1999.

**THE PETITIONER**

The petition was lodged by Waverley Blankets Ltd and Aranda Textile Mills (Pty) Ltd, the domestic manufacturers of blankets in the SACU. The Petitioner alleges that it cannot compete with the low prices charged for the imported products that are allegedly imported to circumvent the anti-dumping duty on blankets, and that this competition is causing them material injury. The Petitioner submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Board to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that an investigation should be initiated.

**THE PRODUCT**

The products on which the anti-dumping duty is allegedly being circumvented are blankets of acrylic fibre or blankets partially containing acrylic fibre, classifiable under tariff subheadings 6301.40 and 6301.90, originating in or imported from China and Turkey. The products that are allegedly being used to circumvent the anti-dumping duty



are woven fabrics containing 85% or more acrylic or mod-acrylic staple fibres, woven pile fabrics of man made fibres, knitted pile fabrics (long pile fabrics) and looped pile fabrics, classifiable under tariff subheadings 5512.29; 5515.29.57/90; 5801.34.90; 5801.35.90; 6001.10; 6001.2280; 6001.92. These products are allegedly being imported as blanketing in roll form or fabric in roll form and are then cut to the required sizes, seamed or otherwise completed and sold as blankets.

### **THE ALLEGATION OF CIRCUMVENTION**

The allegation of circumvention is based on the alleged replacement of the imports entered under tariff subheadings 6301.40/90 by imports entered under the tariff subheadings relating to the importation of the various fabrics stated above.

### **PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION**

The period of investigation for purposes of determining the existence and extent of the alleged circumvention will be from January 2000 to December 2000.

### **PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK**

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Board has begun an investigation in terms of section 4 of the Board on Tariffs and Trade Act, 1986 (the BTT Act). The Board will conduct its investigation in accordance with the BTT Act and the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the GATT 1994 (the Anti-Dumping Agreement). A copy of the Anti-Dumping Agreement is available from the Board's office on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Board will require the following information from interested parties that are importing fabric rolls that are destined for the production of acrylic blankets or blankets containing acrylic fibre of the kind classifiable under the above-stated tariff subheadings:

1. Registered (full names in the case of private individuals) names of importers;
2. Street addresses;
3. Postal addresses;
4. Responsible officials or contact persons;
5. Telephone and fax numbers, also provide any e-mail addresses;
6. Customs import registration numbers;
7. Please also provide the following information in table form in respect of your imports/purchases of the fabric products classifiable under the above-stated tariff subheadings :

8. Provide details of your manufacturing facilities as well as your capacity and current utilisation.
9. Provide details of the current employment in the manufacturing of the blankets.
10. Provide details of the selling prices and levels of trade in respect of each of the import transactions detailed in question 7 above.

Information other than that required under 1 to 10 of the previous paragraph may be required from the interested parties concerned during the course of the investigation.

The trade representatives of the exporting countries have also been notified. Importers, exporters and other interested parties are invited to contact the Board as soon as possible in order to provide the required information to the Board. The questionnaire has to be completed and any other representations must be made within the time limit set out below.

### **CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

Please note that if any information is considered to be confidential then a non-confidential version of the information must be submitted for the public file, simultaneously with the confidential version. In submitting a non-confidential version the following rules are strictly applicable and parties must indicate:

- where confidential information has been omitted and the nature of such information;
- reasons for such confidentiality;
- a summary of the confidential information which permits a reasonable understanding of the substance of the confidential information; and
- in exceptional cases, where information is not susceptible to summary, reasons must be submitted to this effect.

This rule applies to all parties and to all correspondence with and submissions to the Board, which unless indicated to be confidential and filed together with a non-confidential version, will be placed on the public file and be made available to other interested parties.

**PROCEDURES AND TIME LIMITS**

All responses, including non-confidential copies of the responses, should be received by the Director: Dumping Investigations not later than 30 days from the date of publication of this notice.

Late submissions will not be accepted except with the prior written consent of the Board. The Board will give due consideration to written requests for an extension of not more than 14 days on good cause shown (properly motivated and substantiated), if received prior to the expiry of the original 30-day period. Merely citing insufficient time is not an acceptable reason for extension. Please note that the Board will not consider requests for extension by Embassies on behalf of exporters.

The information submitted by any party may need to be verified by the investigating officers in order for the Board to take such information into consideration. The Board may verify the information at the premises of the party submitting the information, within a short period of time after the submission of the information to the Board. Parties should therefore ensure that the information submitted will subsequently be available for verification. Parties should also ensure that all the information requested in the applicable questionnaire is provided in the specified detail and format.
