NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS TO CLOSE TAXI ROUTES AND RANKS IN TERMS OF SECTION 49 (7) OF THE ACT

I, Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng, having already declared the area of the Greater East Rand (Ekurhuleni) Metropolitan Municipality as an area where it is, in my opinion, necessary to normalize the situation caused by violence, unrest and instability in the taxi industry and that it is in the interest of passengers and as the situation is still abnormal and as the closure of routes and ranks as mentioned hereinafter is in my opinion absolutely necessary to normalize the situation. I now give notice of my intention to make regulations in terms of section 49(7) of the Act to close the routes and ranks as fully described in the schedule hereto.
