**REQUEST FOR A STATUTORY MEASURE (LEVY) ON SORGHUM IN TERMS OF
THE MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT, 1996
(ACT NO 47 OF 1996), AS AMENDED**

1. STATUTORY MEASURE – LEVIES

The statutory measure that is requested to be established, is that the Minister in terms of section 15 of the Act, by notice in the Government Gazette, direct that a levy amounting to R5,00 per metric ton sorghum, excluding VAT, payable by the producers, processors, agents or brokers, importers, exporters of sorghum and persons who receive sorghum as remuneration for services rendered or for any goods delivered by them on their behalf, to the Sorghum Trust, be imposed.

2. INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 10 OF THE ACT

The particulars as required by section 10 of the Act to be included in a request for the establishment of a statutory measure, are as follows:

2.1 The statutory measure that is requested would relate to Sorghum [the threshed, ripe seed of plants of *Sorghum bicolor* (L.) Moench, but not seed sorghum or sorghum utilised as silage].

2.2 The categories of directly affected groups which would probably be affected by the proposed statutory measure, are:

Sorghum producers: (Accountable for 50% of the levy amount)

Sorghum buyers: (Accountable for 50% of the levy amount as well as for the payment of the full levy to the Sorghum Trust)

Four categories of buyers are involved, namely Sorghum processors, Sorghum traders, Animal feed manufacturers and Grain silo owners.

2.3 Letters of support for the proposed statutory measure on sorghum, by the different categories of directly affected and other groups in the sorghum industry were received.

2.4 The proposed statutory measure will apply to the whole of the Republic of South Africa, in order to have a uniform levy.

2.5 According to the applicant, the proposed statutory measure will further the objectives of the Act as stipulated in section 2(2) thereof. Such measure will also not contravene section 2(3) of the Act.

2.6 The manner in which the objectives referred to in section 2(2) of the Act will be furthered (namely the increasing of market access for all market participants, the promotion of the efficiency of the marketing of agricultural products, the optimisation of export earnings from agricultural products and the enhancement of the viability of the agricultural sector), are summarised below:

The continuation of the statutory measure is required in order to finance research and information services to the sorghum industry. Almost 90% of the research is being conducted by the ARC-GCI. SAGIS (The South African Grain Information Service) is responsible for the information function.

The increasing of market access for all market participants

Research and Information are generic functions that are the basic prerequisites for an orderly industry. Approximately 62% of the resources for sorghum research are allocated towards the commercial farming sector and 38% towards the small-scale farming sector.

These allocations differ for different projects and are determined by the farming sector, the goal of the project and the possible contribution by newly developed technology.

Information is *inter alia* an indicator to the market entrant as well as other market participants, of possible opportunities and threats in the market place, which should be used as instruments in decision-making, eg. price-fixing, expanding of business, capital investment and product development.

The promotion of the efficiency of the marketing of sorghum

In a free marketing environment, market information that is conducted by an independent and credible organisation (SAGIS) is a critical instrument for especially the producer, trader, processor, researcher and seed grower. In other words, information is needed for decision-making from the seed multiplication stage to the point where the product is offered to the consumer.

Approximately 90% of the research projects are of an agronomical nature and contribute to sorghum of acceptable quality to the buyers. The malting and milling qualities of sorghum are unique in South Africa and cultivars are bred to comply with the required qualities. Sorghum of these qualities is impossible to import from anywhere else in the world. In order to be able to offer (our unique) products of the desired qualities to the consumer, research has to be maintained.

Enhancement of the viability of the sorghum industry

As indicated above, the total sorghum industry's viability is based on the research and information functions and therefore also impacts on labour. The continuance of levies would therefore ascertain that the various role-players of the sorghum industry could effectively continue to pursue their economic objectives.

Optimisation of export earnings

Limited amounts are being exported to mainly the neighbouring countries of South Africa and in particular to Botswana. Botswana is dependant on South Africa for approximately 30% of its sorghum requirements (on an average annual basis), which relates to some R35 million worth of sorghum.

No one of the objectives of the Marketing Act is envisaged to impact negatively on any of the other objectives. Furthermore, the measure would not contravene Section 2(3) of the Act.

2.7 DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION AND DURATION OF STATUTORY MEASURE:

The measure requested for should be implemented as soon as possible as the existing statutory measure expires on 28 February 2002. The implementation of the proposed statutory measure should be applicable for an adequate period in order to ensure continuity of essential industry functions as determined by the sorghum industry. To comply with the provisions of section 13 (2) of the Act, it is suggested that the duration of the proposed statutory measures be three (3) years from the date of implementation as is the case of statutory levies already approved for other agricultural commodities. It should be borne in mind that the measures will, in terms of the Act, be subject to evaluation and review by the National Agricultural Marketing Council at least every two years. Furthermore, the Act provides for the application to be made for the repeal of statutory measures.

2.8 MOST APPROPRIATE BODY TO ADMINISTER MEASURE:

The Sorghum Forum requested that the following two bodies be appointed as administrators for the proposed statutory levies:

- o The Sorghum Trust; and
- o PricewaterhouseCoopers (previously Coopers & Lybrand).

These two bodies have administrated sorghum levies since 1998. The trustees of the Sorghum Trust are the custodians of the levy funds and the levy inspectors are reporting to them. PricewaterhouseCoopers is an international auditing firm, responsible for the banking, record keeping and transfer of all collected levy funds.

2.9 PARTICULARS ON ENFORCEMENT:

Adminhouse Agric CC (Secretaries to the Forum) will be liable for the inspection and enforcement functions of the statutory measure. Messrs N Fouche and MJ Koekemoer from this closed corporation are appointed as levy inspectors.

PROMULGATION OF STRUCTURAL TARIFF
ADJUSTMENTS FOR LARGE AND SMALL POWER USERS

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In 1999 Eskom developed a pricing strategy aimed at giving customers and the National Electricity Regulator (NER) as much advance notice of future tariff developments as possible.
- 1.2 For reasons of economic efficiency the NER supports the principle of cost-reflective and transparent tariffs, as stated in Government's Energy Policy White Paper of 1998 and consequently indicated that Eskom may proceed with tariff rebalancing towards greater cost reflectivity. Tariffs that are currently subsidised will have to be gradually increased to phase out these subsidies, subject to affordability considerations. Government needs to develop policy on subsidisation of the poor.
- 1.3 The most important driving force of the redesigned tariffs for 2002 is the alignment of retail tariffs with the Wholesale Electricity Pricing System (WEPS), the principles of which have already been approved by the NER.
- 1.4 All prices quoted in this notice are in 2001 rand value, exclusive of VAT and subject to Eskom general price increase for 2002. For more details regarding the proposed changes and the motivation for these changes, please consult Eskom's latest Retail Pricing Plan, which can be viewed at the following web address:

2. LARGE POWER USERS

The following structural changes will be introduced with effect from 1 January 2002.

2.1 WEPS alignment

The LPU tariffs will be aligned with WEPS. As a consequence of this alignment, the Nightsave tariffs will be seasonally differentiated while the peak, standard and off-peak rates of the time-of-use tariffs will be changed to reflect WEPS.

2.2 Voltage discount / voltage surcharge

The voltage discount will be increased by 2 percentage points for extra-high-voltage customers (>132 kV) with proportionally smaller increases for lower-voltage customers. Simultaneously with this change, the voltage discount will be converted into a voltage surcharge.

Eskom's existing tariffs are published at the level of low-voltage customers (<500 V) and higher-voltage customers receive a voltage discount to reflect the lower cost of supply at high voltage. The 2002 rates published in this notice are for customers supplied at high voltage (>132 kV) and lower-voltage customers will be subject to a voltage surcharge to reflect the higher cost of supply at low voltage.

The new voltage differentials are given in Table 1 below:

<500 V	0%	17.30%
≥500 V to <66 kV	5.33%	10.07%
≥66 to ≤132 kV	7.13%	7.63%

2.3 Network charge

A network charge based on the greater of the customer's notified maximum demand (NMD) and the actual measured demand over the previous 12 months will be introduced for Nightsave (Rural) and Ruraflex. The network charge will be determined in R/kVA. For customers measured in kW, the power factor will be assumed to be equal to 1 for the purposes of this charge.

2.4 Ruraflex

Ruraflex will in future be sufficiently size-differentiated by the network charge (2.3 above) to allow Ruraflex 1 and 2 to be merged into a single tariff, to be called Ruraflex.

2.5 Nightsave: off-peak period during December

The period from 22:00 on 15 December until 06:00 on 2 January is currently regarded as a totally off-peak period for the Nightsave tariffs.

As this off-peak period does not exist in WEPS, with which all tariffs are aligned, the two-week off-peak period has to be discontinued with effect from 15 December 2002.

2.6 Monthly rentals

Existing gross monthly rentals (MRs) for Ruraflex and Nightsave (Rural) will be reduced by R900.00 per month, but not beyond extinction. This will result in the majority of rural customers no longer having an MR. At the same time, the sharing of existing network costs on an individual customer basis, when new customers are connected to the network will be discontinued.

The MRs for urban customers as well as fixed capital charges (FCCs) for all customers will remain unchanged.

2.7 Minimum accounts

A minimum account will be introduced for the urban tariffs (Nightsave (Urban), Megaflex and Miniflex), as follows:

1. Megaflex and Nightsave (Urban)

The minimum bill will be equal to the greater of the following two quantities:

- All fixed charges plus 15% of NMD x demand rate* plus energy cost at regular rates
- The regular bill

* The low-season demand charge of the applicable tariff will be applicable for all 12 months. The greater of the NMD or the actual measured demand during the previous 12 months will be used for this calculation.

2. Miniflex

The minimum bill will be equal to the greater of the following two quantities:

- All fixed charges plus 15% of NMD x demand rate* plus energy cost at Megaflex energy rates
- The regular bill

* The low season demand charge for Megaflex will be applicable for all 12 months. The greater of the NMD or the actual measured demand during the previous 12 months will be used for this calculation.

2.8 Maximum unit charge

With the introduction of minimum bills (2.7 above) the maximum unit charge (currently applicable to Megaflex and Nightsave) will be discontinued.

2.9 Basic charge, service charge, administration charge

The existing basic charge for all LPU tariffs will be unbundled into a service charge and an administration charge. Both these charges will be based on the greater of the customer's NMD or measured maximum demand during the previous 12 months. The administration charge will be applicable at point of delivery (POD) level, while the service charge will be levied at account level.

2.10 Rates for 2002

The rates reflected in Tables 2 and 3, in 2001 rand value, as well as all the structural changes above will be applicable as from 1 January 2002. It should be noted that these rates cannot be directly compared with the existing 2001 rates, due to:

- the extensive tariff redesign that was required to align tariffs with WEPS; and
- the fact that the 2002 rates are stated at the >132 kV level, as opposed to the 2001 rates that are stated at the <500 V level.

3. SMALL POWER USERS

The following structural changes will be introduced with effect from 1 January 2002.

3.1 WEPS alignment

Like the LPU tariffs, the SPU tariffs will be aligned with WEPS.

3.2 Basic charges

The basic charges of Homepower, Landrate and Businessrate will be unbundled into a service charge (still to be called a basic charge) and a network charge. The network charge will be differentiated on the basis of the existing capacity categories of these tariffs, and will cover network and capacity-related costs.

3.3 Monthly rentals

The monthly rentals for Homepower, Landrate and Businessrate will be rebated by R900.00, but not beyond extinction and the costs will be included in the network charge. Only in exceptional cases where customers have very high monthly rentals, will monthly rentals still exist after the application of the rebate. The process of sharing costs when new customers are connected will be discontinued.

3.4 Landrate 1, 2 and 3

The high-rate energy block of Landrate will be removed in totality, with a commensurate increase in the network charge. This will conclude the phasing out of the high-rate energy block that was commenced in 1997.

3.5 Rates for 2002

The rates reflected in Tables 4 and 5 as well as all the structural changes above will be applicable as from 1 January 2002. It should be noted that, due to the extensive tariff redesign that was required to align tariffs with WEPS, the 2002 rates cannot be compared directly with the existing 2001 rates. The respective customers will be required to model the impact based on their consumption patterns.

3.5.1 Homepower and Homelight (rates are in 2001 rand value, exclusive of VAT)

Please note that from 1 January 2002 the Homelight 2.5A tariff will be an official standard tariff and not a piloted tariff.

1. AGTERGROND

- 1.1 Gedurende 1999 het Eskom 'n prysstrategie ontwikkel wat daarop gemik is om klante en die Nasionale Elektrisiteitsreguleerder (NER) sover moontlik vooraf in kennis te stel van toekomstige tariefontwikkelinge.
- 1.2 Ter wille van ekonomiese doeltreffendheid ondersteun die NER die beginsel van kosteweerspieëlende tariewe, soos voorgelê in die Energie Witskrif van 1998. Die NER het aangedui dat Eskom derhalwe mag voortgaan om tariewe te herbalanseer met die oog daarop om koste beter te weerspieël. Tariewe wat tans gesubsidieer word, sal geleidelik verhoog moet word om hierdie subsidies uit te faseer, maar dit sal gedoen moet word met inagneming van bekostigbaarheid. Die regering moet beleid bepaal ten opsigte van die subsidieëring van armes.
- 1.3 Die belangrikste motivering vir die herontwerp van tariewe vir 2002 is om dit in ooreenstemming te bring met die "Wholesale Electricity Pricing System (WEPS)", waarvan die beginsels reeds deur die NER goedgekeur is.
- 1.4 Alle pryse wat in hierdie kennisgewing aangehaal word, is in 2001 randwaarde, BTW uitgesluit en onderhewig aan Eskom se algemene prysverhoging vir 2002. 2. GROOT KRAGGEBRUIKERS

Die volgende struktuurveranderinge word met ingang van 1 Januarie 2002 van krag:

2.1 Tariewe in ooreenstemming met WEPS

Al die tariewe vir groot kraggebruikers moet in ooreenstemming wees met WEPS. Die gevolg hiervan is dat verskillende seisoenale Nightsave-tariewe ingestel gaan word, terwyl die Spits-, Standaard- en Buitespitspryse van die Tyd-van-Gebruiktariewe gewysig sal word in ooreenstemming met WEPS.

2.2 Spanningskorting / spanningstoelag

Die spanningskorting sal met 2 persentasiepunte verhoog word vir ekstra-hoëspanningsklante (>132 kV), met ooreenstemmende kleiner verhogings vir die laerspanningsklante. Tegelykertyd word die spanningskorting omskep in 'n spanningstoelag.

Eskom se tariewe soos tans gepubliseer is volgens dié vir laespanningsklante (<500 V), en hoëspanningsklante ontvang 'n spanningskorting om die laer koste van toevoer by hoë spanning te weerspieël. Die 2002-pryse wat in hierdie kennisgewing gepubliseer word, is vir klante wat by hoë spanning voorsien word (>132 kV), en laespanningsklante sal onderhewig wees aan 'n spanningstoetslag om die hoër koste van toevoer by lae spanning te weerspieël.

2.3 Netwerkheffing

'n Netwerkheffing gebaseer op die grootste van die klant se aangemelde maksimum aanvraag (AMA) of werklik gemete aanvraag oor die vorige 12 maande sal ingestel word vir Nightsave (Rural) en Ruraflex. Die netwerkheffing sal in R/kVA bepaal word. Waar klante in kW gemeet word, sal daar vir die doeleindes van hierdie berekening aangeneem word dat die arbeidsfaktor 1 is.

2.4 Ruraflex

Weens die instelling van die netwerkheffing sal Ruraflex voortaan voldoende gedifferensieer word volgens toevoervermoë, sodat Ruraflex 1 en 2 kan saamsmelt in 'n enkele tarief wat as Ruraflex bekend sal staan.

2.5 Nightsave: Buitespitstydperk gedurende Desember

Die tydperk van 22:00 op 15 Desember tot 06:00 op 2 Januarie word tans beskou as 'n volkome buitespitstyd vir die Nightsave-tariewe.

Aangesien hierdie tydperk nie bestaan in WEPS, waarmee al die tariewe in ooreenstemming moet wees nie, verval hierdie tydperk van twee-weke met ingang van 15 Desember 2002.

2.6 Maandelikse huurgeld

Die huidige bruto maandelikse huurgeld vir Nightsave- (Rural) en Ruraflex-klante sal verminder word met R900.00 per maand, maar nie verby uitwissing nie. Dit sal tot gevolg hê dat die meerderheid landelike klante nie meer 'n maandelikse huurgeld sal betaal nie. Tegelykertyd verval die huidige praktyk om die koste van bestaande netwerke onder klante te verdeel wanneer 'n nuwe klant by die netwerk aansluit.

Die maandelikse huurgeld en vaste kapitaalkoste van alle stedelike klante bly onveranderd.

2.7 Minimum rekeninge

'n Minimum rekening soos volg word ingestel vir die stedelike tariewe Nightsave (Stedelik), Megaflex en Miniflex:

1. Megaflex en Nightsave (stedelik)

Die minimum rekening sal gelyk wees aan die grootste van die volgende:

- Alle vaste koste plus 15% van die AMA x aanvraagheffing* plus energieverbruik teen die normale tarief.
- Die normale rekening.

* Die aanvraagheffing van die lae-aanvraagseisoen van die betrokke tarief sal vir al 12 maande gebruik word. Die grootste van die AMA of die gemete maksimum aanvraag gedurende die vorige 12 maande word gebruik.

2. Miniflex

Die minimum rekening sal gelyk wees aan die grootste van die volgende:

- Alle vaste koste plus 15% van die AMA x aanvraagheffing* plus energieverbruik teen die Megaflex-energietarief.
- Die normale rekening.

* Die aanvraagheffing van die lae-aanvraagseisoen van die Megaflex-tarief sal vir al 12 maande gebruik word. Die grootste van die AMA of die gemete maksimum aanvraag gedurende die vorige 12 maande word gebruik.

2.8 Maksimum eenheidskoste

Met die instelling van minimum rekeninge (2.7 hierbo) word die maksimum eenheidskoste (tans van toepassing op Megaflex en Nightsave) onttrek.

2.9 Basiese heffing, diensheffing, administrasieheffing

Die huidige basiese heffing in die tariewe vir alle groot kraggebruikers word ontbondel in 'n diensheffing en administrasieheffing. Beide hierdie heffings word gebaseer op die grootste van die klant se AMA of gemete maksimum aanvraag gedurende die vorige 12 maande. Die administrasieheffing word bepaal volgens die leweringspunt (Point of Delivery, POD), terwyl die diensheffing op rekeningvlak bepaal word.

2.10 Tariewe vir 2002

Die tariewe in tabelle 2 en 3 (in 2001 randwaarde) sowel as al die struktuurveranderinge hierbo vermeld is van toepassing vanaf 1 Januarie 2002. Neem kennis daarvan dat hierdie tariewe nie direk vergelyk kan word met die huidige 2001-tariewe nie, en wel om die volgende redes:

- Die omvattende herontwerp van tariewe om dit in ooreenstemming te bring met WEPS en

3.1 WEPS-ooreenstemming

Tariewe vir klein kraggebruikers sal net soos die tariewe vir groot kraggebruikers in ooreenstemming gebring word met WEPS.

3.2 Basiese heffings

Die basiese heffings vir Homepower, Landrate en Businessrate sal ontbondel word in 'n diensheffing (wat steeds 'n basiese heffing genoem sal word) en 'n netwerkheffing. 3.5 Tariewe vir 2002

Let asseblief daarop dat die tariewe vir 2002 nie regstreeks met die bestaande tariewe vir 2001 vergelyk kan word nie as gevolg van die omvattende tariefherontwerp wat nodig was om die tariewe met WEPS in ooreenstemming te bring.
