In terms of the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2000 (Act No. 43 of 2000) I, Stella N. Sigcau, the Minister of Public Works, hereby call for nominations from members of the public for appointment to the Council for the Built Environment (CBE).

Background

The objective of the CBE is to provide strategic leadership in a sustainable built environment and natural environment. In order to achieve this objective the CBE is tasked to serve as a forum for the various professions to promote integrated development within the built environment. The professions involved in the built environment are the engineering, architectural, project and project construction management, quantity surveying, property valuation and landscape architectural professions. These professions will use the CBE as a forum to discuss required qualifications, standards of education, training and competence, promotion of professional status and legislation impacting on the built environment. The CBE will, amongst others, promote standards of health, safety and environmental protection, sound governance, liaison in the field of training and the standards of such training, as well as ongoing

human resource development within the built environment. It will also be responsible to promote and protect the interests of the public.

Meetings

It is envisaged that the CBE will meet at least 4 times per year and the first meeting will take place within the first quarter of 2002. The Council members will be supported by a Chief Executive and staff. The period of office for the members is 4 years.

Nominations

Nominations are invited from members of the general public for the four vacancies which exist in the CBE. Nominees must be competent persons with leadership qualities and the ability to contribute to the strategic direction of the CBE, in the interests of the development and maintenance of a sustainable built environment and the promotion and protection of the public in the built environment.

Each nomination must be in writing and must contain the following information:

The name and address of the nominating person;

The name, address and identity number of the nominee;

A declaration by the nominee that he or she is qualified to serve on the CBE in terms of section 8 of the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2000*;

Motivation for the appointment of the nominee to the CBE (not exceeding one page)

A short curriculum vitae of the nominee (not exceeding two pages)

The requirements and guidelines for nominations should be studied carefully before any nomination is made. Nominations should reach Me L Mabuntana at the National Department of Public Works, Pretoria, Private Bag X65, Pretoria, 0001 not later than 29 October 2001. Only original documentation will be considered by the Minister. No facsimiles or late nominations will be accepted.

*I,(name), ID number, declare hereby that I am prepared to serve on the CBE and/or any of its committees and that I am not disqualified in terms of section 8 of the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2000 (Act No.43 of 2000) to serve on the CBE, and I hereby authorise the Minister of Public Works to investigate any record in relation to such disqualification or requirement.
