PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL BOARD

PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL ACT, 1983

IMPOSITION OF LEVIES ON PERISHABLE PRODUCTS

In terms of section 17(i) of the Perishable Products Export Control Act, 1983 (Act No.9 of 1983), the Board hereby imposes the following levies, in respect of each of the under mentioned perishable products, as defined in section 1 (i) of the above mentioned Act, which may be exported from the Republic of South Africa. These levies will be valid from 1 January 2002 until further notice.

Citrus (conventional)	R 5,75	per pallet

In terms of section 17(i) of the Perishable Products Export Control Act, 1983 (Act No. 9 of 1983), and by virtue of the Board's appointment as Assignee in terms of Regulation 1978 of the Agricultural Products Standards Act, 1990 (Act No. 119 of 1990), the Board hereby imposes the following levies and tariffs in respect of each of the products specified in the tables, which may be exported from the Republic of South Africa. These levies will be valid from 1 January 2002 until further notice.

In all Instances where a service is delivered, the PPECB will retain the right to, at it's discretion, charge the hourly rates above and or the kilometre rate, instead of the published fees above. For administrative purposes these hourly and kilometre rates may be adapted to an equivalent tariff per unit.

Where hourly rates are charged, a minimum fee for a one hour call out will be charged. Thereafter time will be charged In half hour segments ie R95 per half hour or part thereof. The same principle will be applied to overtime and Sunday

time.

Pesticide residue analysis


