The Bill intends to amend the Probation Services Act, 1991 (Act No. 116 of 1991, in order to be in line with new developments in the field of probation services and child justice and in this regard envisages to—

- (a) amend the definitions of "probation officer" and "authorized probation officer", so as to extend the meaning thereof to include an "assistant probation officer" and an "authorized assistant probation officer" who will assist probation officers in the performance of their duties;
- (b) insert the definition of "family finder" whose main function would be to trace the parents or guardian of a child who is being prosecuted, so as to make them available to assist the child in court;
- (c) introduce assessment, support, referral and mediation services in respect of victims of crime;
- (d) provide for the competency of a probation officer to recommend an appropriate sentence or other options to the court and for the mandatory assessment of every arrested child within 48 hours of his or her arrest; and
- (e) provide for the establishment of a probation advisory committee to advise the Minister on matters with regard to probation services.

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) gave public notice of the initiation of a review of the anti-dumping duty on towels and face cloths, originating in and/or exported from the People's Republic of China (PRC), through Notice No.2703, in Government Gazette No. 20711 dated 17 December 1999.

On 13 September 2000 the Board decided that the manufacturers of towels and face cloths in the South African Customs Union (SACU) submitted prima facie information to indicate that the expiry of the duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury.

On 16 May 2001 the Board made a preliminary decision to recommend that the existing anti-dumping duty be maintained.

On 7 June 2001 the Board informed interested parties of its intended recommendation. In terms of Article 6.9 of the Anti-Dumping Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, parties were informed of the "essential facts" as set out in the letter of notification, that would be considered by the Board in making its final determination.

On the basis of this information and other submissions made by interested parties, the Board, on 12 September 2001, made a final determination that the expiry of the anti-dumping duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury.

The Board therefore recommended to the Minister of Trade and Industry that the existing anti-dumping duty of 40% with a maximum of 3000 cents per kilogram on towels and face cloths originating in, or imported from the PRC, should be maintained. This recommendation was accepted by the Minister of Trade and Industry.

HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA

**RULES RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF THE BUSINESS AND THE PROCEDURE AT
MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL**

The Health Professions Council of South Africa intends, in terms of section 61A (1)(a) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), to make the rules set out in the Schedule.

Interested persons are invited to submit any substantiated comments or representations on the proposed rules to the Registrar, P O Box 205, Pretoria 0001 (for the attention of the Secretary: Health Professions Council of South Africa), within one month of the date of publication of this notice.

SCHEDULE

In addition to the provisions concerning the conduct of the business of the Council as prescribed in Sections 7 (President and Vice President), 8 (Meetings of Council), 9 (Quorum and procedure at meetings) and 10 (Committees) of the Health Professions Act, the following rules shall apply:

Meetings

- (1) Notices convening ordinary and special meetings of the Council shall be signed by the Registrar and shall specify the business to be transacted at the meeting. They shall be sent by post or by hand to each member and issued, in the case of ordinary meetings, at least ten (10) days before the date for which the meeting is convened. In the case of special meetings, a period of notice, deemed sufficient by the President, will be given and, if necessary, may be given by telegram, facsimile, e-mail or telephone. If all members agree, specific meetings can be convened at shorter notice or without notice.
- (2) The agenda for every meeting of the Council shall be compiled by the Registrar in consultation with the President or Chairperson and shall, *inter alia*, include the following:
 - (a) Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting;
 - (b) matters arising from the minutes of the previous meeting;
 - (c) matters arising from the minutes of standing committees;
 - (d) financial matters;
 - (e) policy matters;
 - (f) matters referred to the Council by Professional Boards;
 - (g) motions;
 - (h) general.
- (3) No business shall be transacted at a meeting other than that specified in the notice relating thereto, except matters which the Council shall resolve to deal with as urgent.

- (4) The Council may adjourn a meeting to any day or hour, but no business, other than that set out in the notice convening the adjourned meeting shall be transacted at the resumption of the meeting except matters which are brought forward in accordance with the preceding rule.
- (5) The Registrar shall keep an attendance register of all members attending a meeting.
- (6) Any member desirous of bringing any matter before the Council shall forward in writing to the Registrar, at least 30 days before the date for which a meeting is to be convened, a written notice of his or her motion, and the notice of his or her motion. This notice and motion shall appear in the agenda convening the meeting and shall be considered with the other business to be brought before the Council in the order indicated.
- (7) No matter shall be considered unless due notice has been given in accordance with the preceding rule, unless permission is obtained from the meeting to bring it forward as a motion. Should the motion find no seconder, it shall not be considered further.
- (8) The quorum of any committee established under section 10 of the Act shall consist of the majority of the members of the relevant committee. The President and Vice President shall *ex officio* be members of the Executive Committee of Council and the President or in the absence of the President, the Vice President shall be the Chairperson of that Committee.
- (9) The Registrar shall, when the Council is not sitting, refer, as far as possible, all matters within the terms of reference of a committee to such committee and the committee shall then consider, deal with and finalise all routine matters and such other matters of which the principles have already been laid down by regulations or resolutions of the Council.
- (10) The rules of procedure laid down herein for the conduct of ordinary and special meetings of the Council shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to meetings of committees.

Minutes

- (11) The proceedings of meetings of the Council shall be preserved in the form of typewritten minutes, authenticated after confirmation at the next meeting by the signature of the President.
- (12)
 - (a) The minutes of each meeting of the Council shall contain a resumé of the subject matters dealt with and such motions and amendments proposed and adopted or rejected, as well as the name of the proposer and seconder in each instance, but without any comment or observation of the members.
 - (b) The minutes of all meetings of committees of the Council established under section 10 of the Act shall contain a resumé of the subject matter dealt with and resolutions adopted, but without any comment or observation of the members.
- (13) The Registrar shall forward a copy of the minutes of each meeting of the Council and of any committee to all members of the Council as soon as reasonably possible after the meeting has been held.
- (14) The minutes may be taken as read, unless any member moves that a particular section of the minutes should be read with a view to such correction therein or addition thereto as may be found necessary.

Order of business and debate

- (15) At the opening of each separate session of the Council, opportunity shall be given to members to put questions with regard to the work of the Council, which questions shall be answered forthwith, if possible, or if not, at a later session by the President or by such office-bearer or official as the President may direct. No discussion thereon shall be permitted.
- (16) Any member of the Council shall be entitled to move, at a particular meeting, that any item for that meeting of the Council be advanced in the agenda.
- (17) All motions and amendments shall, unless otherwise permitted by the President be committed to writing and signed by the mover, and before they are spoken to by other members, shall be read by the President or by the Registrar under the authority of the President, and then seconded. All formal amendments shall be so framed that they may be read as independent motions. An amendment shall be relevant to the motion it is intended to amend and shall not alter the original motion so as to virtually make it a new motion. It shall be so framed -
- (a) to add or insert certain words; or
 - (b) to omit certain words; or
 - (c) to omit certain words and add or insert others.
- (18) No motion or amendment shall be withdrawn after having been read by the President or by the authority of the President unless by permission of the Council.
- (19) The seconder of a motion or of an amendment may reserve his speech until any period of the debate.
- (20) If an amendment is proposed, it may be followed by other amendments and the last amendment shall be considered first.
- (21) Should every amendment be rejected, the original motion shall then be put to the vote.
- (22) If an amendment is carried, it shall then be regarded as a substantive motion and, as for further amendments, in all other respects be treated as an original motion.
- (23) When a motion is under debate, no further proposal shall be received except one of the following:
- (a) an amendment, namely, "that the motion be amended as follows: ...";
 - (b) the postponement of consideration of the motion, namely, "that the meeting proceed to the next business";
 - (c) the closure, namely, "that the motion now be put";
 - (d) the adjournment of the debate, namely, "that the debate on the motion be adjourned to the next ordinary meeting of Council"; or
 - (e) the adjournment of the Council, namely, "that the Council do now adjourn".

- (24) When an amendment is under debate, no further proposal shall be received except one of the following:
- (a) an amendment, namely, "that the motion be amended as follows: ...";
 - (b) the postponement of consideration of the amendment to the motion namely "that the meeting proceed to the next business";
 - (c) the closure, namely, "that the amendment be now put";
 - (d) the adjournment of the debate, namely, "that the debate on the amendment to the motion be adjourned to the next meeting of Council"; or
 - (e) the adjournment of the Council, namely, "that the Council do now adjourn".
- (25) The proposal for the postponement of consideration of a motion or an amendment thereto (which may specify a date or time for the further consideration of the matter) shall be made and seconded without debate, and may be moved at any time, even during the debate on an amendment. If the proposal is carried, the matter shall be dropped from the programme of business until the date or time specified in the proposal for postponement. If it is lost, the debate shall proceed.
- (26) The proposal for the closure shall be made and seconded without debate and shall be put forthwith. Should the proposal be carried, the motion or amendment under debate shall at once be voted on by the Council.
- (27) If the proposal for the adjournment of the debate is carried, the Council shall pass to the next item on the programme of business and the debate shall be resumed at the next ordinary meeting of the Council. The proposer of the adjournment shall, on the resumption of the debate, be entitled to speak first.
- (28) If the proposal for the adjournment of the Council is proposed and seconded, it shall be competent for the President, before putting the question, to take the opinion of the Council as to whether it shall, before rising, proceed to the transaction of unopposed business.
- (29) A motion to rescind a resolution which has been passed at a previous meeting shall be considered only if notice thereof has been given in terms of rule (6). It shall be passed if a majority of the votes recorded is in favour of the motion. A motion to rescind a resolution which has been passed during a session of the Council may be considered at the same session of the Council, provided that written notice thereof is given that the matter be considered on a subsequent day or specified time of that session. It shall be passed only if two thirds of the votes recorded are in favour of the motion.
- (30) The President or, in the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall preside at all ordinary and special meetings of Council and shall be responsible for the proper conduct of the meeting and if, during a meeting, a procedural problem arises which is not provided for in these rules, the President or, in the absence of the President, the Vice President shall determine the procedure to be followed, provided that the Registrar shall embody in the minute's any ruling of the President or Vice President as to the interpretation of these rules, if so requested by a member at the time of the ruling.
- (31) Notice may be given of a motion to review any ruling of the President or Vice-President as to the interpretation of these rules, if so requested by a member at the time of the ruling, and when given shall constitute an instruction to the Executive Committee to consider and report to the Council on such ruling and shall then be placed on the agenda.

- (32) The ruling of the chairperson of any committee on a point of order may, at the request of any two members of the committee present at the meeting at which such ruling was given, be reviewed by the Executive Committee, which may direct that such ruling be cancelled or amended and the decision of the Executive Committee shall be acted on by the chairperson of the committee whose ruling is called in question, unless and until reversed by the Council. If any ruling of the Chairperson of the Executive Committee is called in question, the Chairperson shall vacate the chair while the matter is under discussion or reviewed during the meeting of the committee at which it has been given.
- (33) If any member dissents from the opinion of the majority and wishes to have his dissent recorded, he or she shall state so forthwith. Such dissent shall then be entered in the minutes.

HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA

RULES RELATING TO CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY

The Health Professions Council of South Africa, in terms of section 26 of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), made the rules set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS

1. In these rules "the Act" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), and, unless inconsistent with the context -

"board" means the Medical and Dental Professional Board established by Government Notice R.75 of 16 January 1998;

"continuing professional development" means the continuing education and training referred to in section 26 of the Act and prescribed in terms of these rules;

"practitioner" means a medical practitioner or a dentist registered in terms of the Act;

"clinical practice" means the management of individuals or groups and may include, but is not confined to taking a history, performing an examination, ordering or performing tests or special investigations, making a diagnosis and administering or prescribing medical or dental treatment;

"speciality" means one of the disciplines of medicine or dentistry prescribed in regulation 2 of the Regulations Relating to the Specialities and Subspecialities in Medicine and Dentistry as published in Government Notice No. R. 590 of 29 June 2001;

“subspeciality” means one of the subdivisions of a speciality recognised in regulation 3 of the said Regulations Relating to the Specialities and Subspecialities in Medicine and Dentistry.

REQUIREMENTS

2. Any practitioner whose name on 1 January 1999 appeared on the register of medical practitioners or the register of dentists kept in terms of section 18 of the Act, shall be required to comply with the conditions of continuing professional development laid down in these rules as a prerequisite for such practitioner to retain his or her registration in terms of the Act.

3. Any person who, after 1 January 1999, registers for the first time in terms of the Act as a practitioner in any category of independent practice or public service, shall be required to comply with the conditions of continuing professional development laid down in these rules, which shall be a prerequisite for such practitioner to retain his or her registration in terms of the Act: Provided that any person who is registered for the first time after 1 January of any year, shall be required to comply on a *pro rata* basis with these requirements during the first year of his or her registration.

4. A practitioner whose name had been removed from the register of medical practitioners or the register of dentists, shall be subject to compliance with any condition or conditions which the board may specify prior to the restoration of the name of such practitioner to the relevant register.

5. For the purpose of continuing professional development, every practitioner shall be required to accumulate at least 50 points within any one year, provided that points accumulated during a specific year in excess of 50 points may be forwarded to the subsequent year only: Provided further that, if the practitioner does not accumulate the prescribed minimum in any one year, he or she shall be permitted to obtain as many points as he or she may require in the subsequent year.

6. The 50 points prescribed in rule 5 shall be accumulated by way of different educational or developmental activities accredited by the board in any of the following categories of activities:

- (1) Organisational activities.
- (2) Small group activities.
- (3) Individual activities.

(4) Any other activities or category of activities which the board may accredit from time to time.

7. In complying with these requirements, no more than 80 percent of the points may be obtained in any one category.

8. Practitioners may obtain their points within their own discipline, speciality or subspeciality or within another relevant discipline, speciality or subspeciality.

9. (1) In complying with these requirements, at least 2 points shall have to be obtained by every practitioner in professional ethics annually.

(2) During any one year, a maximum of 5 points may be obtained in health related activities in business practice, administration or management.

10. Deferment of compliance with the requirements of continuing professional development may only be granted to individual practitioners by the board on application and submission of adequate reasons for such request and subject to such requirements as the board may determine.

11. Full-time students in Family Medicine, registrars and senior registrars shall be considered to have complied with the requirement in rule 5 for each year of –

- (a) such full-time study on submission of documentary proof thereof; or
- (b) registration with the board as a registrar or senior registrar; or
- (c) documentary proof of appointment in a recognised training post for specialisation in a country outside South Africa.

12. A practitioner registered for the calendar year 2002 and thereafter to perform community service in terms of the provisions of section 24A of the Act, shall be required to comply with the requirements relating to continuing professional development whilst being so registered.

13. In the event of a practitioner not complying with the conditions specified in these rules within the prescribed period of time, the board may impose any one or more of the following conditions, namely –

- (a) grant the practitioner deferment for one extra year;

- (b) require the practitioner to follow a remedial programme of continuing education and training as specified by the board;
- (c) require the practitioner to write an examination as determined by the board;
- (d) register the practitioner in a registration category which shall provide for supervision regarded as appropriate by the board;
- (e) register the practitioner in the prescribed registration category restricted to non-clinical practice;
- (f) remove the practitioner's name from the relevant register.

REPEAL

14. The Rules published as Board Notice 174 of 1998 and the draft rules published as Board Notice 80 of 2001 are hereby repealed.

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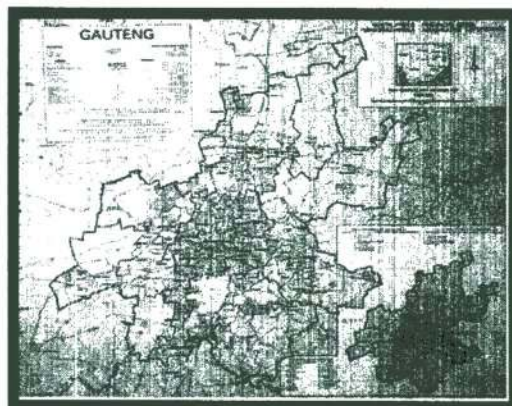
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
