#### SPRINGS PHARMACY

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The aim of the manual is to assist potential requestors as to the procedure to be followed when requesting access to information / documents from Springs Pharmacy as contemplated in terms of the Act.

The manual may be amended from time to time and as soon as any amendments have been finalised, the latest version of the manual will be made public.

Any requestor is advised to contact Mr. Eric Ho should he / she require any assistance in respect of the utilisation of this manual and / or the requesting of information/documents from Springs Pharmacy.

The following words will bear the following meaning in this manual:-

"the Act" shall mean the Promotion of Access to information Act, No. 2 of 2000, together with all relevant regulations published;

"the / this manual" shall mean this manual together will all annexures thereto as available at the premises of Spring Pharmacy from time to time:

"SP" shall mean Springs Pharmacy, structured as a partnership which renders pharmaceutical services individual patients;

"SAHRC" shall mean the South African Human Rights Commission.

"Information Officer" Eric Ho has been appointed as the Information Officer of Springs Pharmacy, to which requests for information in terms of the Act, should be addressed.

#### 6. **INFORMATION HELD:**

#### 6.1 <u>INFORMATION / DOCUMENTS AVAILABLE IN ACCORDANCE</u> WITH OTHER LEGISLATION:

SP keeps information / documents in accordance with the following legislation (please note that this is not an exhaustive list):-

The above records, in so far as it being of a public nature are available automatically without a person having to request access thereto in terms of the Act, as envisaged in Section 52.

## 6.2 DOCUMENTS / INFORMATION HELD BY SP IN TERMS OF THE ACT (SECTION 51(1)(E) OF THE ACT)

SP holds the information / documents listed herein below:

- Client data base (personal information of clients relating to prescriptions

- Human Resources (personal information of past, present and prospective employees and partners / directors)
- Insurance policies
- Rules and regulations relating to the pension fund

It is recorded that any and all documents / information requested pertaining to the aforesaid shall only be made available to a requestor subject to the provisions of the Act. None of the information held by SP is automatically available without a person having to request access in terms of and subject to the provisions of the Act.

A request for information should be in the prescribed form, addressed to the Information Officer and submitted against payment of the prescribed fee.

#### 6.3 OTHER INFORMATION (SECTION 51(1)(F) OF THE ACT)

The Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development has to date not published any regulations in terms of this Section.

#### 6.4 **AVAILABILITY OF THE MANUAL**

- 5.1 This manual is available for inspection at the premises of SP, free of charge;
- 5.2 Copies of the manual may be obtained, subject to the prescribed fees, at the premises of SP;
