3. Records available in terms of other legislation

3.1 Companies Act 61 of 1973

- 3.1.1 All documents of incorporation of Macsteel are lodged at the offices of the Registrar of Companies, and may be inspected at the Companies office. These documents include the memorandum and articles of association of Macsteel, as well as the relevant company forms.
- 3.1.2 The register of members and registers of transfers (of members), pledges and bonds of Macsteel are available for inspection at the registered office of Macsteel.
- 3.1.3 Special resolutions are lodged with the Registrar of Companies, and are therefore available for inspection at the Companies office.
- 3.1.4 A register of the directors' and officials' interests in contracts entered into by Macsteel is kept at the registered office of Macsteel, and is available for inspection.
- 3.2 Pension Funds Act 24 of 1956 The rules of the pension fund utilised by Macsteel, as well as the last revenue account and balance sheet of such

fund, are available for inspection at the offices of the Registrar of Pension Funds.

3.3 Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 – As a designated employer, Macsteel has lodged copies its employment equity reports at the Department of Labour.

(ii) The request procedures

Form of request:

- The requester must use the prescribed form to make the request for access to a record. This must be made to the head of Macsteel. This request must be made to the address, fax number or electronic mail address of the head of Macsteel.
- The requester must provide sufficient detail on the request form to enable the head of Macsteel to identify the record and the requester. The requester should also indicate which form of access is required. The requester should also indicate if he or she wishes to be informed in any other manner and state the necessary particulars to be so informed.
- The requester must identify the right that he or she is seeking to exercise or protect
 and provide an explanation as to why the requested record is required for the
 exercise or protection of that right.
- If a request is made on behalf of a person, the requester must submit proof of the capacity in which the requester is making the request to the satisfaction of the head of Macsteel.

Fees:

- The head of Macsteel must notify the requester (other than a personal requester) by notice, requiring the requester to pay the fee of R50 before further processing the request. A personal requester does not pay such fee.
- The requester may lodge an internal appeal or an application to the court against the tender or payment of the request fee.

- The head of Macsteel will then make a decision on the request and notify the requester in the required form.
- If the request is granted then a further access fee must be paid for the search, reproduction, preparation and for any time that had exceeded the prescribed hours to search and prepare the record for disclosure.
