#### STANDARDS ACT, 1993 STANDARDS MATTERS

In terms of the Standards Act, 1993 (Act 29 of 1993), the Council of the South African Bureau of Standards has acted in regard to standards in the manner set out in the Schedules to this notice.

All South African standards that were previously published by the South African Bureau of Standards with the prefix "SABS" have been redesignated as South African National Standards and are now published by Standards South Africa (a division of SABS) with the prefix "SANS".

A list of all existing South African National standards was published by Government Notice No. 1373 of 8 November 2002.

In the list of SANS standards below, the equivalent SABS numbers, where applicable, are given below the new SANS numbers for the sake of convenience. Standards that were published with the "SABS" prefix are listed as such.

SANS 1867:2003	Sprayed plastics foams for use in mines. Gives the safety requirements for single-component and multi-component foams applied in mines for ventilation control, for the insulation of refrigeration installations or for use as tamping.
SANS 1914-1:2002	Targeted construction procurement - Part 1: Participation of targeted enterprises. Specifies the general requirements for engaging targeted enterprises on a contract for the provision of supplies, services or works; specifies the contract participation goal; sets out the methods by which the contract participation goal will be measured, quantified and verified in the performance of the contract; and describes the means by which progress towards the achievement of the contract participation goal will be monitored; compliance with requirements will be verified and monitored; and the contract participation goal will be adjusted to accommodate variations to the scope of the contract.
SANS 1914-2:2002	Targeted construction procurement - Part 2: Participation of targeted partners in joint ventures. Specifies the general requirements for engaging targeted partners in joint ventures on a contract for the provision of supplies, services or works; specifies the contract participation goal; sets out the methods by which the contract participation goal will be measured, quantified and verified in the performance of the contract; and describes the means by which progress towards the achievement of the contract participation goal will be monitored; compliance with requirements will be verified and monitored; and the contract participation goal will be adjusted to accommodate variations to the scope of the contract.
SANS 1914-3:2002	Targeted construction procurement – Part 3: Participation of targeted enterprises and targeted partners in joint ventures. Specifies the general requirements for engaging targeted joint venture partners and targeted enterprises on a contract for the provision of supplies, services or works; specifies the contract participation goal; sets out the methods by which the contract participation goal will be measured, quantified and verified in the performance of the contract; and describes the means by which progress towards the achievement of the contract participation goal will be monitored; compliance with requirements will be verified and monitored; and the contract participation goal will be adjusted to accommodate variations to the scope of the contract.
SANS 3074:2003/ ISO 3074:1975	Wool – Determination of dichloromethane-soluble matter in combed sliver. Specifies a method for determining the dichloromethane-soluble matter in combed wool sliver. Its use may be extended to wool in other forms.
SANS 4301-1:2002/ ISO 4301-1:1986	Cranes and lifting appliances — Classification — Part 1: General. Establishes a general classification of cranes based on the number of operating cycles to be carried out during the expected life of the crane and a load spectrum factor which represents a nominal state of loading.
SANS 4301-2:2002/ ISO 4301-2:1985	Lifting appliances - Classification - Part 2: Mobile cranes. Establishes a classification of mobile cranes and related crane mechanisms based on the number of operating cycles to be carried out during the expected life of the mobile crane or mechanism and on a load spectrum factor which represents a nominal state of loading.

Specifies a method of verification and calibration of testing machines used for determining Brinell hardness in accordance with ISO 6506-1. Specifies a direct method for checking the main functions of machine operation and an indirect method suitable for checking the overall machine operation. The indirect method may be used independently for periodic routine checking of machine operation while in service.
SANS 6506-3:2003/ ISO 6506-3:1999	Metallic materials - Brinell hardness test - Part 3: Calibration of reference blocks. Specifies a method for the calibration of reference blocks which are intended for use in the indirect verification of Brinell hardness testing machines as described in ISO 6506-2.
SANS 7363:2002/ ISO 7363:1986	Cranes and lifting appliances – Technical characteristics and acceptance documents. Establishes the form of presentation and content of the documents which a manufacturer should provide with cranes and lifting appliances.
SANS 7752-5:2002/ ISO 7752-5:1985	Lifting appliances — Controls — Layout and characteristics — Part 5: Overhead travelling cranes and portal bridge cranes. # NOTICE 864 OF 2003 BOARD ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

# NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON UNCOATED WOODFREE PAPER ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM INDONESIA AND SWEDEN

In accordance with the provisions in Article 11.3, read together with Article 18.3.2 of the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, any definitive anti-dumping duty shall be terminated on a date not later than five years from its imposition, unless the authorities determine, in a review initiated before that date on their own initiative or upon a duly substantiated request made by or on behalf of the domestic industry within a reasonable period of time prior to that date, that the expiry of the duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury.

On 31 May, 2002, the Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) notified all interested parties, through Notice No. 789 of *Government Gazette* No. 23450, that unless a request is made by or on behalf of the domestic industry for the duties to be reviewed prior to the expiry thereof, the anti-dumping duties on uncoated woodfree paper originating in or imported from Indonesia and Sweden will expire on 13 February 2003.

A request to the Board to consider the initiation of a review was received from Mondi Paper, a division of Mondi Limited, supported by Sappi Fine Paper (Pty) Ltd, the only other manufacturer of the subject product in the SACU.

The Board considered the information submitted, and determined that there was no prima facie evidence to justify the initiation of a review on the subject product originating in or imported from Indonesia and Sweden.

In accordance with its policy, the Board decided to recommend that the anti-dumping duties on uncoated woodfree paper originating in or imported from Indonesia and Sweden be withdrawn on the date of the five year expiry. The recommendation was approved by the Minister of Trade and Industry.

NOTICE OF INITIATION OF A REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON CERTAIN PRINTED AND DYED BED LINEN ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM MALAWI AND MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY CROWN FASHIONS LIMITED

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) received a request from Crown Fashions Limited (Crown Fashions), a manufacturer and exporter of bed linen in Malawi that the anti-dumping duties on certain printed and dyed bed linen, originating in or imported from Malawi, be reviewed.

#### THE PETITIONER

The petition was lodged by Crown Fashions (the Petitioner), a manufacturer and exporter of bed linen in Malawi. The Petitioner submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Board to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that a review investigation should be initiated on the basis that certain bed linen is no longer exported at dumped prices to the Southern African Customs Union (SACU).

#### THE PRODUCT

The subject product is described as printed and dyed duvet covers, fitted sheets, pillow cases and sets consisting of duvet covers, pillow cases, fitted sheets and night frills, of man made-fibres (excluding knitted and crocheted bed linen), classifiable under tariff sub-headings 6302.22 and 6302.32, and manufactured and exported by Crown Fashions in Malawi.

#### **DUMPING**

The allegation that the Petitioner is no longer exporting the subject product at dumped prices to the SACU is based on the comparison between the normal values in and the export price from Malawi. The normal value was determined based on constructed cost. The Petitioner did not sell the subject product on the domestic market in Malawi as it manufactured the product exclusively for export to SACU. The export prices were determined based on the actual export sales to SACU for the period August 2000 to February 2001. These were the last exports of the subject product by the Petitioner into the SACU.

#### PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The period of investigation for purposes of dumping in the exporting country will be from 01 April 2000 to 31 March 2001.

## PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Board has begun an investigation in terms of section 4 of the Board on Tariffs and Trade Act, 1986 (the BTT Act). The Board will conduct its investigation in accordance with the BTT Act and the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of GATT 1994 (the Anti-Dumping Agreement). A copy of the Anti-Dumping Agreement is available from the Board's office on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Board will send a non-confidential version of the petition to all known interested parties for comments. Interested parties are invited to contact the Board as soon as possible in order to determine if they have been listed and have been sent the relevant documents. 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
