NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 27 OF 1996) AND THE SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1996) AS AMENDED

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE PROPOSED SUBJECT WORKING GROUPS WITH THE AIM OF DEVELOPING SUBJECT STATEMENTS FOR AGRICULTURAL SUBJECTS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE NATIONAL CURRICULUM STATEMENT GRADES 10-12 (GENERAL)

- 1. I Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor Minister of Education, hereby, in terms of Section 3(4)(1) of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996) and Sections 6(A) and 61 of the South African Schools Act, 1996 (Act. No. 84 of 1996) as amended, approve the establishment of a Ministerial Project Committee and associated curriculum development structures with the aim of developing additional subjects to be included in the National Curriculum Statement Grades 10-12 (General) hereafter referred to as the "NCS".
- 2. In view of requests received from the Agricultural sector to develop additional agricultural subjects to be included in the NCS, I have decided to approve an extension to the current Ministerial Project Committee and associated curriculum development with the aim of developing two additional agricultural subjects, namely Agricultural Management Practices and Agricultural Technologies.
- 3. In response to nominations received for people to serve on the various curriculum development structures for the development of agricultural subjects to be listed in the NCS, I have appointed the following persons to serve on the two above-mentioned curriculum development structures:
