# STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL REVENUE, EXPENDITURE AND BORROWING AS AT 30 APRIL 2005 ISSUED BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL: NATIONAL TREASURY

The following statements of revenue, expenditure and borrowing are published in terms of Section 32 of the Public Finance Management Act.

National government revenue and expenditure are detailed in schedules 1 and 2, respectively. The tables below indicate revenue and expenditure for the reporting month, together with comparable figures for the previous year.

Revenue and expenditure for the reporting month are also expressed as percentages of the Budget for the current year and preliminary outcome for 2004/05.
