

DEPARTMENT OF-PUBLIC WORKS

NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION OF BILL INTO PARLIAMENT

The Minister of Public Works intends introducing the Government Immovable Asset Management Bill into Parliament in 2005. The objectives of the Bill are to:

The Bill intends to :-

- Provide a uniform immovable asset management framework to promote accountability and transparency within government;
- Ensure effective immovable asset management within the state;
- Ensure co-ordination of immovable assets with service delivery objectives of an organ of state and the efficient utilization of immovable assets;
- Optimise the cost of service delivery through allocation of state resources in relation to
 - the accountability for capital and recurrent works;
 - the acquisition, re-use and disposal of an immovable asset;
 - (iii) the maintenance of existing immovable assets;
 - (iv) protecting the environment and the cultural and historic heritage;

(v) improving health and safety in the working environment.
