GENERAL NOTICES**NOTICE 760 OF 2006****DEPARTMENT OF LABOUR****NOTICE PUBLISHED BY THE ESSENTIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE (the 'Committee')**

**IN TERMS OF SECTION 71, READ WITH SECTION 70(2)(a) OF THE LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, 1995
(Act No. 66 of 1995 as amended)**

- A. The Essential Service Committee Notice No. 21 of 2006 published in Government Gazette No. 28651 on 31 March 2006 is hereby withdrawn.**
- B. Notice is hereby given in terms of section 71, read with section 70(2)(a) of the Labour Relations Act, 1995 (Act No. 66 of 1995 as amended) that the committee is to conduct an investigation as to whether the whole or part of the:**
- (a) safety;
 - (b) security;
 - (c) electrical services
- provided at all airports in South Africa should be designated as Essential Services.**
- C. Any interested party making written representations to the Committee in terms of section 71(2)(a) must -**
1. serve its representations on the committee at the head office of the Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (the 'Commission') at 20 Anderson Street, Marshalltown, Johannesburg, 2001, Private Bag X94, Marshalltown, 2107, Telefax (011) 834 7386 on or before the **30th of June 2006**;
 2. state the nature of its interest in the investigation;

3. state whether it requires an opportunity to make oral representations, and if those oral representations are to contain material or raise issues not dealt with in the written representations, to provide a brief summary of those oral representations;
4. state whether it relies or intends to rely on any expert evidence and if so, provide a brief summary of that expert evidence; and
5. specify its address, telephone number (if any) and telefax number (if any).

D. Any interested party requiring an opportunity to make oral representations must -

1. so indicate by writing to the commission on or before the **30th June 2006**;
2. state the nature of its interest in the investigation;
3. state whether it relies or intends to rely on any expert evidence, and if so, provide a brief summary of that expert evidence; and
4. specify its address, telephone number (if any) and telefax number (if any).

E. Any interested person may inspect any written representations made in response to this notice at the head office of the commission.

F. A certified copy of, or extract from, any written representations will be provided by the commission on payment of a prescribed fee of R2,00 per page.
