# ACT

**To provide for the appropriation of money from the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State in the 2006/07 financial year; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.**

**PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS** section 213(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, provides that money may be withdrawn from the National Revenue Fund only in terms of an appropriation by an Act of Parliament;

**AND WHEREAS** section 26 of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), provides that Parliament must appropriate money for each financial year for the requirements of the State;

**B**E IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

**Definitions**

1. In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise—

“conditional grants” means conditional allocations to provinces, local government or municipalities from the national government’s share of revenue raised nationally, contemplated in section 214(1)(c) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996; 5

“current payments” means any payment made by a national department in respect of the operational requirements of that department, and includes payments for the compensation of employees and payments for goods and services, interest, rental of immovable property and financial transactions relating to assets and liabilities, but excludes transfers and subsidies, payments for capital assets and payments made under section 73 of the Public Finance Management Act; 10

“main division within a vote” has the meaning assigned to it in section 1 of the Public Finance Management Act; 15

“payments for capital assets” means any payment made by a national department—

(a) for assets that can be used continuously or repeatedly in production for more than one year, and from which future economic benefits or service potential is expected to flow directly to the national department making the payment; and 20  
(b) that must be classified as or deemed to be payments for capital assets in accordance with the “Reference Guide to the new Economic Reporting Format” (November 2003, Version 2) and the “Asset Management Framework” (April 2004, Version 3.3), issued by the National Treasury under section 76 of the Public Finance Management Act; 25

“Public Finance Management Act” means the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999);

“transfers and subsidies” means any payment made by a national department to another organ of state or any other person in respect of which the national department does not receive a benefit of similar value directly in return, and includes the payment of conditional grants. 30

# WET

**Tot bewilliging van geld uit die Nasionale Inkomstefonds vir die behoeftes van die Staat vir die finansiële jaar 2006/07; en om voorsiening te maak vir aangeleenthede wat daarmee in verband staan.**

## AANHEF

**AANGESIEN** artikel 213(2) van die Grondwet van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, 1996, bepaal dat geld uit die Nasionale Inkomstefonds onttrek kan word slegs ingevolge 'n bewilliging deur 'n Parlements-wet;

**EN AANGESIEN** artikel 26 van die Wet op Openbare Finansiële Bestuur, 1999 (Wet No. 1 van 1999), bepaal dat die Parlement vir elke finansiële jaar geld vir die behoeftes van die Staat moet bewillig,

**WORD DAAR DERHALWE BEPAAL** deur die Parlement van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

### Woordomskrywing

1. In hierdie Wet, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken—  
“**betalings vir kapitaalbates**” enige betaling wat deur 'n nasionale departement gemaak word—  
(a) vir bates wat vir meer as een jaar deurlopend of herhaaldelik vir produksie gebruik kan word, en waaruit toekomstige ekonomiese voordele of dienspotensiaal na verwagting regstreeks na die nasionale departement wat die betaling doen, sal vloe; en  
(b) wat geklassifiseer moet word as of geag word betalings te wees vir kapitaalbates ooreenkomsdig die “*Reference Guide to the new Economic Reporting Format*” (November 2003, Uitgawe 2) en die “*Asset Management Framework*” (April 2004, Uitgawe 3.3), wat deur die Nasionale Tesourie kragtens artikel 76 van die Wet op Openbare Finansiële Bestuur uitgereik is; 15  
“**hoofindeling binne 'n begrotingspos**” dieselfde as bedoel in artikel 1 van die Wet op Openbare Finansiële Bestuur;  
“**lopende betalings**” enige betaling gemaak deur 'n nasionale departement ten opsigte van bedryfsbehoeftes van daardie departement, en sluit onder andere in betalings vir die vergoeding van werknemers en betalings vir goedere en dienste, 20 rente, huur van onroerende eiendom en finansiële transaksies rakende bates en laste, maar sluit oordragte en subsidies, betalings vir kapitaalbates en betalings gemaak kragtens artikel 73 van die Wet op Openbare Finansiële Bestuur uit;  
“**oordragte en subsidies**” enige betaling wat 'n nasionale departement aan 'n ander staatsorgaan of enige ander persoon maak ten opsigte waarvan die nasionale departement nie 'n voordeel van soortgelyke waarde regstreeks in ruil ontvang nie, 25 en sluit die betaling van voorwaardelike toekennings in;  
“**voorwaardelike toekenning**” voorwaardelike toewysings aan provinsies, plaaslike regering of munisipaliteite uit die nasionale regering se deel van inkomste wat nasionaal ingevorder word, beoog in artikel 214(1)(c) van die Grondwet van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, 1996; 30

**Appropriation of money for requirements of State**

2. (1) Appropriations by Parliament of money from the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State in the 2006/07 financial year, to votes and main division within a vote, and for the specific listed purposes, are set out in the Schedule.

(2) The spending of appropriations contemplated in subsection (1) is subject to the Public Finance Management Act. 5

**Appropriation listed as specifically and exclusively**

3. Despite the provisions of any law, appropriations to a vote or main division within a vote that are listed as specifically and exclusively appropriated in the Schedule may only be utilised for the purpose indicated and may not be used for any other purpose, 10 unless an Act of Parliament amends or changes the purpose for which it was allocated.

**Short title and commencement**

4. This Act is called the Appropriation Act, 2006.

**Bewilliging van geld vir behoeftes van Staat**

**2.** (1) Bewilligings deur die Parlement van geld uit die Nasionale Inkomstefonds vir die behoeftes van die Staat gedurende die finansiële jaar 2006/07, vir begrotingsposte en hoofindelings binne 'n begrotingspos, en vir die spesifieke aangeduide doeleindeste, word in die Bylae uiteengesit. 5

(2) Die besteding van bewilligings beoog in subartikel (1) is behoudens die Wet op Openbare Finansiële Bestuur.

**Bewilligings as spesifiek en uitsluitlik aangedui** 10

**3.** Ondanks die bepalings van enige wet, mag bewilligings vir 'n begrotingspos of hoofindeling binne 'n begrotingspos wat as spesifiek en uitsluitlik bewillig in die Bylae aangedui word, slegs vir die aangeduide doel aangewend word en mag dit nie vir enige ander doel aangewend word nie, tensy 'n Parlements-wet die doel waarvoor dit toegewys is, wysig of verander. 15
