#### **EXPORT CONTROL**

- I, Mandisi Mpahlwa in my capacity as Minister of Trade and Industry, acting under the powers vested in me by Section 6 of the International Trade Administration Act, (Act 71 of 2002) -
- (I) Hereby prescribe that-
- (a) goods described in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 shall not be exported from the Republic of South Africa except by virtue of an export permit issued in terms of Section 6 of the said International Trade Administration Act, 2002, and in which such goods are specifically described:
- (II) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (I) (a) above, no export permit shall be necessary for the exportation of the following goods from the Republic of South Africa:
- (a) goods landed for transit through the Republic;
- (b) goods (excluding motor vehicles) exported as household or personal effects for the personal use by a natural person leaving the Republic permanently;
- (c) goods (excluding motor vehicles) exported as bona fide gifts at own cost by a natural person in the Republic to a designated natural person living outside the common customs area;
- (d) samples of no commercial value;
- (e) goods which are imported into the Republic for repair or maintenance and, after such repair or maintenance, exported to the original consignor.
- (f) vehicles of South Africa origin, vehicles imported as new into South Africa and vehicles legally imported into South Africa against a valid import permit issued in terms of Section 6 of the International Trade Administration Act (71 of 2002) exported to any member of SACU.

- (III) The code letters in column 2 of Schedules 1, 2 and 3 indicate the Government Departments and institutions that act as Controlling Authorities. All applications must be Government Departments and institutions to the various submitted submitting the application to the International Trade recommendation before Administration Commission. The code letters and the Government Departments or institutions involved, are as follow:
- I International Trade Administration
   Commission of South Africa.
- M Department of Minerals and Energy.
- H Department of Health.
- E Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism.
- W Department of Water Affairs and Forestry.
- P South African Police Service
- (IV) An export permit is, notwithstanding the conditions mentioned in the permit, subject to the following conditions:
- (a) only goods specified in the permit may be exported;
- (b) the permit may not in any manner be transferred by the holder thereof to any other person or may not be used to the benefit of anyone not referred to in the permit;
- (c) the permit shall be valid for a maximum period of six months from the date of issue or for such shorter period as indicated on the permit.
- (V) Nothing contained in this notice shall absolve an exporter from the obligation of also complying with the provisions of other legislation relating to the exportation of goods from the Republic of South Africa.
- (VI) Hereby withdraw Government Notice R1714 of 5 December 2003.
- (VII) Hereby determine that this notice shall come into operation on the day of publication.
- (VIII) A permit issued in terms of Government Notice R1714 and valid before this notice came into operation, must be regarded as a permit issued in terms of this Government Notice.

#### WATER RESEARCH FUND - RATES AND CHARGES

- I, Lindiwe Benedicta Hendricks, in my capacity as Minister of Water Affairs and Forestry, hereby levy, in terms of the authority vested in me by section 11 of the Water Research Act, 1971 (Act No. 34 of 1971), the following rates and charges:
  - (a) Three hundred and sixty four cents (364c) in respect of each hectare of land of which the water use is permissible during the 2008/2009 water year in terms of section 22(1)(a)(ii) of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998), or in respect of which an allocation has been made under Chapter 4 of the said National Water Act for the irrigation thereof at any time during the said water year, with water supplied or made available from any government water work. These rates and charges shall be recovered by or on the instructions of the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, simultaneously with any other charge which I may make in respect of the land concerned during the said period in terms of section 57 of the said National Water Act or, if no such charge is made, the charge shall be payable upon demand to the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry.
  - (b) The amount mentioned in 1(a) above shall apply in respect of each hectare of land permitted under the control of an irrigation board or other water management institution established in terms of the said National Water Act for the irrigation of land at any time during the 2008/2009 financial year of such board or institution with water supplied or made available from a government water work or a water work belonging to such board or institution. This charge shall be recovered by the irrigation board or statutory body concerned and shall be remitted to the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry within thirty (30) days of the close of the financial year of that irrigation board or statutory body.
  - (c) With effect from 1 July 2008, three comma five four cents (3,54c) per cubic meter in respect of metered water supplied or made available from a government water work for purposes other than the irrigation of land: Provided that if a free allocation has been made to a specific consumer from a government water work, the said charge shall not apply to that allocation as it shall be deemed to be water supplied from his own sources by the consumer concerned. These charges shall be recovered by the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, simultaneously with any charge which I may make in terms of section 57 of the said National Water Act in respect of the supply of water as from the said date or shall be payable to him upon demand.
  - (d) With effect from 1 July 2008, three comma five four cents (3,54c) per cubic meter in respect of the quantity of water supplied or made available for use for urban, industrial or domestic purposes by a statutory body or water management institution established in terms of the said National Water Act or by any other water services institution as defined in terms of the Water Services Act, 1997 (Act No. 108 of 1997): Provided that there shall be deducted from the total quantity of water supplied or made available after 1 July 2008 by any one of the abovementioned suppliers the quantity of water supplied or made available from a government water work as contemplated in paragraph 1(c) and the quantity of water obtained from any of the abovementioned suppliers after that date in respect of which the charge referred to in paragraph 1(c) or (d) has already been paid.

The total amount payable in terms of this paragraph in respect of water supplied or made available shall be remitted by the supplier concerned, so as to reach the Director-General: Water Affairs and Forestry, Private Bag X313, Pretoria, 0001, or such other offices as may be agreed upon, as follows:

- (aa) In respect of the period 1 July to 31 December of each year, on or before 31 March of the ensuing year; and
- (bb) In respect of the period 1 January to 30 June of each year, on or before 30 September of the same year.

The audited statements prescribed in terms of section 11(3)(b) of the said Water Research Act shall be submitted as soon as possible after the payments mentioned in paragraph 1(d) have been made.

- 2. If such rates and charges remain wholly or partly unpaid after the due date, interest shall be charged in terms of section 80(1)(a) of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999) on the outstanding amount at a rate determined from time to time by the Minister of Finance, on loans granted out of a Revenue Fund.
- 3. For the purpose of this notice, one cubic meter shall be equal to one kiloliter.

#### PROCEDURES AND TIME LIMITS

Manufacturers in the SACU of the subject products listed above, who wish to submit a request for the duty to be reviewed prior to the expiry thereof, are requested to do so not later than close of business on **20 July 2008**.

SACU manufacturers, who do submit a request before on **20 July 2008**, should submit duly substantiated information, indicating that the expiry of the duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury, to the Commission.

It should be noted that the investigation process is complex and the Commission is subject to strict time limits within which to complete the investigation. Late submissions will therefore not be accepted, except with the prior written consent of the Commission. The Commission will give due consideration to written requests for an extension of not more than 14 days on good cause shown (properly motivated and substantiated), if received prior to the expiry of the original period. Merely citing insufficient time is not an acceptable reason for extension.

The information submitted by any party may need to be verified by the Investigating Officers in order for the Commission to take such information into consideration.

The Commission may verify the information at the premises of the party submitting the information, within a short period after the submission of the information to the Commission. Parties should therefore ensure that the information submitted will subsequently be available for verification. It is planned to do the verification of the information submitted by the exporters within three to five weeks subsequent to submission of the information. #### INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION

NOTICE OF INITITATION OF A SUNSET REVIEW OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON GYPSUM PLASTERBOARD ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THAILAND AND INDONESIA

In accordance with the provisions of Article 11.3 of the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, any definitive anti-dumping duty shall be terminated on a date not later than five years from its imposition, unless the authorities determine, in a review initiated before that date on their own initiative or upon a duly substantiated request made by or on behalf of the domestic industry within a reasonable period of time prior to that date, that the expiry of the duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury.

On 25 January 2008, the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (the Commission) notified the interested parties through Notice No. 122 of 2008 in Government Gazette No. 30680, that unless a substantiated request is made indicating that the expiry of the anti-dumping duties against imports of gypsum plasterboard originating in or imported from Thailand and Indonesia would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury, the anti-dumping duties on gypsum plasterboard originating in or imported from Thailand will expire on 22 August 2008 and from Indonesia on 21 May 2009.

A response to the sunset review application questionnaire was received from BPB Gypsum on behalf of the South African Customs Union (SACU) industry on 07 March 2008.

#### THE APPLICANT

The application was lodged by BPB Gypsum, trading as Saint-Gobain construction products (the applicant), the sole producer of gypsum plasterboard within the SACU. The Applicant alleges that the expiry of the duty would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and the recurrence of material injury. The Applicant submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Commission to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that a sunset review investigation should be initiated.

#### THE PRODUCT

The products allegedly being dumped is gypsum plasterboard classifiable under tariff subheading 6809.11 originating in or imported from Thailand and Indonesia.

#### THE ALLEGATION OF THE CONTINUATION OR RECURRENCE OF DUMPING

The allegation of continuation or recurrence of dumping is based on the comparison between the normal values and the export prices.

The normal value for Thailand and Indonesia was obtained through a subsidiary company of the Applicant which is also active in these markets. The export price for Indonesia was based on import statistics obtained from the South African Revenue Service (SARS). As the quantities exported from Thailand to SACU was considered too small to be a reliable export price, the Applicant also provided published import statistics of exports from Thailand to India, from which the normal value for Thailand was calculated.

On this basis, the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of the likely continuation or recurrence of dumping if the duties expire.

#### THE ALLEGATION OF CONTINUATION OR RECURRENCE OF MATERIAL INJURY

The Applicant alleges and submitted *prima facie* evidence to show that there would be price undercutting and that the imports in question are depressing and suppressing its selling prices. The Applicant's information indicated that it would experience a decline in sales, profit margins, production, market share, capacity utilisation, return on investment and it will have a negative impact on cash flow, if the duties expire.

On this basis the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of the recurrence of material injury.

#### PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The investigation period for dumping is from 01 January 2007 to 31 December 2007, and the injury investigation involves evaluation of data for the period of 01 January 2006 to 31 December 2007. The Commission will also consider an estimate of what the situation will be, if the anti-dumping duties expire.

#### PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of a sunset review investigation, the Commission has begun an investigation in terms of section 16 of the International Trade Administration Act, 2002 (the ITA Act). The Commission will conduct its investigation in accordance with the relevant sections of the ITA Act, the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the GATT 1994 (the Anti-Dumping Agreement) and the Anti-Dumping Regulations of the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ADR). Both the ITA Act and the ADR are available on the Commission's website (<a href="www.itac.org.za">www.itac.org.za</a>) or from the Trade Remedies section, on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Commission will send non-confidential versions of the application and questionnaires to all known importers and exporters, and known representative associations.

The trade representative of the exporting country has also been notified. Importers and other interested parties are invited to contact the Commission as soon as possible in order to determine whether they have been listed and were furnished with the relevant documentation. ## NOTICE OF INITITATION OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF TALL OIL FATTY ACID ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM SWEDEN

The International Trade Administration Commission (the Commission) accepted an application alleging that tall oil fatty acid originating in or imported from Sweden is being dumped on the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) market, causing material injury to the SACU industry concerned.

#### THE APPLICANT

The application was lodged by Industrial Oleochemical Products, being the only manufacturer of the product under investigation in the SACU. The Applicant alleges that it cannot compete with the low prices charged by the importers and that the allegedly dumped product is causing it material injury. The Applicant submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Commission to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that an investigation should be initiated on the basis of dumping, material injury and causality.

#### THE PRODUCT

The product allegedly being dumped is tall oil fatty acid, classifiable under tariff subheading 3823.13, originating in or imported from Sweden.

#### THE ALLEGATION OF DUMPING

The allegation of dumping is based on the comparison between the normal value in and the export price from Sweden. The normal value was determined based on a quotation received from the Swedish supplier of the subject product. The export price was determined based on the official import statistics obtained from the South African Revenue Service. On this basis, the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of dumping.

#### THE ALLEGATION OF MATERIAL INJURY

The Applicant alleges and submitted sufficient evidence to show that there is price undercutting and that the imports in question are suppressing its selling prices. The Applicant's information indicated a decline in sales, profit margins, output, market share, productivity and capacity utilisation. It further indicated that there is a negative effect on cash flow, growth and the ability to raise capital. It was also evident that the decrease in market share has been at the expense of a corresponding increase in the market share of the allegedly dumped goods. On this basis the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of material injury and causal link.

#### PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The period of investigation for purposes of determining the dumping margin in the exporting country will be from 01 January 2007 to 31 December 2007. The period of investigation for purposes of determining injury will be from 01 January 2005 to 31 December 2007. If there are subsequent events that are relevant to injury the Commission may later request and consider further, more recent information.

#### PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Commission has begun an investigation in terms of section 16 of the International Trade Administration Act, 2002 (the ITA Act). The Commission will conduct its investigation in accordance with the relevant sections of the ITA Act, the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the GATT 1994 (the Anti-Dumping Agreement) and the Anti-Dumping Regulations of the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ADR). Both the ITA Act and the ADR are available on the Commission's website (www.itac.org.za) or from the Trade Remedies section, on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Commission will send non-confidential versions of the application and questionnaires to all known importers and exporters, and known representative associations. The trade representative of the exporting country has also been notified. Importers and other interested parties are invited to contact the Commission as soon as possible in order to determine whether they have been listed and were furnished with the relevant documentation. If not, they should immediately ensure that they are sent copies. The questionnaire has to be completed and any other representations must be made within the time limit set out below.

# INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION OF SOUTH AFRICA

DECISION BY THE COMMISSION TO RESCIND ITS DECISION TO INITIATE SUNSET AND INTERIM REVIEWS OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON CARBON BLACK ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM EGYPT AND INDIA AND THE SUNSET REVIEW OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON GALVANISED STEEL TUBES AND PIPES ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM INDIA

In accordance with the provisions of Sub-Part IV of the Anti-Dumping Regulations and Article 11.3 of the World Trade Organisation Agreement on the Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994 (the "Anti-dumping Agreement"), any definitive anti-dumping duty shall be terminated on a date not later than five years from the date of imposition, unless the authorities determine, in a review initiated before that date on their own initiative or upon a duly substantiated request made by or on behalf of the domestic industry within a reasonable period of time prior to that date, that the expiry of the duty would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury.

In terms of the WTO Anti-dumping Agreement and the Anti-dumping Regulations, the initiation of any sunset review must occur prior to the expiry of the aforementioned five-year period to keep the anti-dumping duty in force beyond the period of five years.

In the case of *Progress Office Machines versus SARS, ITAC and others* that was heard in the Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) the question was whether the date on which antidumping duties are imposed should be taken as the date on which the notice by SARS is published, indicating an amendment to Schedule No. 2 to the Customs and Excise Act, or be taken as the date from which the amendment is stipulated as having retrospective effect, that is the date on which provisional payments were imposed. The SCA decided on 26 September 2007 that the anti-dumping duties were imposed on the date from which they had retrospective effect and therefore the ruling of the SCA was that the five-year period starts on this retrospective date. This is in contrast with how the International Trade Administration Commission has always calculated the five-year lapse date of an anti-dumping duty.

The Commission has always, in accordance with international practice, calculated the five years from the date of the publication of the definitive anti-dumping duty.

The amendment to Schedule No. 2 to the Customs and Excise Act giving effect to the decision to impose anti-dumping duties on carbon black originating in or imported from Egypt and India was published on 10 September 1999 but with retrospective effect from 05 February 1999. In terms of the SCA's decision in *Progress Office Machines vs ITAC and others*, the sunset review of the anti-dumping duties on carbon black originating in or imported from Egypt and India had to be initiated by 05 February 2004. However, the sunset and interim reviews were only initiated on 23 July 2004.

The amendment to Schedule No. 2 to the Customs and Excise Act giving effect to the decision to impose an anti-dumping duty on galvanized steel tubes and pipes originating in or imported from India was published on 14 June 2002 but with retrospective effect from 8 February 2002. Similarly, in terms of the SCA's decision in *Progress Office Machines vs ITAC and others*, the sunset review of the anti-dumping duty on galvanized steel tubes and pipes originating in or imported from India had to be initiated by 8 February 2007. However, the sunset review was only initiated on 13 June 2007.

On 13 December 2007, the Commission made a preliminary decision, based on the SCA's judgment, to rescind its decision to initiate the sunset and interim review investigations of the anti-dumping duties on carbon black originating in or imported from Egypt and India and the sunset review on the anti-dumping duties on galvanized steel tubes and pipes originating in or imported from India. According to the SCA's judgment, these investigations were initiated after the five-year expiry date.

On 14 December 2007, interested parties were of the Commission's preliminary decision and invited to comment.

On 13 May 2008, the Commission considered all the available information and comments received and made a final decision to rescind its decision to initiate the sunset and interim review investigation of the anti-dumping duties on carbon black originating in or imported from Egypt and India, and the sunset review investigation of the anti-dumping duties on galvanized steel tubes and pipes originating in or imported from India.

## NOTICE TO INVITE NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES TO BE APPOINTED AS NATIONAL LOTTERIES BOARD MEMBERS

The Minister of Trade and Industry hereby invites nominations of persons as candidates to be appointed as National Lotteries Board members as contemplated in section 3 of the Act.

The National Lotteries Board (NLB) was established as a juristic person through the Lotteries Act, 1997 (Act No. 57 of 1997) (the Act).

- (1) Subject to subsection (3) of section 3 (1) of the Act, the Minister shall appoint the members of the board, which shall consist of—
  - (a) a chairperson, who shall be a person with applicable knowledge or experience with regard to matters connected with the functions of the board;
  - (b) one member designated by the Minister; and
  - (c) not more than five members who have proven business acumen or applicable knowledge or experience with regard to matters connected with the functions of the board, and of whom at least one should be a legal practitioner admitted to practice in the Republic and at least one a chartered accountant in the Republic.
  - (2) At least four members of the board shall be persons who are not in the service of any sphere of government.
- (3) The members contemplated in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) shall be appointed only after the Minister has by notice in the Gazette and in not less than two newspapers circulating in every province invited interested parties to nominate persons suitable for appointment as chairperson and the relevant committee of the National Assembly has made recommendations to the Minister in relation thereto after a transparent and open process of considering persons so nominated, having due regard to the functions of the board.
- (4) A member of the board shall hold office for such period, not exceeding five years, as the Minister may determine at the time of his or her appointment, and shall be eligible for reappointment at the end of his or her first term of office.
  - (5) Subject to section 33 of the Constitution, the Minister-
    - (a) may, as soon as he or she gains knowledge of any possible disqualification, terminate the membership of any member of the board on the grounds of serious misconduct or prolonged inability to perform the functions of a member of the board:
    - (b) shall suspend the membership of any member of the board in the event of the State instituting criminal proceedings in a court of law on a charge of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering a forged document, perjury, an offence in terms of the Corruption Act, 1992 (Act No. 94 of 1992), or any offence involving dishonesty;
    - (c) shall terminate the membership of any member of the board in the event of that member—
      - being found guilty on a court of law of contravening this Act or of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering of a forged document, perjury, an offence in terms of the Corruption Act, 1992, or any offence involving dishonesty; or
      - (ii) materially failing to comply with subsection (7).

Furthermore, section 3 (7) (a) of the Act states that a person shall not be appointed or remain a member of the Board—

(i) unless he or she is a fit and proper person for such membership;

- ii such person, whether personally or through his or her spouse or life partner, immediate family member, business partner or associate—
  - (aa) has or obtains a direct or indirect financial interest in any lottery or gambling or associated activity, or if that person has had any such interest during the period of three years immediately prior to the envisaged date of appointment as member of the board; or
  - (bb) has or obtains any interest in any business or enterprise that may conflict or interfere with the proper performance of his or her functions as a member of the board or in any shareholder of the licensee or prospective licensee; or
- (iii) if such person-
  - (aa) is or becomes a political office bearer;
  - (bb) is or becomes an un-rehabilitated insolvent or commits an act of insolvency;
  - (cc) has at any time been, or is, removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct; or
  - (dd) has at any time been, or is, convicted, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering a forged document, perjury, an offence in terms of the Corruption Act, 1992, or any offence involving dishonesty.

Section 3 (7) (b) also provides that a person who has been nominated for appointment to the board and who has accepted the nomination, whether tacitly or explicitly, shall, prior to his or her appointment as a member, submit to the Minister a written statement in which he or she declares whether or not he or she has any interest contemplated in paragraph (a) (ii).

Section 3 (7) (c) stipulates that if any member during his or her term of office acquires or contemplates acquiring an interest which could possibly be an interest contemplated in paragraph (a) (ii), he or she shall forthwith in writing declare that fact to both the Minister and the board, which at its following meeting shall consider whether such an interest constitutes or may constitute a contravention of paragraph (a) (ii), and if it is considered not to be a contravention, whether such acquisition or contemplated acquisition is likely to compromise the impartiality of the board.
