NOTICE OF THE ELECTION

In terms of the provisions of the Rules of the Government Employees Pension Fund, an election process for a Pensioner Member Trustee and a Substitute to serve on the GEPF Board of Trustees should take place every four years. In order to make this process fair and independent, the Board of Trustees of the GEPF has contracted the Electoral Institute of Southern Africa (EISA) and the Independent Electoral Commission (REC) to manage the administrative process and monitor the election process respectively.

STEP ONE: THE NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations are invited for the election of one Pensioner Member trustee. Each member of the GEPF who is a pensioner as defined in the Government Employees Pension Law, 1996 and is not disquetted in terms of Rule 4.1.7 of the Government Employee Pension Law of 1996 from becoming a Trustee shall be eligible for nomination. Please note that the nomination form is on the reverse aids of this letter.

Each GEPF Pensioner Member may nominate another GEPF Pensioner Member, provided that the nominated person accepts such a nomination by signing the relevant section of the nomination form. For a person to quality as a candidate for election, he/she must be a Pensioner Member of the GEPF, be nominated by a minimum of ten other GEPF Pensioner Members, and must indicate acceptance of the nomination by signing the nomination form, as indicated.

Nominations must be ledged with the Chief Electoral Officer by not later than 16:30 on Friday, 13 February 2009, where after each nomination will be screened for Vehicley.

- A typed personal statement or curriculum vitae (CV) in no more than 250 words, and A recent black and white passport-sized photograph with his/her name at the back of the photo
