ACT

To provide for the appropriation of money from the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State in the 2009/10 financial year; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS section 213(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, provides that money may be withdrawn from the National Revenue Fund only in terms of an appropriation by an Act of Parliament;

AND WHEREAS section 26 of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), provides that Parliament must appropriate money for each financial year for the requirements of the State,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa,
as follows:—

Definitions

1. In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, any meaning ascribed to a word or expression in section 1 of the Public Finance Management Act must bear the meaning so ascribed, and—

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“**conditional grants**” means conditional allocations to provinces, local government or municipalities from the national government’s share of revenue raised nationally, contemplated in section 214(1)(c) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996;

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“**current payments**” means any payment made by a national department in respect of the operational requirements of that department, and includes payments for the compensation of employees, goods and services, interest, rental of immovable property and financial transactions relating to assets and liabilities, but excludes transfers and subsidies, payments for capital assets and payments made under section 73 of the Public Finance Management Act;

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“**payments for capital assets**” means any payment made by a national department—

(a) for an asset that can be used continuously or repeatedly in production for more than one year and which is expected to have future economic benefits or service potential for the national department making the payment; and

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(b) that must be classified as or deemed to be a payment for capital assets in accordance with the *Reference Guide to the New Economic Reporting Format* (November 2003, Version 2) and the *Asset Management Framework* (April 2004, Version 3.3), issued by the National Treasury under section 76 of the Public Finance Management Act;

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“**Public Finance Management Act**” means the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999);

Ditthaloso

1. Molaong ona, haese feela ha ditaba di ka totobatsa ka hosele, moelelo o mong le o mong o hlahiswang ke lenswe kapa polelwana karolong ya 1 ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba o lokela ho jara moelelo o rerilweng, mme— 5

“**ditefello tsa thepa ya kapitale**” di bolela tefello efe kapa efe e entsweng ke 20 lefapha la naha—

(a) Bakeng sa thepa ya bohlokwa e ka sebediswang molebe kapa kgafetsa tlhahisong ka nako e fetang selemo se le seng, ebole e lebeletswe hore e be le menyetla ya moruo ka nako e tlhang kapa bokgoni ba tshebeletso bakeng sa lefapha la naha le ntshang ditefello; mme 25

(b) e lokela ho hlophiswa kapa nkuwe e le tefello ya tjhelete jwalo ka thepa ya bohlokwa ho latela *Reference Guide to the New Economic Reporting Format* (Pudungwana 2003, Kgatiso ya 2) le *Asset Management Framework* (Mmesa 2004, Kgatiso ya 3.3), e nehelanwe ke Bolaodi ba Ditjhelete tsa Naha (*National Treasury*) ho latela karolo ya 76 ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete 30 tsa Setjhaba;

“transfers and subsidies” means any payment made by a national department to another organ of state or to a person or organisation outside government in respect of which the national department does not receive a direct benefit of similar value in return, and includes the payment of conditional grants.

Appropriation of money for requirements of State

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2. (1) Appropriations by Parliament of money from the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State in the 2009/10 financial year, to votes and main divisions within a vote and for the specific listed purposes, are set out in the Schedule.

(2) The spending of appropriations contemplated in subsection (1) is subject to the provisions of this Act and the Public Finance Management Act. 10

(3) The spending of funds withdrawn from the National Revenue Fund before this Act has been passed by Parliament, as contemplated in section 29 of the Public Finance Management Act, must be recorded and accounted for in accordance with the votes and main divisions within a vote and for the specific listed purposes set out in the Schedule, and is subject to the conditions imposed by the National Treasury in terms of the Public Finance Management Act. 15

Conditional expenditure

3. (1) The Minister may—

- (a) impose conditions in respect of an appropriation listed as specifically and exclusively appropriated in the Schedule, in order to promote and enforce transparency and effective management in respect of revenue, expenditure, assets and liabilities of departments, public entities and constitutional institutions contemplated in section 6(1)(g) of the Public Finance Management Act; and 20
- (b) stop any allocation in terms of such appropriation until any condition imposed by the Minister is met. 25

(2) An amount stopped in terms of subsection (1)(b) must be included in the National Treasury’s next report in terms of section 32(1) of the Public Finance Management Act.

Utilisation of saving

4. Notwithstanding section 43(4) of the Public Finance Management Act, the National Treasury may approve the utilisation of a saving in— 30

- (a) an amount appropriated for transfer to another institution or to an organisation or body outside of government; or
- (b) an amount appropriated for payments for capital assets, if the saving is to be utilised for other categories of expenditure. 35

Authorisation of expenditure

5. (1) In addition to section 16 of the Public Finance Management Act, and despite anything to the contrary in any other law, the Minister may approve expenditure qualifying for inclusion in an adjustments budget in terms of section 30(2) of the Public Finance Management Act, before such an adjustments budget is passed. 40

(2) Expenditure approved in terms of subsection (1)—

- (a) may not exceed the total amount set aside as a contingency reserve in the national annual budget for the current financial year;
- (b) is a direct charge against the National Revenue Fund; and
- (c) must be included either in the next national adjustments budget or in other appropriation legislation tabled in the National Assembly for the financial year in which the expenditure is authorised. 45

(3) An approval granted by the Minister in respect of money to be appropriated for expenditure already announced by the Minister during the tabling of the annual budget—

- (a) is subject to the requirements of subsection (2); and
- (b) may be made subject to conditions. 50

2. (1) Ditekanyetso tsa tjhelete e tswang Letloleng la Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba ke Palamente bakeng sa dithhoko tsa ditjhelete tsa selemo sa ditjhelete sa 2009/10, dikgethong le dikarolo tsa sehlooho ka hara kgetho, esita le merero e itseng e 10 totobetseng e lenaneng, di boletswe ka hara lenane la dinyehelo.

(2) Tshebediso ya ditekanyetso tse boletseng ho karolwana ya (1) di laolwa ke dikarolo tsa 4 le 5 tsa Molao ona, le Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba.

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Ditshenyehelo tsa dipehelo

3. (1) Letona le ka nna la—

- (a) qobella dipehelo ho ya ka tekanyetso e hlophisisweng e le e ikgethang e lekanyeditsweng ka ho itsheka ka hara lenane la dinyehelo e le ho ntshetsa pele le ho matlafatsa ponalaetsa le taolo e hlwahlwa malebana le ditjhelete, ditshenyehelo, matlotlo a bohlokwa le dikoloto tsa mafapha, dintho tsa setjhaba le ditsha tsa molao wa motheo jwalo ka ha di boletswe ho karolo ya 6(1)(g) ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba; le
- (b) thibele kabo efe kapa efe ho ya ka tekanyetso ya mofuta oo ho siblela maemo afe kapa afe a beilweng ke Letona a phethahatswa.

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(2) Palo ya tjhelete e thibetseng ho ya ka karolwana ya (1)(b) e lokela ho kenyelsetsa tlalehong e latelang ya Bolaodi ba Ditjhelete tsa Naha ho latela karolo ya 32(1) ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba.

Tshebediso ya poloko

4. Ho sa natswe karolo ya 43(4) ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba, Bolaodi ba Ditjhelete tsa Naha bo ka nna ba dumella tshebediso ya poloko ha—

- (a) palo ya tjhelete e lekanyeditsweng ho fetisetswa institjusheneng e nngwe kapa mokgatlong tseo e seng tsa mmuso, kapa
- (b) palo ya tjhelete e lekanyeditsweng bakeng sa ditefello tsa matlotlo a bohlokwa a tjhelete, haeba poloko e lokela ho sebedisetswa mekgahlelo e meng ya 40 ditshenyehelo.

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Tumello ya ditshenyehelo

5. (1) Ka hodima karolo ya 16 ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaba, le ka ntle ho dipehelo tse fumanwang molaong o mong ofe kapa ofe, Letona le ka ananela ditshenyehelo tse lokelang ho ba karolo ya tekanyetso ho latela karolo ya 30(2) ya Molao wa Taolo ya Ditjhelete tsa Setjhaha pele diphetolo tseo tsa tekanyetso di fetiswa ka molao.

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(2) Tshenyehelo e dumelletsweng ho latela karolwana ya (1)—

- (a) E ke ke ya feta palo yohle e beheletseng ka thoko e le e boloketsweng lebaka la tshohanyetso le ka hlahang ka hara **tekanyetso** ya selemo le selemo ya naha 50 bakeng sa selemo sona scena sa ditjhelete;

Gautrain Loan

6. An amount of R4.2 billion is appropriated as a capital transfer to the Gauteng Province for the implementation of the Gautrain Rapid Rail Link Project, subject to a loan agreement being entered into between the Minister of Finance and the Premier of the Gauteng Province, and the Province's continued compliance with the loan agreement once entered into. 5

Regulations

7. The Minister may, by notice in the *Gazette*, make regulations regarding—
(a) anything which may be prescribed in terms of this Act; and
(b) any ancillary or incidental administrative or procedural matter that it is 10 necessary to prescribe for the proper implementation or administration of this Act.

Short title

8. This Act is called the Appropriation Act, 2009.

Melawana

7. Letona le ka nna la sebedisa tsebiso Koranteng ya Mmuso (*Gazette*), ho etsa melawana malebana le—

- (a) ntho efc kapa efe e ka nnang ya kgothaletswa hore e sebediswe ho ya ka Molao ona; le hore
 (b) taba efc kapa efc ya tlatsatso kapa ya tshohanyetsos tsamaisong e tshwanelehang bakeng sa ho kenngwa tshebetsong ho lokileng kapa tsamaiso ya Molao ona.
